WELCOME TO PROFESSIONAL VOLLEYBALL

The San Diego Mojo are one of seven teams taking the court in the inaugural season of Pro Volleyball Federation. Below are a few facts about San Diego and Pro Volleyball Federation.

- The League boasts 17 players from the United States who have played with the National Team. Overall, there are 35 players who have been part of an Olympic or National Team.
- The Mojo are one of six professional sports teams based in San Diego (San Diego Padres, San Diego Wave FC, San Diego Gulls, San Diego Sockers, San Diego Seals)

HOME SWEET HOME

- After dropping the first three matches on the road this season, the San Diego Mojo became the final team in the Pro Volleyball Federation to play a home match this season, winning 3-1 over Grand Rapids on Friday, Feb. 23.
- The Mojo logged almost 7,500 air miles in traveling to Atlanta, Omaha and Las Vegas for the squad's first three matches.

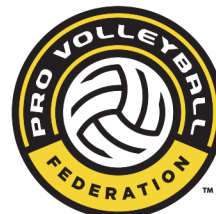
MOJO BEGINNING TO GEL

- The Mojo opened the season with three straight three-set losses, but over the next two matches, San Diego has won five sets and dropped four.

HEAD COACH TAYYIBA HANEEF-PARK

Tayyiba Haneef-Park is a former American volleyball player and coach with an impressive athletic career.

A three-time Olympian and two-time silver medalist, she has extensive experience in international competition, including the 2004, 2008 and 2012 Olympic Games. Haneef-Park contributed to notable achievements such as a gold medal at the 2012 FIVB World Grand Prix and bronze finishes at the 2003 and 2004 Grand Prix.

Prior to joining the Mojo, she spent 2022 as an assistant coach with Oregon Volleyball, during which the Ducks sported a 26-6 record, including a 17-3 mark in Pac-12 play. The 17 conference wins were a program record. Haneef-Park also spent two seasons (2015-16) as an assistant coach with Arizona Beach Volleyball, helping the Wildcats to a 38-10 record.

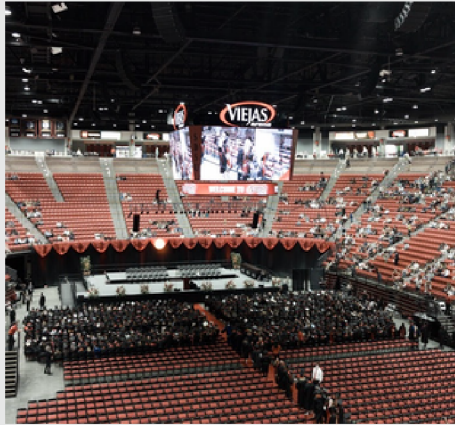

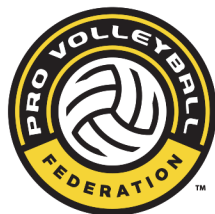
Pro Volleyball Federation, USA Volleyball Announce Alliance
