SERIES HISTORY: This is the seventh all-time meeting between Omaha and Columbus and the third of four matches in 2025. The Supernovas lead the all-time series 5-1 having won five in a row. Omaha has taken victory in the two matches this season by sweeps on January 24 in Columbus and January 31 at the CHI Health Center in Omaha. Dating back to last season, the Supernovas have swept the Fury in three consecutive matches.

SUPERNOVAS-FURY CONNECTIONS

There are numerous connections between the Supernovas and Fury as they face off for the third of four matches in 2025.

- ⇒ Supernovas Reagan Cooper and Kaitlyn Hord return to Columbus after playing for the Fury in the inaugural PVF season. Cooper was the PVF Rookie of the Year while Hord finished fourth in hitting percentage.
- ⇒ Omaha rookie Emily Londot returns to Columbus where she spent five seasons at Ohio State University where she garnered over 2,600 career points.
- ⇒ A batch of Puerto Ricans come together on the court on Friday night, which also extends to the coaching staffs. Omaha's Natalia Valentín-Anderson and Valeria Vazquez Gomez have played with Columbus' Paula Cerame and Wilma Rivera on the Puerto Rico National Team. Fury middle blocker Janice Leao, also heralds from Puerto Rico, but hasn't competed on the national team.
- ⇒ Plus, Columbus head coach Ángel Pérez coached against most of the Puerto Rican natives in the Puerto Rico League when he was with Changas de Naranjito (2016-2017) and Pinkin de Corozal (2019-2023).
- ⇒ Valentín-Anderson and Rivera were teammates for the 2021-2022 Puerto Rico League season as part of Valencianas de Juncos where they finished fourth.
- ⇒ The Supernovas setter also spent a brief time as teammates with Fury outside hitter Megan Courtney-Lush when they were with Leonas de Ponce for the 2015-2016 season when they placed third in the league standings.
- ⇒ Columbus opposite Morgan Lewis spent four seasons (2019-2022) with Supernovas outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller at Oregon.
- ⇒ Fury hitter Jill Gillen was originally drafted by the Supernovas at No. 8 overall in the 2023 PVF Draft, but was immediately traded to Orlando for the 2024 season.

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2024 PRO VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONS



From preseason favorites to first-ever Champions, the Omaha Supernovas took the pro volleyball world by storm in the Pro Volleyball Federation's inaugural season in 2024. The Supernovas swept the Grand Rapids Rise to claim the PVF Championship at the CHI Health Center in Omaha on May 18. Setter Sydney Hilley was named Postseason MVP after coming off the bench in leading Omaha to a reverse sweep of the San Diego Mojo in the semifinals before the championship sweep.

The championship win capped off a historic year for the Supernovas, who showed the hunger for professional volleyball in the United States, hosting the seven most-attended pro volleyball matches in U.S. history. That includes the U.S. record on March 16, 2024 with 12,090 fans watching Omaha beat the Orlando Valkyries 3-1. The Supernovas drew seven crowds of 10,000 people or more out of its 12 home matches. Omaha finished with the No. 1 average attendance mark in the world among pro volleyball teams with 9,656 fans per match. A total of 134,969 fans attended pro volleyball matches at the CHI Health Center in 2024, which also includes the 19,094 spectators who attended the PVF Semifinals and Championship.

The product on the court was equally as impressive with the Supernovas finishing 18-8 overall and a 9-3 mark at home. Star outside hitters Brooke Nuneviller and Bethania De La Cruz were named to the PVF All-League First Team while De La Cruz took home the PVF Server of the Year award after leading the league with 32 aces during the regular season. Bulgarian middle blocker Hristina Vuchkova missed the first three matches of the season, but arrived in Omaha to lead the league with 70 total blocks by season's end. She was also an All-League selection, being named to the second team.



CHI Health Center Omaha



Built for \$291 million and finished in the fall of 2003, CHI Health Center Omaha is a key element in the continued renovation and development of Omaha’s riverfront. The facility formerly known as Qwest Center Omaha (2003-11) and CenturyLink Center Omaha (2011-18) is located on a 421-acre site of the former Union Pacific Railroad yards, just a few blocks from Creighton’s campus, the historic Old Market and three miles from Eppley Airfield.

In 2018, CHI Health agreed to pay \$23.6 million over 20 years for the naming rights to the arena. Among the amenities at CHI Health Center Omaha are seven locker rooms, five dressing rooms and a media interview room. In the summer of 2023, a lighting upgrade project was completed. A \$6 million Daktronics, Inc., scoreboard hangs from the arena center. The scoreboard is more than 26 feet in height and approximately 32 feet in diameter. The scoreboard was upgraded in the summer of 2013 and is one of the nation’s finest, as CHI Health Center Omaha is one of the nation’s only arenas to have 4 mm and 6 mm pixel configurations to give fans significantly better resolution

Twelve permanent concession stands and 20 free-standing kiosks help feed and quench thirst for crowds of up to 18,300 for volleyball matches.

