MATCHDAY STORYLINES

- The San Diego Mojo and Columbus Fury will meet for the third time this season and second time in Columbus on Wednesday, April 16 at Nationwide Arena. The Mojo have won two of their last three matches and the Fury are looking for their third consecutive victory. San Diego is 4-7 on the road this season, while Columbus is 5-7 at home.
- **Series History:** The Mojo and Fury meet for the seventh time in series history with San Diego holding a 6-0 series lead, including a 3-0 mark in Columbus.
- **Old Friends:** Current Mojo players Rainelle Jones and Jenaisya Moore competed with the Fury in 2024. Jones appeared in all 24 matches for the Fury, starting 17 matches and playing in 69 sets. She registered 85 kills, 35 blocks, 28 digs and nine service aces. Former Mojo standouts Nootsara Tomkom, the 2024 PVF Setter of the Year, and Morgan Lewis will compete for the Fury with this being the first time Tomkom will face her former team.

SAN DIEGO MOJO OUTLOOK

- The San Diego Mojo dominated the league-leading Omaha Supernovas on Saturday night in a four-set victory Viejas Arena.
- San Diego had a season-high 17 blocks and held Omaha to a season-low .119 hitting percentage.
- Opposite hitter Yaasmeen Bedart-Ghani was the game's leading player, tallying a match-high 20 points, on 13 kills, four blocks and three aces, equaling a Mojo single-match record, while also collecting nine digs.
- Ronika Stone recorded a season-high 19 points, with 11 kills and eight blocks. Her eight blocks are a season-high for the Mojo and the second-most in franchise history. It brings her season total to 58 blocks, the fourth-most in the Pro Volleyball Federation and three shy of the Mojo's single-season record.
- Outside hitters Jenaisya Moore and Maya Tabron each had 13 points, and both recorded a double-double. Moore made her impact on 13 kills and 12 digs, while Tabron collected 10 kills and 20 digs. Tabron's 20 digs put her name in the Mojo record books for seventh-most digs in a single match, tying Nootsara Tomkom, who did so in two previous matches.
- Regan Pittman contributed on both ends of the ball with seven kills and four blocks, increasing her league lead in blocks per set to a mark of 0.96 per frame.
- Sarah Sponcil has continued to shine in her duty as the Mojo's starting setter, posting her fourth-straight double-double with 46 assists and 16 digs, while libero Shara Venegas registered 18 digs.
- Newcomer Bedart-Ghani had an immediate impact in two dominating home performances last week, as the opposite hitter helped the Mojo push the Atlanta Vibe to five sets on Tuesday before taking down the league-leading Omaha Supernovas on Saturday night.
- Over the two matches, Bedart-Ghani appeared in nine sets and totaled 36 points courtesy of 27 kills, four blocks and five service aces, hitting .243 with a 38.6% kill percentage. She also contributed 17 digs over the two matches. Her per set averages were 4.00 points, 3.00 kills, 0.44 blocks, 0.56 aces and 1.89 digs.
- Tabron has been a sensation for the Mojo the last seven matches, scoring in double-digits in each contest, including a pair of 20-plus point scoring efforts, while filling up the stat sheet in kills, digs and blocks. She currently ranks in the top nine in set averages for points (3.60/8th), kills (2.96/8th), blocks (0.47/9th) and digs (2.98/7th).
- Dahlke continues to be one of the premier players in the Pro Volleyball Federation in 2025, ranking among the top 10 in kills (262/6th), kills per set (3.51/8th), points (286/8th) and points per set (3.81/7th).
- Stone remains a force among middle blockers in the

league, ranking fourth total blocks (58) and fifth in blocks per set (0.67), while ranking 10th in hitting percentage (.300).

- Pittman is one of the best middles in the league, topping the PVF with a blocks per set average of 0.96 per frame while her 49 total blocks are fifth.

- Libero Shara Venegas has come up huge in court coverage, averaging 3.88 digs per set with 318 total digs, the third-best marks in the PVF in both categories.

- San Diego is one of the best defensive teams in the league, leading the PVF with 17.24 digs per set. The Mojo middles have San Diego ranked third in the PVF in blocks, averaging 2.60 blocks per set. The Mojo has had at least 10 blocks in 11 of the last 12 games, including 15 in Tuesday's matchup against Atlanta and 17 blocks on Saturday against Omaha.

COLUMBUS FURY OUTLOOK

- The Fury picked up their second-straight win on Sunday with a sweep at home of the Vegas Thrill.

