MATCHDAY STORYLINES

- San Diego will play a second-straight road game and sixth of the season while Omaha will be hosting a match for just the fourth time this season and first time since a sweep of Columbus on January 31.
- Series History: The Mojo and Supernovas meet for the seventh time in series history and the second time in 2025 with both matchups taking place in Omaha. The overall series is tied 3-3, while the Mojo lead the regular-season series 3-2. San Diego came away with the victory the last time the teams met, winning 3-1 (20-25, 25-19, 25-22, 25-22), the first road win for either team in the series
- Return to Omaha: San Diego's victory in Omaha on January 19 is the only loss for the Novas at CHI Health Center this season.
- All-Stars in the House: The match will feature five players named to the Inaugural PVF All-Star Match. Mojo middle blocker Ronika Stone and libero Shara Venegas will represent San Diego, while Novas outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller, middle blocker Kaitlyn Hord and libero Camila Gómez will represent Indy. The match will take place on Saturday, February 22 and broadcast nationally on CBS.

SAN DIEGO MOJO OUTLOOK

- The San Diego Mojo fell in four sets to the Indy Ignite, 25-21, 25-14, 18-25, 25-15, at the Fishers Event Center on Thursday night.
- San Diego native Kendra Dahlke was stellar for the Mojo, leading the match with season highs of 24 points and 22 kills, hitting .327 on the night, while adding two aces and 11 digs for her sixth double-double of the season. The outside hitter has tallied double-digit kill efforts in a San Diego-record eight consecutive games, while her 22 kills are tied for sixth best in team history and the 24 points equaled the seventh-most for a Mojo player.
- Middle blocker Lauren Page scored nine points tallying four kills, four blocks and a service ace.
- Middle blockers Ronika Stone and Rainelle Jones each posted eight points with Stone collecting eight kills with a .412 hitting percentage, and Jones registering five kills, two blocks and a service ace.
- Setter DaYeong Lee led San Diego with 36 assists and added nine digs and outside hitter Elise McGhee had a career-best 10 digs in her second career start.
- San Diego has lost four-straight games, the longest losing streak in franchise history and just the third multi-game losing streak in team history.
- Dahlke continues to be one of the top players in the Pro Volleyball Federation in 2025, ranking third in kills per set (4.13) and fifth in points per set (4.42).
- Lee is fifth in the PVF in total assists with 339 total assists on the year and in assists per set averaging 10.27 per frame.
- Stone remains one of the most accurate attackers in the league, ranking eighth in the PVF this season with a .400 kill percentage, while also being a force in the middle, sitting 10th in total blocks (16) and blocks per set (0.48).
- In limited action this season, middle blocker Lauren Page has been a standout performer for the Mojo, totaling 10 blocks and 0.63 blocks per set, highlighted by two four-block games against Indy.
- Libero Shara Venegas has come up huge in court coverage, averaging 3.76 digs per set with 109 total digs on the season.

OMAHA SUPERNOVAS OUTLOOK

- The Supernovas enter the match having won two of three matches on their recent road trip, including backto-back wins over Indy and Atlanta.
- Outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller combined for 27 kills with a .361 hitting percentage in the two victories to go along with 27 digs.
- Reagan Cooper tallied 32 points in the two matches including a season-high 18 kills on a .357 hitting percentage versus the Vibe on Saturday.
- Middle blocker Kaitlyn Hord leads the PVF in total



blocks (29) and blocks per set (0.91), while ranking fifth in hitting percentage (.355).

- Reagan Cooper (4.24 points/set) and Brooke Nuneviller (4.18) are among the top scorers in the league.
- Setter Natalia Valentín-Anderson is sixth in the PVF in total assists (318) and assists per set (9.94).
- A trio of Omaha players rank in the top 10 in digs and digs per set. Camila Gómez leads the Novas and ranks second in the PVF with 131 digs and 3.97 per set. Valentín-Anderson is fourth with 3.75 digs per set and sixth with 120 total digs, and Nuneviller is seventh in total digs (119) and sixth in digs per set (3.61).

MOJO-SUPERNOVA CONNECTIONS

- San Diego libero Shara Venegas and Omaha setter Natalia Valentín-Anderson were teammates on the Puerto Rico National Team at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games, and played against each other in the Puerto Rico League from 2010-17 and 2021-23.
- Mojo middle blockers Ronika Stone and Lauren Page were teammates with the Novas' outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller at Oregon, while Tayyiba Haneef-Park was on the Ducks' staff as an assistant coach during Nuneviller's senior season in 2022.
- Outside hitter Kayla Luna spent three season at Pitt with Omaha's Vazquez Gomez for three seasons (2019-21).
- Middle blocker Rainelle Jones played alongside current Supernovas Kaitlyn Hord and Reagan Cooper while with the Columbus Fury during the 2024 PVF season.
- Outside hitter Jenaisya Moore and Omaha's Mac Podraza spent four seasons as teammates at Ohio State (2019-22).

