WELCOME TO PROFESSIONAL VOLLEYBALL

The Grand Rapids Rise are one of seven teams taking the court in the inaugural season of Pro Volleyball Federation. Below are facts about Grand Rapids and Pro Volleyball Federation.

- ⇒ Pro Volleyball Federation head coaches have combined for more than 2,500 career wins.
- ⇒ The League boasts 17 players from the United States who have played with the National Team. Overall, there are 35 players who have been part of an Olympic or National Team.
- ⇒ There are 490 college and high school volleyball teams in Michigan.

RISE - VALKYRIES CONNECTIONS

While neither team has any players from the opposing state, former teammates will reunite:

- ⇒ Ashley Evans and Valkyries middle blocker Blake Mohler played at Purdue together for two seasons (2015-16). Mohler redshirted in 2015, but both played for the Boilermakers in 2016 and helped Purdue reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- ⇒ Orlando outside hitter Carly Skjodt is a former University of Michigan volleyball captain and played three seasons (2016-18) with Rise director of volleyball operations MacKenzi Welsh-Vazquez. Skjodt also played in the AVP Beach Volleyball tour against Rise libero Sarah Sponcil.
- ⇒ Outside hitters Shannon Scully (Rise) and Adora Anae (Valkyries) were part of the 2017 Utah volleyball team that reached the NCAA Tournament regional semifinals.



GRAND RAPIDS RISE MATCH NOTES

SERIES COMING TO A CLOSE

The Grand Rapids Rise will wrap up three regular-season series this week against the Atlanta Vibe, Orlando Valkyries, and Vegas Thrill. It's the fourth and final time that Grand Rapids will play each of them in the inaugural Pro Volleyball Federation regular season. Head-to-head results could play an important role at the end of the season, as they are the first tiebreaker for the League standings. The second tiebreaker, if both teams beat each other twice during the season, is most match sweeps.

Atlanta, which became the first team to clinch a playoff berth on April 14 when San Diego defeated Orlando, has nearly half of the sweeps in the League this season with eight. Omaha is second with three, Grand Rapids and Vegas each have two, and the other three teams all have one 3-0 victory.

NEW ADDITION

The Rise signed 6-foot-3 middle blocker Molly Lohman on Monday. She became the first in-season addition in the franchise's brief history. To make room for Lohman on the active roster, middle blockers Sydney Bolding and Nia Grant were waived.

Lohman, a native of Mankato, Minnesota, has been playing professional for six seasons in six countries: France, Switzerland, Finland, United States, Hungary, and Philippines. She was named the best middle blocker in the 2021-22 Finnish Cup. Internationally, Lohman competed with the USA Collegiate national team at the 2016 Global Challenge in Pula, Croatia, where the team won gold and she was named the MVP of the tournament.

Lohman graduated from the University of Minnesota (2014-17) and was an AVCA All-American honorable mention in 2016. In the Minnesota volleyball record book, she still ranks third all-time in total blocks (536) and attack percentage (.356) with a minimum 1,000 attempts. During her junior season in 2016, Lohman totaled the second-most total blocks for the Golden Gophers in a single season with 177.

Lohman made her Rise debut in Atlanta on Tuesday. She played in two sets and recorded her first Pro Volleyball Federation kill and block.

GO GO GÓMEZ

After primarily being used as a defensive specialist and substitute server, Camila Gómez has started the last three matches for the Rise at libero. She has recorded team highs in digs the last two matches with 17 against Vegas on April 13 and 20 more in Atlanta on April 16. Gómez has 52 digs and seven assists in 35 sets played this season.

MINI MILESTONES TRACKER

CAUGHT IN A WHIRLWIND

The Rise are currently playing five matches in the span of 10 days, which will include travel before and after each match. The schedule looks like this: at Orlando [4/11], travel home to Grand Rapids to face Vegas [4/13], at Atlanta [4/16], home again against Orlando [4/18], and then over to Vegas to see the Thrill again [4/20]. The multi-stop journey is roughly 6,575 miles and doesn't include the road trip to face Omaha [4/26] and Columbus [4/28] later this month. The Rise have three road matches left and will complete them before April is over.

FINDING THE BROOM

Since sweeping the Fury in the season opener on Jan. 25, the Rise had only played in four and five set matches. That changed April 11 in Orlando, as the Rise secured their second 3-0 victory of the season.

Sweeps have been uncommon for the entire League with only 18 happening in the 59 matches played so far (30.5%). There have been 27 four-set matches (45.8%) and 14 five-set matches (23.7%). Grand Rapids and Omaha are the only two teams that have completed a sweep this season and haven't been swept themselves.

SET-BY-SET BREAKDOWN

A look at how the Rise have fared across the different sets:

- ⇒ **First Set:** 12-5 with a +42 point differential (420-378)
- ⇒ **Second Set:** 10-7 with a -1 differential (392-393)
- ⇒ **Third Set:** 6-11 with a -5 point differential (402-407)
- ⇒ **Fourth Set:** 6-9 with a -19 point differential (352-371)
- ⇒ **Fifth Set:** 2-3 with a -5 point differential (60-65)

With eight regular-season matches remaining, Grand Rapids has a +12 point differential (1,626-1,614) and is 36-35 across all sets played. The Rise are 8-14 in sets decided by the minimum of two points and 15-12 in sets decided by five points or more.

HEAD COACH CATHY GEORGE

The Grand Rapids Rise on March 13, 2023 introduced Cathy George as the team's head coach and VP of volleyball operations.

The winningest coach in the history of Michigan State University's volleyball program, George led the Spartans for 17 seasons (2005-21) and totaled 35 years as a collegiate head coach, including 11 seasons (1994-2004) at Western Michigan University. Upon her retirement from MSU in January 2022, her 667 career wins (667-457, .593) ranked 15th among active Division I coaches and third in the Big Ten.

George began her DI coaching career at UT-Arlington in 1989, reaching the Final Four in her first season at the helm and winning three Southland Conference titles (1989, 1990 and 1992) in five years. She was the first female head coach to lead a team to the NCAA Division I Final Four. George got her start as a collegiate head coach at the NCAA DII level at North Dakota State University, serving from 1987-88.

CBS SPORTS NETWORK TO TELEVISE THREE RISE MATCHES

Three upcoming Grand Rapids Rise matches – two at home and one on the road – will be televised by CBS Sports Network, as announced by Pro Volleyball Federation on March 13. A total of 10 League matches will be aired on CBS Sports Network to kick off a multi-year broadcast agreement, including seven regular-season matches plus the League's semifinal and championship matches in May.

The Rise's three appearances on CBS Sports Network, tied for most in the League, include their home match against Orlando on Saturday, April 6, a visit to Omaha on Friday, April 26, and their regular-season finale against Omaha on Sunday, May 12 at Van Andel Arena. The final two telecasts will feature time changes from the original schedule, as the April 26 road match will start at 9:30 p.m. EDT instead of 8 p.m., and the finale at home will begin at 5:30 p.m. instead of 4 p.m.


