### MATCHDAY STORYLINES

- San Diego and Grand Rapids will meet for the third time this season and second time at Van Andel Arena. The teams have split the season series so far, each winning on their home court with the Rise winning by sweep on Feb. 2 and the Mojo winning in four sets last Thursday, Feb. 27.
- In last week's meeting, the Mojo had a season-high 16 blocks in the win, equaling the fourth-most in franchise history, and held the Rise to a .086 hitting percentage.
- The Mojo and Rise will meet twice this week, as both squads will head back to SoCal this weekend for a 4 p.m. first serve at Viejas Arena on Sunday, March 9.
- San Diego lead the all-time series 4-2 with a 1-2 mark as the visitor. The Rise have won the last two meetings in Grand Rapids, taking both matchups in three set.

SAN DIEGO MOJO OUTLOOK

• San Diego arrive in Grand Rapids winners of two-straight matches, including a four-set victory over the Rise on February 27. Last time out, the Mojo defeated the Columbus Fury in four sets, 20-25, 25-16, 25-15, 25-22, on Saturday night at Viejas Arena to remain undefeated in six matches against the Fury.

• Middle blocker Regan Pittman registered another stellar outing with a team-high 18 points with season highs of 11 kills and seven blocks, while hitting .435 on the night and contributing six digs and one assist. The seven blocks were a Mojo season best and equaled the second-most in a game in franchise history.

• Ronika Stone had an outstanding all-around performance, posting a season-high 12 kills with a .440 hitting percentage to go along with two aces, two blocks and four digs.

• Outside hitter Elise McGhee has developed into a reliable option off the bench, providing 13 points on 11 kills, one block and two service aces.

• Setter DaYeong Lee extended her double-double streak to three games, her eighth of the year, with 49 assists and 11 digs. Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke had nine kills and a team-high 17 digs, and libero Shara Venegas had 15 digs.

• Dahlke has been one of the top players in the Pro Volleyball Federation in 2025, ranking fourth in kills per set (3.80) and seventh in points per set (4.11).

• Lee is fourth in the PVF in total assists with 490 total assists on the year and is tied in assists per set averaging 10.43 per frame.

• Stone remains a force among middle blockers in the league, ranking sixth in the league in total blocks (26) and ninth in blocks per set (0.54) while also being a scoring precense with a 40.2% kill percentage, also the ninth-best mark in the league.

• Lauren Page has been a standout performer for the Mojo, totaling 12 blocks and 0.44 blocks per set, highlighted by a pair of four-block games against Indy.

• Venegas has come up huge in court coverage, averaging 3.95 digs per set, the second-best mark in the PVF, with 174 total digs on the season that rank third in the league.

• Pittman has also been among the best middles in the league, totaling 19 blocks with a 0.76 per set average, the third-best average in the league. She has also collected six aces on the year and is averaging 0.24 aces per set, the fourth-best mark in the league.

GRAND RAPIDS RISE OUTLOOK

• Grand Rapids Rise put on a show in Vegas in their last game, sweeping the Thrill at Lee's Family Forum on Sunday and setting a PVF record 18 blocks in a three-match set.

• The Rise were led by outside hitter Erika Pritchard, who was playing out of position at opposite hitter, who topped all scorers with 16 points on 14 kills and two

blocks while sporting .267 hitting percentage.

- The win snapped a five-match losing streak for Grand Rapids.
- Grand Rapids lead the PVF with 148 total blocks and 2.90 blocks per set, guided by two of the top middles in the league as Ali Bastianelli ranks second in the PVF with 40 total blocks and Marin Grote is 10th with 22.

#### MOJO-RISE CONNECTIONS

- Mojo setter/libero Sarah Sponcil will face her former Grand Rapids Rise teammates for the third time and the second time in Michigan, while former Mojo middle blocker Ali Bastianelli and setter August Raskie are starters for the Rise.
- San Diego middle blockers Ronika Stone (2016-18) and Lauren Page (2015-18) were teammates with Raskie while at Oregon, while Stone and Raskie both helped guide the Mojo to the 2024 PVF Championship semifinals.
- Middle blocker Rainelle Jones and outside hitter Jenaisya Moore were teammates last season with Rise libero Valeria León when the trio were with the Columbus Fury.
- Jones also played three seasons at Maryland (2018-20) with Rise outside hitter Erika Pritchard.
- Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke was a teammate of León at Leonas de Ponce in Puerto Rico during the 2020-21 season.
- Rookie outside hitter Maya Tabron played with Rise rookie opposite Naya Shime last season at SMU.

#### HANEEF-PARK NAMED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM COACHING STAFF

- Mojo head coach Tayyiba Haneef-Park has been named to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching staff, USA Volleyball and head coach Erik Sullivan this week, as the team prepares for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games. She will continue leading the Mojo while serving as an assistant with Team USA.