CHI Health Center Omaha provides more than 194,000 square feet of exhibition space, and the exhibit hall can hold dinners for up to 15,000 people at once. Downtown Omaha’s 40-story First National Bank Tower could be laid down inside the length of the exhibit space.

Funding for CHI Health Center Omaha came from private donations, taxes and projected revenue from the facility. The facility has hosted some of America’s top sporting events, including the NCAA Men’s Basketball Championships (2008, 2012, 2015, 2018 and 2024), NCAA Volleyball Championships (2006, 2008, 2015, 2020 and 2022), U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Swimming (2008, 2012, 2016 and 2021), NCAA Wrestling Finals (2010), the U.S. Figure Skating Championships (2013) as well as four title fights for boxing champion Terence Crawford.

The facility has also hosted concerts by artists such as *The Eagles*, *Justin Timberlake*, *Lady Gaga*, *Katy Perry*, *Taylor Swift*, *ZZ Top*, *Prince*, *Bruce Springsteen*, *Dave Matthews Band*, *Billy Joel*, *The Rolling Stones*, *Paul McCartney*, *Aerosmith*, *Luke Bryan*, *Travis Scott*, *Britney Spears*, *Justin Bieber*, *Alan Jackson*, *U2*, *KISS*, *Jimmy Buffett* and *Garth Brooks*.

More than 1,700 new seats were added to the upper deck on the north side of the building during the summer of 2006, expanding capacity. Located one block northwest of CHI Health Center Omaha is Charles Schwab Field Omaha, which opened in 2011 as the home of Creighton baseball and the NCAA Men’s College World Series.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Coming off its championship-winning season, the Supernovas were voted third in the PVF Preseason Poll, receiving one of the eight first-place votes. Both the poll and all-league teams were voted by the league head coaches, who weren't allowed to vote for their own team and players.
- Omaha will have the top outside hitter duo entering the 2025 season with 2024 All-League First Team Selection Brooke Nuneviller and PVF Rookie of the Year Reagan Cooper who were both voted to the Preseason All-League Team.

PEDIGREE OF GREATNESS

- Aside from winning their own league title, the 2025 Supernovas field a roster full of championship experience and individual stardom dating back to their college days. This season's roster has combined for the following:
 - Nine NCAA Volleyball National Championships, Semifinal and Championship Appearances. Middle blocker Kayla Caffey won the 2022 title with Texas in her final year of college at the CHI Health Center, securing the first of back-to-back Longhorn championships. Outside hitter Valeria Vazquez Gomez leads the team in semifinal appearances, helping Pittsburgh reach four-straight national semifinals from 2021 to 2024.
 - 12 conference titles. Vazquez Gomez and setter Kendra Wait are tied for the most on the

Supernovas with four. Vazquez Gomez won four ACC titles while Wait helped Creighton to Big East championships in all four of her college seasons.

- 27 AVCA All-American honors spread across 14 Supernovas. Seven of those earning multiple honors including Wait [4], Nuneviller [4], Kaitlyn Hord [4], Mac Podraza [3], Emily Londot [3] and Kelsie Payne [3].

WELCOME BACK TO THE GOOD LIFE

- Six Supernovas on the 2025 roster have college connections within the state. Four having played at Nebraska and two at Creighton.
- Lindsay Krause, Ally Batenhorst, Kayla Caffey and Kaitlyn Hord were all Huskers under head coach John Cook, but Krause was the only one to play all four seasons at NU [2021-2024].
- Krause and Batenhorst have the longest teammate history as Huskers from 2021 to 2023. Caffey [2021] and Hord [2022] joined that duo as teammates for one year each.
- Wait and libero Allison Whitten each played for Creighton under head coach Kirsten Bernthal Booth. Wait spent all four seasons in Omaha while Whitten joined the Bluejays for her final year in 2022, where she and Wait shared the floor as starters.