MOJO ALL-STARS

- San Diego Mojo middle blocker Ronika Stone and libero Shara Venegas were named as the first-ever All-Star selections for the Mojo and will compete in the Inaugural All-Star Match on Saturday, Feb. 22 at Fishers Event Center in Indianapolis.
- Stone has played in and started all eight matches for the Mojo this season and is one of two San Diego players to appear in 29 sets. The San Jose, Calif. native has tallied 16 blocks, 54 kills and one service ace on the season for 71 total points, averaging 2.45 points per set, while also recording 36 digs and one assist. Her 16 blocks are tied for ninth in the PVF while her 0.55 blocks per set are seventh best in the league.
- Venegas has appeared in seven matches with seven starts and appeared in 25 sets. For the year, the Puerto Rico native has 100 digs, the 10th-most in the league, and 25 assists. She is averaging four digs per set, the second-highest ranking in the PVF.

HANEEF-PARK NAMED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM COACHING STAFF

- Mojo head coach Tayyiba Haneef-Park has been named to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching staff, USA Volleyball and head coach Erik Sullivan this week, as the team prepares for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games. She will continue leading the Mojo while serving as an assistant with Team USA.
- "I fell in love with the Olympics in the Los Angeles 1984 games," Haneef-Park said. "One of the greatest honors of my life has been to represent USA on that stage. I am deeply humbled and excited to work with Erik in this full circle moment and be a part of a podium push with this incredible staff and team for the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles."
- A three-time Olympian and two-time silver medalist (Beijing 2008, London 2012), Haneef-Park brings first-hand Olympic experience and a winning mentality to her new role. The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, she guided San Diego to the PVF Championship semifinals during the league's inaugural season.
- Prior to joining the Mojo, Haneef-Park held assistant coaching roles at Oregon and the Arizona, as well as extensive experience with USA Volleyball's National Team Development Program. Last year, she was an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's National Team that won silver at the NORCECA Pan Am Cup and NORCECA Final 6. In 2019, she led the U.S. Women to gold at the NORCECA Champions Cup. She was also an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's Collegiate Team from 2021-23.

DAHLKE DOES IT ALL

- Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke has started the season strong, posting five double-doubles in the first nine games of the season, besting her total from all of last season.
- Dahlke has totaled 128 kills this year, topping her total of 96 for the 2024 season, and has reached 100 points scored for the second-straight year, the first Mojo player with multiple 100-point seasons.
- The Fallbrook High alum has tallied at least 10 kills in each of the last eight matches, the longest streak in Mojo history.
- She has scored at least 13 points in each of the last eight games after scoring in double-digits in five games last season.
- Dahlke picked up her first double-double of the season in a win at Columbus, totaling 17 kills and 17 digs, then notched another one the following match with 14 kills and 18 digs versus Orlando. She added a third at defending PVF champion Omaha with a season-best 18 kills while tallying 12 digs, then picked up her fourth-straight (19 kills, 11 digs) in a home win over Indy.
- Dahlke has tallied six service aces this season including at least one in each of the last four games. She has posted two in each of the last two games.
- In 2024, she was among the top scorers for the Mojo, highlighted by a 23-point match at Orlando on April 14 that is the fifth-best scoring output in team history.
- Dahlke had 65 attacks in the Mojo's five-set win at Orlando on April 14, the most in a four-set match for the Mojo and the second-most overall.
- She also had 27 points in the victory, tied for the fourth-most in a match in Mojo history.

LEE COMMANDS THE FLOOR

- Veteran setter DaYeong Lee has made an immediate impact in her first year in the league, currently ranking fifth in total assists (339) and assists per set (10.27).
- The native of South Korea has tallied five double-doubles on the year, the fifthmost for a season and career in Mojo history.
- Lee has tallied 12 blocks this season, the eighth-most in a season in team history, while her 12 career blocks already rank as the seventh most.
- She had at least two blocks in five-straight games from January 19-30.
- In the Mojo's home win over Indy, Lee collected her fourth double-double of the season, tallying 45 assists and 12 digs, while also posting a pair of blocks and two kills in the Mojo's thrilling victory over first-place Indy.
- She averaged 11.25 assists and three digs per set, while leading an offense that had almost all of the Mojo hitters have their highest-rated efficiency performances.