**"I fell in love with the Olympics in the Los Angeles 1984 games," Haneef-Park said. "One of the greatest honors of my life has been to represent USA on that stage. I am deeply humbled and excited to work with Erik in this full circle moment and be a part of a podium push with this incredible staff and team for the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles."**

- A three-time Olympian and two-time silver medalist (Beijing 2008, London 2012), Haneef-Park brings first-hand Olympic experience and a winning mentality to her new role. The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, she guided San Diego to the PVF Championship semifinals during the league's inaugural season.
- Prior to joining the Mojo, Haneef-Park held assistant coaching roles at Oregon and the Arizona, as well as extensive experience with USA Volleyball's National Team Development Program. Last year, she was an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's National Team that won silver at the NORCECA Pan Am Cup and NORCECA Final 6. In 2019, she led the U.S. Women to gold at the NORCECA Champions Cup. She was also an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's Collegiate Team from 2021-23.

#### MOJO ALL-STARS

- San Diego Mojo middle blocker Ronika Stone and libero Shara Venegas were named as the first-ever All-Star selections for the Mojo, competing in the inaugural Pro Volleyball Federation All-Star Match on Saturday, Feb. 22 at Fishers Event Center in Indianapolis.
- Venegas helped Team Shondell win the first-ever PVF All-Star Match, topping Ronika Stone and Team Collier before a sellout crowd at the 7,500-seat Fishers Event Center on Saturday afternoon.
- The match was scored based on total points over three sets. Team Shondell, coached by long-time Purdue head coach Dave Shondell, won by set scores of 25-22, 25-20, 15-10 (65-52 total points) over Team Collier, coached by Georgia Tech head coach Michelle Collier.
- Venegas had two digs and an assist in the winning effort, and Stone registered three points with two kills and one block while also contributing one dig.



## DAHLKE DOES IT ALL

- Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke has started the season strong, posting seven double-doubles in the first 13 games of the season, far exceeding the two she registered last season.
- Dahlke has totaled 171 kills this year, topping her total of 96 for the 2024 season, and has scored 185 points. It marks her second-straight year with 100 points, the first Mojo player with multiple 100-point seasons.
- The Fallbrook High alum tallied at least 10 kills eight-straight matches earlier this season, the longest streak in Mojo history. All told, she has 10 double-digit kill performances this season.
- She has scored at least 13 points in 10 games after scoring in double-digits in five games last season.
- Her seven double-doubles on the year are more than three times as many as the two she tallied in all of 2024.
- Dahlke picked up her first double-double of the season in a win at Columbus, totaling 17 kills and 17 digs, then notched another one the following match with 14 kills and 18 digs versus Orlando. She added a third at defending PVF champion Omaha with a season-best 18 kills while tallying 12 digs, then picked up her fourth-straight (19 kills, 11 digs) in a home win over Indy.
- Dahlke has recorded seven service aces this season including at least one in five of the last seven games with a pair of two-ace performances.
- In 2024, she was among the top scorers for the Mojo, highlighted by a 23-point match at Orlando on April 14 that is the fifth-best scoring output in team history.
- Dahlke had 65 attacks in the Mojo's five-set win at Orlando on April 14, the most in a four-set match for the Mojo and the second-most overall.
- She also had 27 points in the victory, tied for the fourth-most in a match in Mojo history.

## LEE COMMANDS THE FLOOR

- Veteran setter DaYeong Lee has made an immediate impact in her first year in the league, currently ranking in the top four in assists per set (10.43/fifth) and total assists (490/4th).
- The native of South Korea has tallied eight double-doubles on the year, the third-most in a season and fourth-most in a career in Mojo history.
- Lee has tallied 15 blocks this season, the ninth-most in a season and career in team history.
- She had at least two blocks in five-straight games from January 19-30.
- In the Mojo's home win over Indy, Lee collected her fourth double-double of the season, tallying 45 assists and 12 digs, while also posting a pair of blocks and two kills in the Mojo's thrilling victory over first-place Indy.
- She averaged 11.25 assists and three digs per set in the match, while leading an offense that had almost all of the Mojo hitters have their highest-rated efficiency performances.

## STONE COLD

- Middle blocker Ronika Stone has been a force in the middle for the Mojo, racking up 26 blocks in the first 16 games, including four in the first road matchup against Omaha.
- Stone's 77 career blocks are the most in Mojo history, while the 2025 All-Star's 26 this year are the sixth-most in a single-season mark team history.
- Stone was selected by the league's coaches to the PVF Preseason All-League Team.
- She earned 2024 All-Pro Volleyball Federation Second Team honors after leading the league with league in a .336 hitting percentage.
- Last season, Stone equaled the team-record with three services aces in a victory over Omaha on April 2.

