

UNLEASH THE FURY

The Columbus Fury are one of seven teams taking the court in the inaugural season of Pro Volleyball Federation.

- ⇒ The Fury boast a roster that features a combined 45-years of professional experience.
- ⇒ Three players, Megan Courtney Lush, Raymariely Santos, and María Schlegel have seven-plus years of experience playing internationally.
- □ Columbus' roster features three Ohio State alums, Ashley Wenz, Valeria León, and Jenaisya Moore, who will once again be playing volleyball in the Buckeye State
- \Rightarrow The Fury join the Columbus Blue Jackets (NHL) and the Columbus Crew (MLS) as the major league teams representing the city.
- The team hosted their home opener on Feb. 21 in front of a crowd of 9,165 at Nationwide Arena, the fifth-largest professional volleyball crowd recorded in the U.S.
- ⇒ After an 0-2 start, the team has won their last three matches behind the strong play of rookie Reagan Cooper. Cooper earned the Pro Volleyball Federation Player of the Week on 2/27 after totaling 66 points, 58 kills and 33 digs over three matches.

MAKING MOVES

After dropping their last two matches, the Fury made one of the biggest transactions of the inaugural season, acquiring Tori Stringer from the Atlanta Vibe. Columbus sent their 2025 and 2026 first round picks to Atlanta in exchange for the two-time All-American.

⇒ Stringer was an impact player at Louisville and in her time with the Vibe. She had four matches with 35+ assists and a season-high of 47 assists in a four-set loss at Grand Rapids.

- Stringer will reunite with head coach Ángel Pérez as she played for him in the Puerto Rican League in 2022, winning a league championship and being named the setter of the year.
- ⇒ Tori will face a familiar foe in her first match with the Fury, going against former Louisville teammate, Claire Chaussee.

BIG TEN COUNTRY

Columbus lies in the heart of Big Ten country and is home to the Ohio State Buckeyes. The team roster features eight players who spent at least one season at a Big Ten school.

- Wenz, León, and Moore are all Buckeyes with Wenz earning an All-American nod in her senior season in 2017.
- Rainelle Jones spent her collegiate career at Maryland where she led the country in blocks per set (1.71) in 2021.
- ⇒ The roster also features three Penn State alum, Kaitlyn Hord, Gabby Blossom, and Courtney Lush. Courtney Lush won two national titles with the Nittany Lions, while Hord garnered three All-American nods while there.
- ⇒ Hord also spent one season at Nebraska, where she led the NCAA in blocks per set (1.63) in 2022.
- ⇒ Before a four-year career at Washington, Samantha Drechsel spent her freshman season at Maryland.

PRO VOLLEYBALL FEDERATION PRESEASON POLL

The Fury were voted to finish third in the League's preseason poll, tying Grand Rapids with 23 points. The Fury did receive on first-place vote in the poll.

Columbus also placed one player on the Preseason All-League team, rookie Asjia O'Neal. O'Neal was the first overall draft selection of the League's inaugural College Draft.

BIG BLOCKS

The Fury are stacked at middle blocker. With four middles on the roster, they combined for huge numbers in college:

- ⇒ First overall draft pick, Asjia O'Neal is coming off backto-back National Championships with the Longhorns and made her mark as the program's all-time leading blocker
- ⇒ Kaitlyn Hord was named an All-American four times between Penn State and Nebraska, closing out her career by leading the nation in blocks while with the Cornhuskers.
- Rainelle Jones was dominant in her time at Maryland, and just one season before Hord, led the nation in blocks for the 'Terps.

⇒ Jenna Rosenthal was named All-Big East twice while at Marquette and worked her way to the highest levels of the German Bundesliga in her five-year career as a pro.

MORE THAN AN ATHLETE

The Fury features several athletes who have made their mark outside of volleyball:

- Megan Courtney Lush is returning to pro volleyball after a two year hiatus when she gave birth to her first child, Nora. Courtney Lush is just eight months out from giving birth.
- Valeria León is a practicing attorney with a law firm in Puerto Rico, ECIJA SBGB. She is an Associate Lawyer with the firm.
- ⇒ Jenna Rosenthal spent two years as a civil engineer before returning to the pro ranks.
- ⇒ Ashley Wenz is returning to volleyball for the first time after opting to not go overseas after college.
- Asjia O'Neal has had to battle for her spot in the limelight after undergoing two open-heart surgeries, the most recent in 2020.
- Rainelle Jones spent time working as an analyst for the Big Ten Network covering volleyball.