CARRYING THE CHAMPIONSHIP TORCH

- Two Supernovas from the inaugural championship-winning team return to Omaha for the 2025 season. That includes outside hitter Nuneviller and setter Natalia Valentin'-Anderson.
- Nuneviller was a pillar on the 2024 team, making her a priority in the free agency period over the summer. The Oregon alum showcased her two-way play en route to PVF All-League First Team honors. She recorded 3.33 kills [8th in PVF] and 3.32 digs [6th] per set, including the previous franchise record for most digs in a single match with 22.
- Nuneviller was also the first player in franchise history to be named PVF Player of the Week [March 12]. Plus, she's currently the all-time franchise leader in kills, kills per set attacks and digs.
- Valentin'-Anderson shared time as a starter in 2024, but quickly established herself as one of the best defensive setters in the league. The Puerto Rico Olympian averaged 8.60 assists and 2.87 digs per set in 21 matches, highlighted by her PVF Player of the Week honor after averaging over 12 assists and four digs per set in two matches. Her defense was put on national display when her incredible two-dig save against the Vegas Thrill on May 6 was featured No. 2 on SportCenter's Top 10 Plays.

ROCK, CHALK JAYHAWK

- Much like its ties to Nebraska, the 2025 Supernovas draw several connections with Kansas.
- Opposite Kelsie Payne, outside hitter Reagan Cooper and middle blocker Toyosi Onabanjo each finished their college careers at KU. Cooper and Onabanjo spent time together as teammates for the 2023 season while Wait heralds from the Sunflower State.

- All three former Jayhawks received All-American honors in Lawrence with Payne leading the way with two first team honors [2016, 2015] and a third team nod [2017]. Cooper made the third team [2023] in her lone season with KU while Onabanjo was named an honorable mention in 2024 after averaging 2.58 kills and 1.23 blocks per set.
- Omaha head coach Laura "Bird" Kuhn made her name known in the coaching ranks at Kansas from 2011-2017, winning the 2015 AVCA Assistant Coach of the Year after KU made its first-ever National Semifinal in school history.
- Supernovas Team President Diane Mendenhall earned her bachelor's degree from Kansas while being a four-year starter for the Jayhawks.

THE FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

- Omaha will see the pro debut of eight rookies in 2025: MB Phoebe Awolaye, OH Ally Batenhorst, OH Lindsay Krause, OPP Emily Londot, MB Toyosi Onabanjo, OH Valeria Vazquez Gomez, S Kendra Wait and L Allison Whitten.
- Kayla Caffey, Reagan Cooper, Kaitlyn Hord, Brooke Nuneviller and Mac Podraza are either entering their second or third season as pros.
- In total, 13 of the 16 players on the Supernovas have three years or fewer of professional seasons under their belt.
- Natalia Valentín-Anderson is the clubhouse leader with 16 years of professional experience followed by Kelsie Payne (6 years) and Camila Gómez (4 years).

HORDING THE NET

- Hord has been the premier blocker in the PVF so far in the 2025 season.
- The former Husker and Nittany Lion leads the league in both total blocks [45] and blocks per set with a 1.00 mark.
- Hord's seven blocks in the five-set win over the Atlanta Vibe on opening night set a Supernovas single-match record. She is also one of five players in the PVF to record seven or more blocks in a match this season.
- The Kentucky native also sits sixth in hitting percentage with a .345 clip through 142 attacks with 55 kills and only six errors.

A'NUNE"THHER LEVEL

- After averaging over 12 kills and digs per match last season, Supernovas outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller has raised her game for the 2025 season.
- Nuneviller enters Wednesday third in the PVF in kills per set [3.89], third in kills [179], and fourth in total points [192].
- The Chandler, Arizona native is one of only four players in the league this season to record 20+ kills and 15+ digs in a match. That was on opening night against Atlanta when she poured in 22 kills and 17 digs while hitting .340.
- The Oregon product has been averaging 13.8 kills and 13.2 digs per match through 13 contests this season.
- Nuneviller's 16-kill outing last time out against Indy tied the franchise record for most kills in a three-set match.
- Sunday's sweep over the Ignite marked the

fifth time in the last six matches Nuneviller has notched double-digit kills and recorded a clip of above .300.

NUNEVILLER SHINES IN ALL-STAR MATCH

- Brooke Nuneviller dominated the inaugural PVF All-Star match on Feb. 22 in Indy. The outside hitter poured in a match-high 13 points with 11 kills on a .391 hitting percentage while adding six digs, one ace and one block.
- The Oregon product posted nine of her 13 points in the opening set with seven kills on a .417 clip while chipping in her lone block and ace.
- Fellow Supernovas All-Stars Kaitlyn Hord and Camila Gómez also made their presence felt.
- Hord started in the final two sets, delivering two kills on four swings for a pair of points. Gómez took the court in the first and third sets, contributing six digs and three assists.