## VENEGAS WITH THE COURT COVERAGE

- All-Star libero Shara Venegas has picked up right where she left off last season, ranking second in the league with 3.95 digs per set while collecting 175 digs.
- She has had at least 13 digs in 10 of 12 matches played, including a 16-dig performance against Vegas on Feb. 7 that are the most-ever for a Mojo player in a three-set match.



- Venegas collected 23 digs against Omaha at Viejas Arena on Feb. 20, equaling her best total with the Mojo.
- The 23 digs tied her mark for the second-most in San Diego history, a feat she accomplished twice in 2024. The previous two times also occurred at home against Omaha.
- Last year, she led the Mojo last season and was fourth in the league with 345 total digs and ranked second on the team with 3.63 digs per set.
- She had season highs of 23 digs against Omaha on April 2 and April 23.
- Her 23 digs against Omaha on April 2 occurred in a four-set match.

## PITTMAN COMING UP ACES

- Middle blocker Regan Pittman was dominant last week leading the Mojo to back-to-back home victories against Grand Rapids and Columbus in her return to the court following a six-game absence.
- Last Thursday against the Grand Rapids Rise, Pittman had match highs of 20 points and six blocks and added 12 kills and two service aces to top the Rise and end the visitors' three-match winning streak. She had a .417 hitting percentage and a 50% kill percentage in the win while adding six digs and one assist.
- Two days later against the Columbus Fury, Pittman registered a co-match-leading 18 points courtesy of 11 kills on 23 swings for a .435 hitting percentage, while also recording seven blocks, tied for the second-most blocks in a match in team history. Her seven blocks are tied for the third-most in a game this season in the PVF and are the most by a player since February 2. She also contributed six digs and one assist.
- Across the two matches, Pittman scored 38 points with 23 kills, 13 blocks and two service aces while adding 12 digs and two assists. Her 13 blocks over a two-game stretch are the third-most in Mojo history, one shy of the 14 accomplished twice by Ali Bastianelli during the 2024 season.
- Pittman had a .430 hitting percentage in the two wins with a 49% kill percentage. Her seven blocks against the Fury were the most of any player in a single game in the PVF during week the week and her 13 blocks for the week led all players, while her 20-point and 18-point performances each ranked in the Top 7 for week eight. She appeared in all eight sets the Mojo played across the two matches with per set averages of 4.75 points, 2.88 kills and an impressive 1.63 blocks.
- She has also been a force at the service line, collecting six aces in 25 sets played, averaging 0.24 aces per set.
- Pittman has twice tallied two aces in a match this season, at Columbus on January 11 and against Grand Rapids on February 27. The mark equaled the

fourth-most in San Diego history and tied for the top mark in a four-set match.

#### **GIMMIE MOORE**

- Outside hitter Jenaisya Moore had a career day for the Mojo in San Diego's four-set victory over Indy on Jan. 24.
- Moore had a Mojo season-high 24 points, collecting her first double-double of the season with 20 kills and 12 digs.
- The 24 points and 20 kills established career highs, while also posting a career best with three blocks and adding a service ace -- which equaled a personal best.
- Moore's 24 points in the match are the seventh-most in Mojo history and the 20 kills are tied for 10th.
- Her 12 digs marked her first outing with double-digits this season and the fourth of her PVF career.
- She added a second double-double against the Omaha Supernovas on February 20 with 12 kills and 11 digs, scoring 14 points in the effort.

#### **PAGING PAGE**

- Middle blocker Lauren Page has been a beast on defense while also contributing as an opposite.
- The Chino, Calif. native has posted 12 blocks on the year, the 10th-best single season mark in Mojo history, while averaging 0.44 blocks per set.
- She tallied her first double-double of the year on February 20 against Omaha, collecting 11 kills and 12 digs in the match at Viejas Arena.

#### **TABRON TAKES CHARGE**

- Rookie outside hitter Maya Tabron is off to a hot start in her professional career, notching double-figures in kills in each of her first three games and four overall, while twice leading the Mojo in scoring.
- The Gilroy, Calif. native tallied 10 kills in her debut against Orlando on January 9 and collected 14 in a road win at Columbus before posting a career-best 15 kills in her home debut against the Valkyries.

#### **BLACKWELL BACK HOME**

- Rookie middle blocker Leyla Blackwell has been a consistent presence in the middle for the Mojo, starting eight games this season and posting 10 blocks in 26 sets.
- The San Diego native's 10 blocks are already the 10th-most in a career for a Mojo player and her 0.38 blocks per set ranks as the seventh-best.
- Prior to playing at Nebraska, Blackwell helped guide the San Diego Toreros to the 2022 NCAA Semifinals.
- Blackwell was a three-time first-team All-WCC selection for the Toreros.