PUERTO RICAN INFLUENCE

The Fury boast the only Latino head coach in the league and he brought three Puerto Rican players with him to the team. Valeria León, Raymariely Santos, and Ivania Ortiz all played collegiately in the States but had since returned home to Puerto Rico to play professionally. Santos has played in leagues all around the world. The coaching staff also features Argentinian, Carlos Cardona, as the assistant coach and two Puerto Rican staffers, Jose Figueroa (technical director) and Felix Gordillo (athletic trainer).

ONCE UPON A TIME...

The Fury played their home opener on January 25 and had a 22 day break before getting back in action. They have had the last three weeks to prepare for match number two. The team had a couple of solid performances in their opener despite dropping the match in straight sets to Grand Rapids.

- Aitlyn Hord notched eight kills on an impressive .429 percentage for the match. Her percentage was a matchhigh for all players with at least 10 attack attempts.
- ⇒ Rookie Reagan Cooper led the team with nine kills in her professional debut.
- Ray Santos dished out 20 assists and spread the ball around with five hitters totaling 10-plus attempts.
- ⇒ Valeria León had a team-high 13 digs.

ROCKIN' ROOKIES

Columbus has had significant contributions from two of their rookies, Reagan Cooper and Asjia O'Neal

- □ Cooper has led the team in points and kills in each of the first three contests. She scored 24 points in the team's win over Omaha, the most of any Fury player this season.
- ➡ O'Neal saw her first action against Orlando and had to knock off a bit of rust on her way to seven points. The rust was gone by the team's home opener where she scored 19 points behind 15 kills and four blocks.
- Cooper continues to dominate, especially over the team's four-match win streak. She has now tallied three doubledoubles incluing a 29-kill, 16 dig performance at Orlando. Her 29 kill performance is tied for the most by any player in the league this season (Khat Bell, Vegas).

PASSING PERFECTION



Through their first three matches, the Fury have the highest perfect passing percentage in the league. This accounts for a service reception that allows the setter to set any hitter in the offense.

- As a team, Columbus is at a 29 percent perfect passes in serve receive, tied with Omaha.
- ⇒ Megan Courtney Lush has been the best passer on the year, with 45 percent of her passes being perfect.
- ⇒ Valeria León had the best single-match passing number in the season opener with 62 percent perfect passing.

HEAD COACH ÁNGEL PÉREZ

Pérez is a distinguished former international player and one of the best-ever male players from Puerto Rico, having played in France, Germany, Austria, Italy, Romania, and Slovenia. He also played on the Puerto Rican men's national team and for the Changos de Naranjito in the Puerto Rican men's pro volleyball league.

Pérez coached the Puerto Rican Women's Superior Volleyball League's Las Pinkin de Corozal to back-to-back league championships and was also named the league's Manager of the Year for the second consecutive year in just his third season as a head coach.



Pérez played one season in the United States at BYU before returning home to play at Polytechnic University of Puerto Rico from 2002-06. Starting in 2006 Pérez played for the Puerto Rican men's national team and spent more than a dozen years representing his native Puerto Rico in international play. He was captain of the national team from 2013-18.



Located on the corner of Nationwide Boulevard and Front Street in downtown Columbus, Nationwide Arena was built on a piece of property that was the site of the historic Ohio State Penitentiary. The support of naming rights partner Nationwide Insurance paved the way for the city to acquire an NHL expansion team, the Columbus Blue Jackets.

Nationwide Arena opened with back to back SOLD OUT Soul 2 Soul concerts featuring Tim McGraw and Faith Hill. Named one of the best arenas in the NHL, the facility opened to great fanfare in September of 2000 and has since hosted the NHL All-Star Game, regular season and playoff hockey, NCAA championships, local, regional and national conferences and a multitude of concerts and touring events.

COOPER NAMED PRO VOLLEYBALL FEDERATION PLAYER OF THE WEEK

COLUMBUS—After leading her team to three straight victories for the first time this season, Columbus' Reagan Cooper has been named Pro Volleyball Federation Player of the Week.

The outside hitter led the Fury in kills in all three matches, starting with a season-high 22 kills versus Omaha on Wednesday. She followed that effort with 15 and 21 kills in back-to-back wins over the Vegas Thrill. In the second match against the Thrill, she notched eight kills in the fourth set alone.

Cooper also recorded a season-best 15 digs in the home win over Vegas and tallied 33 overall in the three matches. She led the team in both points and kills for the week.

The native of Rowlett, Texas was the second-round pick for Columbus in the inaugural Pro Volleyball Federation draft in December.