THE DIG PATROL

- The Supernovas have been one of the best defensive teams in the league as they sit second in the PVF in digs per set [16.78] and sixth in total digs [772].
- Gómez leads that effort with a team-high 174 digs [T-2nd in PVF] and 3.78 per set [3rd]. Her 31 digs against Atlanta in the season opener broke a single-match franchise record. That number is also tied for second in most digs during a single match in PVF history.
- Nuneviller, who is a former libero, is fourth in the league in both total digs [171] and digs per set with a 3.77 mark. She leads all PVF attackers in both categories.
- Valentín-Anderson is fifth in the league and leads all PVF setters with 155 total digs and 3.44 digs per set. She's recorded at least 10 digs in 10 of the 13 contests this season including a season-high 21 against San Diego on Jan. 19th.

THE COOPER CURVE

- 2024 PVF Rookie of the Year Reagan Cooper has recorded a team-leading 10 aces [T-5th in PVF] and 0.24 per set [5th]. The second-year pro has already surpassed her rookie year total when she had eight aces in 82 sets last year in Columbus.
- Cooper became the first Supernovas player to put down an ace in three or more consecutive matches since Bethania De La Cruz did so in seven straight matches last year. Cooper recorded an ace in the first six matches of the 2025 season.
- Cooper is still a dangerous attacker, posting 3.54 kills per set [T-5th in PVF] while her 153 total kills is 10th. Her 171 points on the season is also 10th among all players in the league.
- Cooper's 10-kill performance in Sunday's sweep over Indy was the seventh-straight match that she totaled at least 10 kills. She's also posted a hitting percentage above .300 in five of the seven contests.

DIG, KILL, REPEAT

- Nuneviller's 22-kill, 17-dig performance was her fourth PVF match with at least 20 kills and 15 digs, which is the most in PVF history. Teammate Reagan Cooper has achieved those marks three times, which ties her for

second in achieving that stat line.

- There have been 27 league performances with at least 20 kills and 15 digs. Supernovas players have tallied for eight of those 26. Aside from Nuneviller and Cooper, former opposite Stephanie Samedy produced those numbers with a 21-kill, 18-dig match against Grand Rapids on April 26, 2024.

LONDOT AND LOADED

- Since rookie opposite Emily Londot has entered the starting lineup on Feb. 6 at Indy, the Supernovas have rolled off wins in five of their last six matches.
- During that stretch, Londot has recorded 81 points [4.05 P/S], 62 kills [3.10 K/S], 54 digs [2.70 D/S] and 17 blocks [0.85 B/S] in 20 sets.
- Her best match came in the four-set win at San Diego on Feb. 20 when she finished with a match-high 22 points on 18 kills, 11 digs, four blocks and one assist.

DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE

- The Supernovas lead the league in opponent efficiency with a .195 clip - 25 points lower than second-place Grand Rapids [.220].
- Part of that clip comes from the two matches against Columbus when the Fury hit .015 & .036 in back-to-back matches vs. Omaha on January 24 and January 31.
- The Supernovas are also one of the best blocking teams in the PVF, which is spearheaded by Hord's league-leading total of 45 blocks. Omaha averages 2.67 blocks per set, which is second in the league while its 123 total blocks sits third.

OFFENSIVE BLASTOFF

- The Omaha Supernovas offense has formed into one of the most efficient units in the PVF with a .236 team hitting percentage which is third in the league.
- Omaha has posted hitting percentages of .250 or above in eight of the 13 matches this season. The Supernovas offense reached that mark only nine times across the entire 2024 season.
- There's only been five times in franchise history that the Supernovas have recorded a team hitting percentage of .300 or above. Two of those instances have come during the 2025 season which includes a .309 clip in Omaha's sweep over Indy on Feb. 6 and a .321 hitting percentage against Orlando on Feb. 27.

ROAD WARRIORS

- The Supernovas have the biggest home court advantage in professional volleyball, but they've also been mighty on the road. That includes the league's best road record at 5-2. Omaha and Orlando [4-3] are the only teams in the PVF to have a road record at .500 or above.
- The Supernovas go into Wednesday with a three-match winning streak on the road, which dates back to Feb. 6 at Indy. That winning streak equals the franchise record. Omaha won three consecutive road matches from Feb. 25 to March 9 in 2024 with wins over Atlanta and Orlando [twice].

The Omaha Supernovas continue to show the growing interest and passion of pro volleyball, resetting the U.S. Pro Volleyball Attendance Record with 13,486 cheering on the Supernovas for the 2025 season opener at the CHI Health Center.

Omaha broke its own attendance record from a season ago when 12,090 packed into CHI on March 16, 2024, to see the Supernovas beat the Orlando Valkyries 3-1. As we look ahead, we remain committed to raising the bar and delivering a major league volleyball experience that inspires the next generation athletes and fans."

"Breaking another U.S. Pro Volleyball record underscores the growing hunger for this sport and the impact it's making on a major-league level. We're proud to be at the forefront of this growth, showing what's possible when passion meets opportunity, and we're excited to keep elevating the game for our fans and the sport as a whole."
