# 1. Projects

- a. J. W. Denver Williams Memorial Front Entrance- Review concrete pad quotes. Have additional quote from TH Solutions waiting on itemized invoice. Said it would be around \$13,000.
- b. Playground Repair Quote-Runk's Custom Welding \$100 to repair playground handles. (Need a new line in budget to proceed with quote. The clown slide has been removed and scraped.
- c. Review Playground inspection reports. Checking with Runk's Custom Welding to come out and give estimates on other repairs to park equipment in playground inspection.
- d. Xidas Park- Construction is complete, missing one board on the roof. Reaching out to Thompson construction to see why that has not been done.
- e. Southeast Park- Plan was to remove tires and replace them with new playground equipment if we receive the CDBG grant. Tires can be painted if the grant is not received.
- f. Lighting for Tennis/ Pickleball Courts at Denver Park. Pickleball players donated \$2,487.50 for new lights on the tennis balls courts for pickleball. Need to reach back out to Josh Fisher to do the work and Street Department for the city's bucket truck.

### 3. Grant Info

- a. Recreational Trail Program grant is submitted, had to tie up loose ends should be hearing back this fall
- b. The State Capital Budget Bill request was made through City administration for consideration for Galvin. This was approved. They are currently working to finalize the procedural guide and should get initial award correspondence in August. The estimate included 3 pieces of playground equipment and installation and installation of a shelter house.



- c. Clinton County Foundation Legacy Grant- have received this grant should be receiving funds in the next few weeks. Will need a new line item for these funds.
- d. ODNR Nature Works- 25% match; Available funds for Clinton County \$52,398. August 15 is the deadline for the grant. The idea is to use the funds to get new playground equipment where the slide was and to have a paved parking lot instead of gravel at J.W. Denver Williams Park. With 25% match could have a \$65,498 project.
- e. CDBG project for SECD- this is for Southeast Park; grant was for new equipment and replace the tire tower
