WELCOME TO PROFESSIONAL VOLLEYBALL

The Orlando Valkyries are one of eight teams taking the court this season of Pro Volleyball Federation. Below are a few facts about Orlando and Pro Volleyball Federation.

- Orlando is home to the AAU Junior National Volleyball Championships.
- The Valkyries are the fourth professional team to be based out of Orlando (Orlando Magic, Orlando City Soccer, Orlando Pride).
- Pro Volleyball Federation head coaches have combined for more than 2,500 career victories.
- Orlando was selected to finish second in the Preseason polling, with 41 total points.

TEAM CONNECTIONS

This marks the first time the Valkyries and Vibe have played on the court this season, but there are several connections with the teams.

- Valkyries middle blocker Kaz Brown and Vibe outside hitter Leah Edmond played together at the University of Kentucky in 2016 & 2017.
- Mia Tuaniga (Atlanta) and Shannon Scully (Orlando) were teammates at the University of Southern California during the 2021 campaign.

- Courtney Schwan** - In Sunday's sweep vs. Omaha, Schwan tallied eight kills and 14 digs. It was her third match of the season tallying 12+ digs.

EXTENSIVE AND EXPANDED NATIONAL BROADCAST SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED

MATCH PREVIEW

MATCH EIGHT PREVIEW – VALKYRIES AT VIBE

After sweeping the Omaha Supernovas at home, Orlando [3-4] will travel to the Peach State, aiming to build on their momentum against the Atlanta Vibe [4-3] on Thursday, February 6, at 7:00 p.m. ET. Fans can catch the action streamed live on Pro Volleyball Federation's YouTube channel.

Top Offense vs. Top Defense

Leading in arguably every offensive category this season, Orlando is moving like a well-oiled machine. Leading the league in kills (403), hitting efficiency (26.9%), and kill percentage (37.8%), Orlando has also gotten it done with their defense, holding Omaha's attack to a .159 hitting percentage on Sunday. On Thursday, they face another tough test against Atlanta's formidable defense, which leads the league in opponent hitting efficiency (.188).

This will be the first meeting between Orlando and Atlanta this season, with Atlanta leading the all-time series 4-0.

Valkyries Players to Watch:

Adora Anae (Outside hitter): After posting 13 kills vs Omaha, her fifth straight match of 10+ kills, Anae will look to continue her aggressive ways against Atlanta. Providing plenty of energy from both the back and front row, Anae will play a key role in not only putting up points with her swing, but helping her team play within system with her passing, as she's averaging 11.4 digs per contest.

Brittany Abercrombie (Opposite hitter): Leading the league with 123 kills, Abercrombie has been incredible this season. Coming off a double-double performance where she had 16 kills and 12 digs against Omaha, she'll have another opportunity to showcase her excellent pinpoint accuracy versus a very good defense. With Abercrombie on one side and Anae on the other, Orlando boasts one of the most dynamic pin combinations in the league.

Vibe Players to Watch:

Merritt Beason (Opposite hitter): The first overall pick of the 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation draft, the former husker has been phenomenal in her first professional season. Setting a career-high with 23 kills earlier in the season and coming off a 15-kill performance against Vegas, the 6'4" opposite plays like a seasoned veteran.

Leah Edmond (Outside hitter): After taking home MVP as well as Outside hitter of the year and All-PVF First Team in 2024, Edmond has continued to make her presence known, averaging a double-double this season, with 12.9 kills and 10.6 digs per match. She also ranks first in service aces (16) and fourth in blocks (19).

VALKYRIES SUFFER FIRST LOSS TO IGNITE

The Orlando Valkyries [1-1] were unable to spoil Indy Ignite's [1-0] home opener, falling 3-1 by set scores of 25-13, 19-25, 17-25, 21-25.

Brittany Abercrombie led the Valkyries with 18 total points, registering 17 kills, one block and nine digs in the contest.

Set 1

Orlando set the tone early in the match, sparked by a powerful kill from Brittany Abercrombie to open the scoring. Indy initially matched the Valkyries' intensity, trading points and even grabbing a brief lead (5-4). However, Orlando soon found their rhythm, embarking on an impressive 17-8 run fueled by exceptional defense that forced the Ignite into committing seven errors. Brittany Abercrombie, who sparked the Valkyries' momentum, continued her dominance with five kills in the set, sealing a 25-13 victory for Orlando in the opener.

Set 2

Building on their strong start in the first set, Brittany Abercrombie once again sparked the Valkyries' offense, helping them race to an early 6-2 lead. However, after a slow start, Indy began to find their rhythm. Led by a dominant stretch from Leketor Member-Meneh, who delivered eight kills, the Ignite seized their first lead of the set at 16-14. Set 3

Set 4

VALKYRIES DEFEAT MOJO IN FOUR

The Orlando Valkyries [2-1] secured their first road win of the season over the San Diego Mojo [1-2] winning 3-1 by set scores of 25-23, 20-25, 25-17, 25-15.

