## **VIBE VS RISE RECAP ON 3/13**

On March 13, 2025, the Atlanta Vibe secured a 3-1 victory over the Grand Rapids Rise, improving their record to 9-8. The team's offense was well-balanced, with Leah Edmond, Merritt Beason, and Pia Timmer each recording 13 kills and double-doubles in the match. Edmond, Beason, and Timmer also contributed significantly in the back row, with Edmond tallying 12 digs, Beason adding 13, and Timmer finishing with 16. Atlanta's defense stood out, accumulating 94 digs compared to Grand Rapids' 85, with libero Morgan Hentz leading the way with 28 digs, maintaining her position as the league leader in total digs and digs per set. The Vibe's front row was strong as well, totaling 14 blocks, including a season-high 6 blocks from middle blocker Khori Louis.

#### SAN DIEGO VS ATLANTA STAT COMPARISON

Offensively, the Vibe are ranked fourth in the league for kill percentage, averaging .361, while the Mojo are seventh in the league with .330. Defensively, the Mojo are first in the league for digs per set, averaging 17.43, while the Vibe's digs per set average on the season is 16.55, holding the second highest amount in the league. In aces on the season, with the Vibe total 80, ranked first in the league for aces per set, while the Mojo total 43, ranked seventh in the league. As for assists, Atlanta holds the third highest assists per set with 12.71 and the Mojo are sixth averaging 12.03 assists per set.

## **ROSTER UPDATES**

The Vibe have made some updated roster changes for the upcoming match. Middle blocker Jenna Rosenthal is now placed on the active roster. Setter Whitney Bower has been moved to the practice squad.

#### **CORNHUSKER REUNION**

Vibe opposite hitter Merritt Beason reunites with former collegiate teammate, Mojo middle blocker Leyla Blackwell. Both competed for the Nebraska Cornhuskers in the 2024 season, earning a spot in the NCAA semi-finals. Beason and Blackwell were both drafted in the 2024 PVF draft this past November, making their debuts in professional careers this year.

### **HEAD COACHES WITH ELITE EXPERIENCE**

Vibe head coach Kayla Banwarth and Mojo head coach Tayyiba Haneef-Park both bring impressive Olympic experience to their respective team. Banwarth, a standout player on the U.S. women's volleyball team, earned a bronze medal at the 2016 Rio Games, while Haneef-Park also made her mark on the international stage, securing silver medals at the 2008 Beijing and 2012 London Olympics. On top of their profound playin careers, both coaches have taken on coaching roles at the collegiate level: Coach Banwarth at Ole Miss and Nebraska and Coach Haneef-Park at Oregon and Arizona.

## **HEAD COACH KAYLA BANWARTH**

As a former Power Five head volleyball coach and a member of the 2016 USA Olympic Team, Banwarth has expansive knowledge of the game. Her impressive career with Team USA spanned six years of international competition, during which she collected eight medals. Notably, she earned a bronze medal at the 2016 Olympics, adding to her legacy in American volleyball history.

Banwarth previously served as head coach at Ole Miss and as an assistant for the powerhouse Nebraska program. After making a shift to coaching in 2017, Banwarth stepped into an assistant role at the University of Nebraska. In her debut season, she helped guide



the Huskers to a Big Ten Championship and a NCAA Championship title. In 2020, Banwarth became head coach at Ole Miss turning around the volleyball program from a 1-9 record in the 2020-2021 season to a staggering 21-9 record in 2022. Banwarth heads into her first season as the newly appointed Atlanta Vibe head coach.