STONE COLD

- Middle blocker Ronika Stone has been a force in the middle for the Mojo, racking up 16 blocks in the first eight games, including four on the road against Omaha.
- Stone's 67 career blocks are the most in Mojo history, while the 2025 All-Star's 16 this year are seventh-best in team history.
- Stone was selected by the league's coaches to the PVF Preseason All-League Team.
- She earned 2024 All-Pro Volleyball Federation Second Team honors after leading the league with league in a .336 hitting percentage.
- Last season, Stone equaled the team-record with three services aces in a victory over Omaha on April 2.

VENEGAS WITH THE COURT COVERAGE

- All-Star libero Shara Venegas has picked up right where she left off last season, ranking fifth in the league with 4.76 digs per set while collecting 109 digs.

- Her 12 digs marked her first outing with double-digits this season and the fourth of her PVF career.

TABRON TAKES CHARGE

- Rookie outside hitter Maya Tabron is off to a hot start in her professional career, notching double-figures in kills in each of her first three games and four overall, while twice leading the Mojo in scoring.
- The Gilroy, Calif. native tallied 10 kills in her debut against Orlando on January 9 and collected 14 in a road win at Columbus before posting a career-best 15 kills in her home debut against the Valkyries.

MCGHEE SHINES IN FIRST CAREER START

- Rookie outside hitter Elise McGhee impressed in her first career start against Vegas on February 7 at Viejas Arena.
- The San Antonio native had a team-leading 17 points, hitting .324 with 16 kills and one block.
- Her 17 points and 16 kills both established career highs, while also collecting six digs for the Mojo.
- The 16 kills also equaled a Mojo record for kills in a three-set match.

BLACKWELL BACK HOME

- Blackwell has been a consistent presence in the middle for the Mojo, starting all eight games this season and posting seven blocks in 22 sets.
- Prior to playing at Nebraska, rookie Leyla Blackwell helped guide the San Diego Toreros to the 2022 NCAA Semifinals.
- A native San Diegan, Blackwell was a three-time first-team All-WCC selection for the Toreros.

PITTMAN COMING UP ACES

- Middle blocker Regan Pittman has shown her versatility this season, opening the year as the starting opposite for the Mojo, but her impact has also been felt at the service line.
- Heading into San Diego's sixth match of the season, Pittman was tied for sixth in the league with four service aces.
- She picked up her first of the year in the season-opener at Orlando.
- Pittman tallied two aces in San Diego's win at Columbus, tied for the fourthmost in San Diego history and tied for the top mark in a four-set match.

LUND MAKES AN IMPACT

- Outside hitter Kayla Lund made her presence felt immediately for the Mojo, scoring the first point of the PVF season in the opener against Orlando.
- Lund went on to tie for a team-leading 10 kills, while also posting the most swings with 31. She tallied her first double-double of the season by adding 10 digs.



TAYYIBA **HANEEF-PARK**

HEAD COACH

The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, Tayyiba Haneef-Park is a three-time Olympian with the United States. Haneef-Park won silver with Team USA at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics.

Last season, Haneef-Park led the Mojo to a 13-11 regular-season record and No. 3 seed in the PVF playoffs in their first season. The club started 2-6 before winning 11 of its next 16 games to qualify for the postseason, falling one set short of reaching the championship match.

Prior to joining the Mojo, she spent 2022 as an assistant coach with Oregon Volleyball, during which the Ducks sported a 26-6 record, including a 17-3 mark in Pac-12 play. The 17 conference wins were a program record. Haneef-Park also spent two seasons (2015-16) as an assistant coach with Arizona Beach Volleyball, helping the Wildcats to a 38-10 record.

In addition to her Olympic performances, Haneef-Park contributed to notable achievements such as a gold medal at the 2012 FIVB World Grand Prix and bronze finishes at the 2003 and 2004 Grand Prix.

Haneef-Park played professionally for 11 years from 2001-12 with stops in Italy, Japan, Russia, Turkey and Azerbaijan. She began coaching in 2014, serving as an assistant on collegiate staffs with Arizona from 2014-16 and Oregon from 2022-23. She has also served as an assistant with various USA Volleyball teams during that time, but recently helping the United States win silver at the Pan American Cup in August and NORCECA Final Six in June.

Collegiately, Haneef-Park was a 2001 All-American at Long Beach State and helped The Beach to a national championship in 1998 and a runner-up finish in 2001. She also competed in track & field for Long Beach State and was a three-time All-American in the high jump.
