


MATCH NOTES

Match 15 Omaha Supernovas (10-4) at Indy Ignite (8-7)






SERIES HISTORY: This is the third all-time meeting between Omaha and Indy with the Supernovas leading the series 2-0. Omaha has won six consecutive sets against the Ignite, sweeping Indy in a pair of matches on Feb. 6 in Indy and March 2 in Omaha. The Supernovas return to the Fishers Event Center after handing the Ignite their first home loss in franchise history.

SERIES HISTORY: This is the seventh all-time meeting between Omaha and Orlando and the third of four matches this season. The Supernovas lead the all-time series 4-2, but the Valkyries have taken both matches in 2025. Orlando completed sweeps on Feb. 2 in Orlando and Feb. 27 in Omaha. Since starting the season 2-2, the Supernovas have won eight of their last 10 matches with the Valkyries giving Omaha its only two losses in that span.

2024 PRO VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONS



From preseason favorites to first-ever champions, the Omaha Supernovas took the pro volleyball world by storm in the Pro Volleyball Federation's inaugural season in 2024. The Supernovas swept the Grand Rapids Rise to claim the PVF Championship at the CHI Health Center in Omaha on May 18. Setter Sydney Hilley was named Postseason MVP after coming off the bench in leading Omaha to a reverse sweep of the San Diego Mojo in the semifinals, which was followed by the championship sweep.

The championship win capped off a historic year for the Supernovas, who showed the hunger for professional volleyball in the United States, hosting the seven most-attended pro volleyball matches in U.S. history. That's highlighted by the U.S. record on March 16, 2024 with 12,090 fans watching Omaha beat the Orlando Valkyries 3-1. The Supernovas drew seven crowds of 10,000 people or more out of its 12 home matches and finished with the No. 1 average attendance mark in the world among pro volleyball teams at 9,656 fans per match. A total of 134,969 fans attended pro volleyball matches at the CHI Health Center in 2024, which also includes the 19,094 spectators who attended the PVF Semifinals and Championship.

The product on the court was equally as impressive with the Supernovas finishing 18-8 overall and a 9-3 mark at home. Star outside hitters Brooke Nuneviller and Bethania De La Cruz were named to the PVF All-League First Team while De La Cruz took home the PVF Server of the Year award after leading the league with 32 aces during the regular season. Bulgarian middle blocker Hristina Vuchkova missed the first three matches of the season, but arrived in Omaha to lead the league with 70 total blocks by season's end. She was also an All-League selection, being named to the second team.



CHI Health Center Omaha



Built for \$291 million and finished in the fall of 2003, CHI Health Center Omaha is a key element in the continued renovation and development of Omaha's riverfront.

The facility formerly known as Qwest Center Omaha (2003-11) and CenturyLink Center Omaha (2011-18) is located on a 421-acre site of the former Union Pacific Railroad yards, just a few blocks from Creighton's campus, the historic Old Market and three miles from Eppley Airfield.

In 2018, CHI Health agreed to pay \$23.6 million over 20 years for the naming rights to the arena. Among the amenities at CHI Health Center Omaha are seven locker rooms, five dressing rooms and a media interview room. In the summer of 2023, a lighting upgrade project was completed. A \$6 million Daktronics, Inc., scoreboard hangs from the arena center. The scoreboard is more than 26 feet in height and approximately 32 feet in diameter. The scoreboard was upgraded in the summer of 2013 and is one of the nation's finest, as CHI Health Center Omaha is one of the nation's only arenas to have 4 mm and 6 mm pixel configurations to give fans significantly better resolution

Twelve permanent concession stands and 20 free-standing klosks help feed and quench thirst for crowds of up to 18.300 for volleyball matches.

CHI Health Center Omaha provides more than 194,000 square feet of exhibition space, and the exhibit hall can hold dinners for up to 15,000 people at once. Downtown Omaha's 40-story First National Bank Tower could be laid down inside the length of the exhibit space.

Funding for CHI Health Center Omaha came from private donations, taxes and projected revenue from the facility. The facility has hosted some of America's top sporting events, including the NCAA Men's Basketball Championships (2008, 2012, 2015, 2018 and 2024), NCAA Volleyball Championships (2006, 2008, 2015, 2020 and 2022), U.S. Olympic Team Trials for Swimming (2008, 2012, 2016 and 2021), NCAA Wrestling Finals (2010), the U.S. Figure Skating Championships (2013) as well as four title fights for boxing champion Terence Crawford.