- The team recorded 10 blocks on the night, while setter Nootsara Tomkom controlled the offense, leading her attackers to hit at a .330 efficiency, the second-best in franchise history.

- Opposite hitter Izabella Rapacz led the offense, attacking .519 with 15 kills and one error on 27 attempts, while outside hitter Raina Terry recorded 10 kills on 22 attempts with a .364 attacking percentage.

- Rapacz is among the top scorers in the PVF this season, ranking fifth in kills per set (3.64) and points per set (4.04).

HANEEF-PARK NAMED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM COACHING STAFF

- Mojo head coach Tayyiba Haneef-Park has been named to the U.S. Women's National Team coaching staff, USA Volleyball and head coach Erik Sullivan this week, as the team prepares for the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games. She will continue leading the Mojo while serving as an assistant with Team USA.

"I fell in love with the Olympics in the Los Angeles 1984 games," Haneef-Park said. "One of the greatest honors of my life has been to represent USA on that stage. I am deeply humbled and excited to work with Erik in this full circle moment and be a part of a podium push with this incredible staff and team for the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles."

- A three-time Olympian and two-time silver medalist (Beijing 2008, London 2012), Haneef-Park brings first-hand Olympic experience and a winning mentality to her new role. The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, she guided San Diego to the PVF Championship semifinals during the league's

inaugural season.

• Prior to joining the Mojo, Haneef-Park held assistant coaching roles at Oregon and the Arizona, as well as extensive experience with USA Volleyball's National Team Development Program. Last year, she was an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's National Team that won silver at the NORCECA Pan Am Cup and NORCECA Final 6. In 2019, she led the U.S. Women to gold at the NORCECA Champions Cup. She was also an assistant coach with the U.S. Women's Collegiate Team from 2021-23.

THP TO THE HOF

• Haneef-Park has been selected for induction into the USA Volleyball Hall of Fame, the organization announced on March 11. She is among six athletes that will be honored with the All-Time Great Athlete Award as members of the Class of 2025. Along with Haneef-Park the group includes Lindsey Berg, Mike Dodd, Tom Hoff, David Lee and Kerri Walsh Jennings.

• A three-time Olympian, Haneef-Park helped lead the U.S. Women's National Team to Olympic silver medals in 2008 and 2012. A collegiate star at Long Beach State, she guided her team to a 33-1 record and an NCAA runner-up finish in 2001. She ranks seventh on the school's all-time kill list with 1,421. She competed for Team USA for over a decade, contributing to multiple podium finishes at the FIVB World Cup and World Grand Prix.

• To receive the All-Time Great Athlete Award, an athlete must have played at least five years on a U.S. national team and competed in a minimum of five top-level international events—including the Olympic Games, FIVB World Championship, FIVB World Cup, or NORCECA Championship.

• The six athletes will be inducted into the USA Volleyball Hall of Fame during the annual banquet and ceremony on May 21 at the Hilton Denver City Center in Colorado, two days before the 2025 USA Volleyball Open National Championship begins at the Denver Convention Center.

MOJO ALL-STARS

• San Diego Mojo middle blocker Ronika Stone and libero Shara Venegas were named as the first-ever All-Star selections for the Mojo, competing in the inaugural Pro Volleyball Federation All-Star Match on Saturday, Feb. 22 at Fishers Event Center in Indianapolis.

• Venegas helped Team Shondell win the first-ever PVF All-Star Match, topping Ronika Stone and Team Collier before a sellout crowd at the 7,500-seat Fishers Event Center on Saturday afternoon.

• The match was scored based on total points over three sets. Team Shondell, coached by long-time Purdue head coach Dave Shondell, won by set scores of 25-22, 25-20, 15-10 (65-52 total points) over Team Collier, coached by Georgia Tech head coach Michelle Collier.

• Venegas had two digs and an assist in the winning effort, and Stone registered three points with two kills and one block while also contributing one dig.

STONE COLD

• Middle blocker Ronika Stone has been a force in the middle for the Mojo, racking up 58 blocks this season, including a career-best eight against Omaha last Saturday that rank as the second-most in Mojo history.

• She has been dominate during the second half of the season, scoring at least 10 points in 11 of the last 12 matches while posting over three blocks per outing during the stretch while averaging 0.80 blocks per set.

• Last time out against Omaha, she established career highs in points (19) and blocks (8) in a four-set upset of league-leading Omaha.