Adora Anae led the Valkyries with 27 kills, setting a new career high. She also had 10 digs and one block, securing her first double-double of the season

Set 1

Adora Anae set the tone early for Orlando, getting the scoring started and taking an early charge with a 8-5 lead. San Diego, looking to even up the season series vs. Orlando, focused their offense on Kendra Dahlke, who missed most of the first matchup. Dahlke would provide a big spark by scoring five of the Mojo's first nine points. Despite San Diego's efforts, Orlando maintained control throughout the first set, never giving up the lead. The Valkyries sealed the set with a 25-23 victory, fueled by standout performances from Courtney Schwan and Adora Anae, who each contributed four kills.

Set 2

Much like in the opening set, Adora Anae provided the spark for the Valkyries as they aimed to make it five consecutive set wins to start the year against San Diego. However, the Mojo were ready for the challenge and responded pulling ahead with a 12-9 lead, after a back-and-forth affair. Despite Orlando's efforts to keep pace, costly errors in the serving game—seven service errors alone in set two—began to take their toll. This opened the door for San Diego to seize momentum with a decisive 5-0 run, ultimately clinching the set 25-20. Maya Tabron shined for the Mojo in set two, leading her team with five kills.

Set 3

The Valkyries aimed to bounce back in set three, while the Mojo looked to build on the momentum they had gained at the end of set two. After being limited to just one kill in the previous set, Brittany Abercrombie came out firing, delivering the first two Valkyries kills and igniting a spark that powered her team to a 15-10 lead. Abercrombie's impact extended beyond her attacks—her dominance at the net, along with Natalie Foster's strong blocking, stifled San Diego's attempts to close the gap. The Valkyries sealed the set with a 10-7 run, capped off by a big block from Natalie Foster. Abercrombie finished the set as the team leader in kills with seven, boasting a stellar .462 hitting percentage

Set 4

Trailing 2-1 in the match, San Diego faced a tough situation as they fought to force a decisive fifth set in front of their home crowd. They came out strong, jumping to an early 3-1 lead. However, Orlando remained relentless, refusing to let the match get to five sets. The Valkyries surged ahead, climbing to an impressive 18-10 lead and maintained their momentum to close out the match with a commanding 3-1 victory over the San Diego Mojo. Adora Anae led the charge for Orlando, recording seven kills in the final set.

VALKYRIES FALL TO THRILL IN FIVE

The Orlando Valkyries [2-2] fall to the Vegas Thrill [3-1] in five sets, with set scores of 25-22, 23-25, 25-14, 21-25, 12-15.

Brittany Abercrombie had a career night, leading the Valkyries with 33 total points, recording 30 kills, two blocks and eleven digs in the contest

Set 1

After completing a reverse sweep against Omaha at home, Vegas hit the ground running off a back-row attack from Hannah Maddux that helped them jump to an early 6-2 lead. However, Orlando wasted no time responding as Kaz Brown and Hannah Pukis delivered defensively, each of them recording a block during a 4-0 run, tying the score at 6-6. Vegas regained momentum and built a four-point lead at 13-9, but Orlando refused to back down. They clawed their way back into the set eventually taking their first lead 23-22. Orlando would finish on a 10-3 run, winning 25-22. Brittany Abercrombie led the Valkyries with seven kills in set one.

Set 2

After being held to just one kill in the first set, the Valkyries looked to get Adora Anae going early, and she helped get things started. A completely different tone from set one saw the Valkyries get off to a much better start, as both teams went back and forth, with Orlando getting up to as much as a four-point cushion at 17-13. Vegas would give Orlando a taste of their own medicine, as they were able to get hot at the right moment, taking a late lead and winning set two 25-23. Hannah Maddux would lead the Thrill with six kills.

Set 3

Making her first start at setter this season, Hannah Pukis got things started in a big way off a service ace, as the team would build on it to a 5-2 lead. Although the Valkyries started on fire, the Thrill quickly caught up, taking a 10-9 lead. However, after taking the lead, the Thrill would struggle to get anything going. Orlando responded by retaking the lead at 15-14, and would finish on a 10-0 run, cruising to a 25-14 victory. Just like set one, Brittany Abercrombie led all hitters with seven kills in set three.

Set 4

Building off the momentum going up 2-1 in the match, Orlando jumped out to a 4-0 lead, thanks to a pair of rookies providing some energy, a block by Norah Sis and a service ace from Natalie Foster. With Orlando getting up early, Vegas showed incredible resilience, as their backs were against the wall the entire set. They were able to take advantage of the Valkyries missed opportunities, soaring back out in front to a 16-12 lead. From that point on it became the Allison Mayfield and Hannah Maddux show, as Vegas forced a deciding set five with a set score of 25-21. Allison Mayfield would finish with five kills in set four.

Set 5

Set five ended in a wild finish as the Vegas Thrill ultimately won 15-12. Both teams went neck and neck with a score of 8-8. Orlando would call a timeout after Vegas went up by two, trying to slow down the attack and really get the team to respond as it was a race to 15 points. Vegas went on to win the match, improving to 3-1 on the year.