The facility has also hosted concerts by artists such as The Eagles, Justin Timberlake, Lady Gaga, Katy Perry, Taylor Swift, ZZ Top, Prince, Bruce Springsteen, Dave Matthews Band, Billy Joel, The Rolling Stones, Paul McCartney, Aerosmith, Luke Bryan, Travis Scott, Britney Spears, Justin Bieber, Alan Jackson, UZ, KISS, Jimmy Buffett and Garth Brooks.

More than 1,700 new seats were added to the upper deck on the north side of the building during the summer of 2006, expanding capacity. Located one block northwest of CHI Health Center Omaha is Charles Schwab Field Omaha, which opened in 2011 as the home of Creighton baseball and the NCAA Men's College World Series.

PRESEASON HONORS

- Coming off its championship-winning season, the Supernovas were voted third in the PVF Preseason Poll, receiving one of the eight first-place votes. Both the poll and allleague teams were voted by the league head coaches, who weren't allowed to vote for their own team and players.
- Omaha will have the top outside hitter duo entering the 2025 season with 2024 All-League First Team selection Brooke Nuneviller and PVF Rookie of the Year Reagan Cooper, who were both voted to the Preseason All-League Team.

PEDIGREE OF GREATNESS

- Aside from winning their own league title, the 2025 Supernovas field a roster full of championship experience and individual stardom dating back to their college days.
 This season's roster has combined for the following:
- Nine NCAA Volleyball National Championships, Semifinal and Championship Appearances. Middle blocker Kayla Caffey won the 2022 title with Texas in her final year of college at the CHI Health Center, securing the first of back-to-back Longhorn championships. Dutside hitter Valeria Vazquez Gomez leads the team in semfinal appearances, helping Pittsburgh reach fourstraight national semifinals from 2021 to 2024.
- 12 conference titles. Vazquez Gomez and setter Kendra Wait are tied for the most on the

Supernovas with four. Vazquez Gomez won four ACC titles while Wait helped Creighton to Big East championships in all four of her college seasons.

• 27 AVCA All-American honors spread across 14 Supernovas. Seven of those earning multiple honors including Wait (4), Nuneviller (4), Kaitlyn Hord (4), Mac Podraza (3), Emily Londot (3) and Kelsie Payne (3).

WELCOME BACK TO THE GOOD LIFE

- Six Supernovas on the 2025 roster have college connections within the state. Four having played at Nebraska and two at Creighton.
- Lindsay Krause, Ally Batenhorst, Kayla Caffey and Kaitlyn Hord were all Huskers under head coach John Cook, but Krause was the only one to play all four seasons at NU (2021-2024).
- Krause and Batenhorst have the longest teammate history as Huskers from 2021 to 2023. Caffey (2021) and Hord (2022) joined that duo as teammates for one year each.
- Wait and libero Allison Whitten each played for Creighton under head coach Kirsten Bernthal Booth. Wait spent all four seasons in Omaha while Whitten joined the Bluejays for her final year in 2022, where she and Wait shared the floor as starters.

CARRYING THE CHAMPIONSHIP TORCH

- Two Supernovas from the inaugural championship-winning team return to Omaha for the 2025 season. That includes outside hitter Nuneviller and setter Natalia Valentín-Anderson.
- Nuneviller was a pillar on the 2024 team, making her a priority in the free agency period over the summer. The Oregon alum showcased her two-way play en route to PVF All-League First Team honors. She recorded 3.33 kills (8th in PVF) and 3.32 digs (6th) per set, including the previous franchise record for most digs in a single match with 22.
- Nuneviller was also the first player in franchise history to be named PVF Player of the Week [March 12]. Plus, she's currently the all-time franchise leader in kills, kills per set attacks and digs.
- Valentín-Anderson shared time as a starter in 2024, but quickly established herself as one of the best defensive setters in the league. The Puerto Rico Olympian averaged 8.60 assists and 2.87 digs per set in 21 matches, highlighted by her PVF Player of the Week honor after averaging over 12 assists and four digs per set in two matches. Her defense was put on national display when her incredible two-dig save against the Vegas Thrill on May 6 was featured No. 2 on SportCenter's Top 10 Plays.

ROCK, CHALK JAYHAWK

- Much like its ties to Nebraska, the 2025 Supernovas draw several connections with Kansas.
- Opposite Kelsie Payne, outside hitter Reagan Cooper and middle blocker Toyosi Onabanjo each finished their college careers at KU. Cooper and Onabanjo spent time together as teammates for the 2023 season while Wait heralds from the Sunflower State.

