News, Notes & Numbers

- ⇒ The Orlando Valkyries will open the second half of the PVF season on a six-game winning streak, which is longest streak this season and the second-best in PVF history. Orlando's string began with a 3-0 win over Omaha on Febrary 2. Atlanta's seven-game winning streak from March 27-April 16, 2024 last season is the longest in league history.
- ⇒ The Indy Ignite's Sidney Hilley will return to action on Thursday in eighth place on the PVF single-season assists list with 510. Alisha Childress of the Vegas Thrill has also cracked the top 10 with 481 assists and sits in 10th place. Both Childress (No. 2, 976) and Hilley (No. 7, 592) already rank in the top 10 with their assist totals from 2024.
- ➡ Columbus' Kaley Rammelsberg tied the PVF record for aces in a set with four in the second set of the Fury's 3-1 win over the Vegas Thrill on February 17. Rammelsberg finished the match with five aces for the Fury, which is the second most by a player in a four-set match this season.

Mojo's Haneef-Park Naned to U.S. National Team Coaching Staff

San Diego Mojo head coach Tayyiba Haneef-Park has been named to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching staff, USA Volleyball and head coach Erik Sullivan announced, as the team prepares for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games. Haneef-Park will continue leading the Mojo while serving as an assistant with Team USA.

A three-time Olympian and two-time silver medalist (Beijing 2008, London 2012), Haneef-Park brings first-hand Olympic experience and a winning mentality to her new role. The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, she guided San Diego to the PVF Championship semifinals during the league's inaugural season.

Atlanta's Edmond, Orlando's Foster Reach Top Three on PVF Single-Season Aces List

Guedpard Equals PVF Three-Set Assists Record

Orlando's Chompoo Guedpard tied the PVF record for assists in a three-set match with 44 in the Valkyries' sweep of Omaha on February 2. The effort equaled the record set by Indy's Sydney Hilley against Grand Rapids on January 19 this season.

Leo Equals Single-Set Blocks Record

Columbus' Janice Leo tied the PVF record for blocks in a set with five against Grand Rapids in the third set of the Fury's 3-2 win over Grand Rapids on February 7. Alison Bastianelli set the record in 2024 with five blocks for San Diego in the fifth set of their match with Grand Rapids on May 4, 2024.

Maddux Joins 20-Point Club

Hannah Maddux became the third PVF player to record 20 points in a three-set match this season when she hit the mark in the Thrill's 3-0 win over San Diego on February 7. She joins Orlando's Brittany Abercrombie and Indy's Leketor Member-Meneh as the only 20-point scorers in such matches this season. The trio is tied for fourth on the PVF's all-time three-set points list.

Thrill Lead PVF In Five-Set Wins

With their 3-2 win over the Indy Ignite on Jan. 19, the Vegas Thrill is now 9-1 all-time in five-set matches. The Thrill is 4-0 this season and was 5-1 in such matches during the 2024 regular season. The nine wins are the most all-time by a PVF team in five-set matches.

Abercrombie Ties PVF Five-Set Kills Record

Orlando's Brittany Abercrombie tied the PVF five-set record for kills with 30 in the Valkyries' match at Vegas on Jan. 19. Teammate Lindsey Vander Weide set the record a season ago as a member of the San Diego Mojo in a match against Orlando on May 9, 2024.

Record-Setting Night For The Ignite

The Indy Ignite set or tied multiple team and individual PVF records in their 3-0 win over the Grand Rapids on Jan. 16. The Ignite set PVF team marks for assists in a three-set match (51) and kills in a set (24) and equaled the record for kills in a three-set match (55) set by Omaha in Week 1. Setter Sydney Hilley broke the PVF record for assists in a three-set match with 44 and tied the PVF record for assists in a set with 21 in the second set against the Rise.



Team Shondell Wins Inaugural PVF All-Star Match

The inaugural Pro Volleyball Federation All-Star Match lived up its billing, and then some. In front of a thrilled capacity crowd of 6,943 on Saturday at Fishers Event Center in Fishers, Indiana. The Team Shondell All-Stars, coached by Purdue University volleyball coach Dave Shondell, defeated Team Collier coached by Georgia Tech's Michelle Collier by a total point score of 58-47.


But the magnitude of the event reached far beyond the final score. The All-Star Match was the first women's pro volleyball match to be shown on a traditional American over-the-air network with PVF broadcast partner CBS. Those tuning in and in the stands were treated to a high-intensity match highlighting the extreme athleticism of the players competing.

"The level of play today, I thought was remarkable," winning coach Shondell said. "For them to go out and play with the intensity and focus and the cohesion, it was just fun to be a part of. It was just a thrill."

While the match was played in a traditional three-set format on the home court of the Indy Ignite, the winning team was determined by overall points.

After winning the first sets 25-22 and 25-20, Team Shondell needed only to reach eight points in the third set to clinch the victory. That came when Shondell's squad took an 8-5 lead to make the final score 58-47. The teams completed the third set anyway, with Team Shondell securing the sweep with a 15-10 triumph.

While the competitive spirit was high between the two teams, so was the level of enjoyment.



And that, after all, was the primary reason for this first of an expected many PVF All-Star Matches, to present the energy, athleticism and excitement of women's volleyball to an eager, growing audience.

"That's why this is so important," Team Shondell setter Alisha Childress of the Vegas Thrill said. "It's why having a league here in the U.S. is so important, it's why treating the league with the utmost respect and having an All-Star game and getting it on a major broadcast station on CBS (is important).

"We want to continue this not just this year, but for years and years to come. We feel that energy; we can feel that that's what we're doing here. We're older and we're playing, and to see the younger generation get to look up to us, it's our responsibility but it's one we take very seriously to make sure they see volleyball at a high level all the way."
