

Residents can play a part in ensuring the ends of their driveways remain clear of snow even after local plows come through. Shoveling a "corner" of the right-of-way free of snow in the area several feet before the driveway will help keep that same snow from being pushed into the driveway. Clearing an area large enough to hold the snow coming off the plow may reduce the "Second Shovel."