- All three former Jayhawks received All-American honors in Lawrence with Payne leading the way with two first team honors [2016, 2015] and a third team nod [2017].
 Cooper made the third team [2023] in her lone season with KU while Onabanjo was named an honorable mention in 2024 after averaging 2.58 kills and 1.23 blocks per set.
- Omaha head coach Laura "Bird" Kuhn made her name known in the coaching ranks at Kansas from 2011-2017, winning the 2015 AVCA Assistant Coach of the Year after KU made its first-ever national semifinal in school history.
- Supernovas Team President Diane Mendenhall earned her bachelor's degree from Kansas while being a four-year starter for the Jayhawks.

THE FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

- Omaha will see the pro debut of eight rookies in 2025: MB Phoebe Awoleye, OH Ally Batenhorst, OH Lindsay Krause, OPP Emily Londot, MB Toyosi Onabanjo, OH Valeria Vazquez Gomez, S Kendra Wait and L Allison Whitten
- Kayla Caffey, Reagan Cooper, Kaitlyn Hord, Brooke Nuneviller and Mac Podraza are either entering their second or third season as pros.
- In total, 13 of the 16 players on the Supernovas have three years or fewer of professional seasons under their belt.
- Natalia Valentín-Anderson is the clubhouse leader with 16 years of professional experience followed by Kelsie Payne (6 years) and Camila Gómez (4 years).

HORDING THE NET

- Hord has been the premier blocker in the PVF so far in the 2025 season.
- The former Husker and Nittany Lion leads the league in both total blocks (48) and blocks per set with a 1.00 mark.
- Hord's seven blocks in the five-set win over the Atlanta Vibe on opening night set a Supernovas single-match record. She is also one of five players in the PVF to record seven or more blocks in a match this season.
- The Kentucky native also sits third in hitting percentage with a .351 clip through 151 attacks with 60 kills and only seven errors, which is fewest among middle blockers.

A'NUNE"THER LEVEL

- After averaging over 12 kills and digs per match last season, Supernovas outside hitter Brooke Nuneviller has raised her game for the 2025 season.
- Nuneviller enters Thursday third in the PVF in kills per set (3.88), fifth in kills (190), and fifth in total points (205).
- The Chandler, Arizona native is one of only four players in the league this season to record 20+ kills and 15+ digs in a match. That was on opening night when she poured in 22 kills and 17 digs while hitting .340.
- The Oregon product has been averaging 13.6 kills and 13.3 digs per match through 14 contests this season.
- Wednesday's sweep over the Fury marked the sixth time in the last seven matches Nuneviller has notched double-digit kills and

recorded a clip of above .300. She posted 11 kills on a .308 hitting percentage while adding 15 digs.

LONDOT EARNS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Rookie opposite Emily Londot was named the PVF Player of the Week on 3/11 after setting a franchise record for most points in a three-set match [19] last time out at Columbus on March 5. She tallied 15 kills, three blocks and one ace in the sweep.
- She is the fifth Superovas player to win the weekly award and first in 2025.
- Since Londot entered the starting lineup on Feb. 6 at Indy, the Supernovas have rolled off wins in six of their last seven matches.
- During that stretch, Londot has recorded 100 points (3.33 P/S), 77 kills (2.57 K/S), 58 digs (1.93 D/S) and 20 blocks (0.67 B/S) in 30 sets.

THE DIG PATROL

- The Supernovas have been one of the best defensive teams in the league as they sit second in the PVF in digs per set [16.82] and eighth in total digs [824].
- Nuneviller, who is a former libero, leads that effort with a team-high 186 digs (3rd in PVF) and 3.80 per set (3rd). She leads all PVF attackers in both categories.
- Gómez is right behind her teammate with 185 digs (4th in PVF) and 3.78 per set (4th).
 Her 31 digs against Atlanta in the season opener broke a single-match franchise record. That total is tied for the second-most digs recorded in a single match in PVF history.
 Valentín-Anderson is ninth in the league
- Valentin-Anderson is ninth in the league and third among setters with 164 total digs while her 3.42 digs per set mark is fifth. She's recorded at least 10 digs in 10 of the 14 contests this season including a season-high 21 against San Diego on Jan. 19th.

