#### **VIBE VS THRILL RECAP ON 3/7**

The Atlanta Vibe secured a thrilling 3-2 victory over the Vegas Thrill at Gas South Arena on March 7, 2025, improving their season record to 7-8. After dominating the first two sets, the Vibe saw the Thrill tie the match at 2-2, but fought back to win the decisive fifth set 15-13. Atlanta's offense was led by Leah Edmond with 25 kills, while Pia Timmer added 14 kills and hit .419. Khori Louis contributed 11 kills, maintaining the best kill percentage in the league at .407. Defensively, libero Morgan Hentz posted a team-high 18 digs to seal the win.

#### **INDY VERSUS ATLANTA STAT COMPARISON**

Offensively, the Vibe are ranked third in the league for kill percentage, averaging .370, while the Ignite are first in the league with .381. Defensively, the Ignite and Vibe share the exact same digs per set average on the season, totaling 16.38 digs per set, being tied for third highest in the league. In aces on the season, with the Vibe total 68, ranked second in the league, while the Ignite total 51, ranked fourth in the league. As for assists, Atlanta holds the third highest assists per set with 12.70 and the Ignite are second averaging 13.15 assists per set.