#### **MCGHEE SHINES IN FIRST CAREER START**

- Rookie outside hitter Elise McGhee impressed in her first career start against Vegas on February 7 at Viejas Arena.
- The San Antonio native had a team-leading 17 points, hitting .324 with 16 kills and one block.
- Her 17 points and 16 kills both established career highs, while also collecting six digs for the Mojo.
- The 16 kills also equaled a Mojo record for kills in a three-set match.

#### **LUND MAKES AN IMPACT**

- Outside hitter Kayla Lund made her presence felt immediately for the Mojo, scoring the first point of the PVF season in the opener against Orlando.
- Lund went on to tie for a team-leading 10 kills, while also posting the most swings with 31. She tallied her first double-double of the season by adding 10 digs.
- She led the way for the Mojo once again in a road matchup at Omaha on Feb. 16, leading the team with 11 points and 10 kills.

#### **CALIFORNIA LOVE**

- Six Mojo players are native Californians, the most players to hail from a single state on any roster in the Pro Volleyball Federation and the most to play in their home state.
- The Mojo roster includes San Diegan locals Kendra Dahlke (Bonsall, Calif./

Fallbrook HS) and Leyla Blackwell (San Diego, Calif./La Jolla HS/USD).

- Kayla Lund (Pasadena, Calif.) and Lauren Page (Chino, Calif.) are SoCal natives, while Ronika Stone (San Jose, Calif.) and Maya Tabron (Gilroy, Calif.) are NorCal natives.
- Sarah Sponcil also has Golden State ties, having played as a graduate student at UCLA.

#### **TEAMMATES ONCE AGAIN**

- Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke and middle blocker Lauren Page were previously teammates during their club days, competing with Coast Volleyball Club prior to their collegiate careers.
- During their senior year of club in 2015, the duo helped Coast Volleyball Club win bronze at the Junior Olympics in New Orleans.
- Page was also a college teammate of middle blocker Ronika Stone for three seasons at Oregon from 2016-18.
- While at Oregon, Page and Stone helped the Ducks go a combined 62-33 (.653) with three appearances in the NCAA Tournament, including an Elite Eight run in 2018.
- Rainelle Jones and Jenaisya Moore were teammates at Metro Volleyball Club in Washington, D.C., helping lead the team to two nationals appearances.

#### **ROOKIES MAKING THEIR MARK**

- Three Mojo rookies made their professional debuts in the season opener against Orlando.
- Outside hitter Maya Tabron started tied for the team lead with 10 kills while also adding eight digs.
- Middle blocker Leyla Blackwell also started, collecting seven kills and hitting a team-high .417.
- Elise McGhee entered in the second set and played two frames in her first professional appearance.

#### **OLYMPIC REPRESENTATION**

- A pair of Mojo players have represented their nation in the Olympic Games.
- Libero Shara Venegas competed with Puerto Rico at the 2016 Olympic Games Rio, the first team in the history of Puerto Rico volleyball to play in the Olympic games.

- Dahlke has served as an assistant coach at UC Davis for the last three seasons, helping the Aggies to a 19-10 record in 2024, the most for the program since 2011.
- Lund began kicked off her coaching career as an assistant at Brown University, helping second-year coach Taylor Virtue guide the team to a fourth-place finish in the Ivy League.

# TAYYIBA HANEEF-PARK

## HEAD COACH

The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, Tayyiba Haneef-Park is a three-time Olympian with the United States. Haneef-Park won silver with Team USA at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics.

Last season, Haneef-Park led the Mojo to a 13-11 regular-season record and No. 3 seed in the PVF playoffs in their first season. The club started 2-6 before winning 11 of its next 16 games to qualify for the postseason, falling one set short of reaching the championship match.

Prior to joining the Mojo, she spent 2022 as an assistant coach with Oregon Volleyball, during which the Ducks sported a 26-6 record, including a 17-3 mark in Pac-12 play. The 17 conference wins were a program record. Haneef-Park also spent two seasons (2015-16) as an assistant coach with Arizona Beach Volleyball, helping the Wildcats to a 38-10 record.

She began coaching in 2014, serving as an assistant on collegiate staffs with Arizona from 2014-16 and Oregon from 2022-23. She has also served as an assistant with various USA Volleyball teams during that time, but recently helping the United States win silver at the Pan American Cup in August and NORCECA Final Six in June.

Collegiately, Haneef-Park was a 2001 All-American at Long Beach State and helped The Beach to a national championship in 1998 and a runner-up finish in 2001. She also competed in track & field for Long Beach State and was a three-time All-American in the high jump.