THE COOPER CURVE

- 2024 PVF Rookie of the Year Reagan Cooper has recorded a team-leading 11 aces (T-7th in PVF) and 0.24 per set (T-6th). The secondyear pro has already surpassed her rookie year total when she had eight aces in 82 sets last year in Columbus.
- Cooper is still a dangerous attacker, posting 3.69 kills per set (5th in PVF) while her 166 total kills is eighth. Her 185 points on the season is also eighth among all players in the league.
- Cooper's 13-kill performance in Wednesday's sweep over the Fury was the eighth-straight match that she totaled at least 10 kills, which is a franchise record.

DIG. KILL. REPEAT

- Nuneviller's 22-kill, 17-dig performance was her fourth PVF match with at least 20 kills and 15 digs, which is the most in PVF history.
 Teammate Cooper has achieved those marks three times, which ties her for second most.
- There have been 27 league performances with at least 20 kills and 15 digs. Supernovas players have tallied for eight of those 27. Aside from Nuneviller and Cooper, former opposite Stephanie Samedy produced those numbers with a 21-kill, 18-dig match against Grand Rapids on April 26, 2024.

DEFENSIVE DOMINANCE

- The Supernovas lead the league in opponent efficiency with a .195 clip five points lower than second-place Grand Rapids (.200).
- The Supernovas are also one of the best blocking teams in the PVF with a 2.67 blocks per set mark, which is second in the league.

OFFENSIVE BLASTOFF

- The Omaha Supernovas offense has rounded into form with a .242 team hitting percentage second in the league.
- Omaha has posted hitting percentages of .250 or above in nine of the 14 matches this season. The Supernovas offense reached that mark only nine times across the entire 2024 season.
- There's only been six times in franchise history that the Supernovas have recorded a team hitting percentage of .300 or above. Three of those instances have come during the 2025 season which includes a .339 clip in the sweep at Columbus on March 5.

ROAD WARRIORS

- The Supernovas have the biggest home court advantage in pro volleyball, but they've also been mighty on the road. That includes the league's best road record at 6-2. Omaha and Orlando (4-3) are the only teams in the PVF to have a road record at .500 or above.
- The Supernovas go into Thursday with a franchise-record four-match winning streak on the road, which dates back to Feb. 6 at Indy.

SUPERNOVAS-VALKYRIES CONNECTIONS

- Valkyries outside hitter Norah Sis and libero Maddy Bilinovic played in Omaha for their college careers at Creighton. They were teammates with Kendra Wait for the 2024 college volleyball season, where Creighton reached its second regional final in program history. Allison Whitten spent the 2022 season with both Sis and Wait.
- Bilinovic has connections that stretch across the Omaha roster, including Supernovas middle blocker Kaitlyn Hord and setter Mac Podraza at Penn State. Hord spent three years with Bilinovic (2020-2022) while Podraza was teammates with her in 2023.
- Valkyries opposite Brittany Abercrombie and Valentín-Anderson have played together in multiple tournaments for the Puerto Rico National Team. That includes the 2022 World Championships (15th), NORCECA Pan American Cup Final Six (3rd) and FIVB Challenger Cup (3rd). They also played against one in the Puerto Rico League from 2020-2023.
- Omaha middle blocker Phoebe Awoleye spent two seasons (2023-2024) with Orlando opposite Lydia Grote at Minnesota.
- Five Oregon alumni come together on Saturday which includes Omaha's Nuneviller [2018-2022] and Orlando's Abby Hansen [2018-2021], Georgia Murphy [2019-2023], Hannah Pukis [2022-2023] and Lindsay Vander Weide [2015-2018].
- Plus, Pukis and Reagan Cooper were teammates for one season (2019) at Washington State.

The Omaha Supernovas continue to show the growing interest and passion of pro volleyball, resetting the U.S. Pro Volleyball Attendance Record with 13,486 cheering on the Supernovas for the 2025 season opener at the CHI Health Center.

Omaha broke its own attendance record from a season ago when 12,090 packed into CHI on March 16, 2024, to see the Supernovas beat the Orlando Valkyries 3-1. It's not just about the numbers — it's about the community we've built together and the milestones we will continue to achieve. As we look ahead, we remain committed to raising the bar and delivering a major league volleyball experience that inspires the next generation athletes and fans."

"NovasNation has shown the world that professional volleyball has a bright future," Supernovas Partner Kirk Thompson shared. "Breaking another U.S. Pro Volleyball record underscores the growing hunger for this sport and the impact it's making on a major-league level. We're proud to be at the forefront of this growth, showing what's possible when passion meets opportunity, and we're excited to keep elevating the game for our fans and the sport as a whole."