• In the Mojo's home match against Atlanta on April 8, Stone equaled her career-high with six blocks and added four kills for a 10-point night.

• Against Atlanta on March 15, she tallied a season-high 15 kills with a .375 hitting percentage.

• Stone had a monster game at Orlando on March 13, posting six blocks in the match including three in the fifth set with two on the last two points in the game.

• She has had at least three blocks in six of the last 10 matches and nine times



overall.

• Stone is San Diego's all-time leader with 101 career blocks, while the 2025 All-Star's 50 this year are the third-most in a season in team history.

• She is the only player in team history to appear in all 183 sets the Mojo has played with 178 regular-season sets and five in the postseason.

• Stone was selected by the league's coaches to the PVF Preseason All-League Team.

• She earned 2024 All-Pro Volleyball Federation Second Team honors after leading the league with league in a .336 hitting percentage.

• Last season, Stone equaled the team-record with three services aces in a victory over Omaha on April 2.

DAHLKE DOES IT ALL

• Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke has been stellar in 2025, posting nine double-doubles in her first 21 games of the season, after registering two last season.

• Dahlke has totaled a career-best 263 kills this year, topping her tally of 96 for the 2024 season, and has scored 286 points. It marks her second-straight year with 100 points, the first Mojo player with multiple 100-point seasons, and to have a 200-plus and 100-plus point season.

• The Fallbrook High alum tallied at least 10 kills in eight-straight matches earlier this season, the longest streak in Mojo history. All told, she has 12 double-digit kill performances this season including a 22-kill match at Indy (2/13) and a 20-kill match at Orlando (3/13).

• She has scored at least 10 points in 15 games after scoring in double-digits in five games last season.

• Her nine double-doubles are a career best after tallying two in all of 2024.

• She had 15 kills and 21 digs at Atlanta on March 15, two days after collecting 20 kills and 15 digs on the road against Orlando.

• Dahlke picked up her first double-double of the season in a win at Columbus, totaling 17 kills and 17 digs, then notched another one the following match with 14 kills and 18 digs versus Orlando. She added a third at defending PVF champion Omaha with a season-best 18 kills while tallying 12 digs, then picked up her fourth-straight (19 kills, 11 digs) in a home win over Indy.

• She is the Mojo career record holder in kills (351) and attacks (1,072).

• Dahlke has recorded a team-leading nine service aces this season.

• In 2024, she was among the top scorers for the Mojo, highlighted by a 23-point match at Orlando on April 14 that is the fifth-best scoring output in team history.

- Dahlke had 65 attacks in the Mojo's five-set win at Orlando on April 14, the most in a four-set match for the Mojo and the second-most overall.
- She also had 27 points in the victory, tied for the fourth-most in a match in Mojo history.

VENEGAS WITH THE COURT COVERAGE

- All-Star libero Shara Venegas has picked up right where she left off last season, ranking third in the league with 3.88 digs per set and 318 total digs.
- She has had at least 13 digs in 19 of 21 matches played, including each of the last 10 games.
- Venegas had a 16-dig performance against Vegas on Feb. 7 that are the most-ever for a Mojo player in a three-set match.
- She collected 23 digs against Omaha at Viejas Arena on Feb. 20, equaling her best total with the Mojo, then added a 22-dig performance against Orlando on March 19.
- The 23 digs tied her mark for the second-most in San Diego history, a feat she accomplished twice in 2024. The previous two times also occurred at home against Omaha.
- Last year, she led the Mojo last season and was fourth in the league with 345 total digs and ranked second on the team with 3.63 digs per set.
- She had season highs of 23 digs against Omaha on April 2 and April 23.
- Her 23 digs against Omaha on April 2 occurred in a four-set match.

YAAZIE IN PEAK FORM

- Opposite hitter Yaasmeen Bedart-Ghani has been phenomenal since signing with San Diego on March 26.
- Last week, in her first true stretch of playing time with the Mojo, she had an immediate impact in two dominating home performances, helping push the Atlanta Vibe to five sets on Tuesday before taking down the league-leading Omaha Supernovas on Saturday night.
- Over the two matches, Bedart-Ghani appeared in nine sets and totaled 36 points courtesy of 27 kills, four blocks and five service aces, hitting .243 with a 38.6% kill percentage. She also contributed 17 digs over the two matches. Her per set averages were 4.00 points, 3.00 kills, 0.44 blocks, 0.56 aces and 1.89 digs.
- In her first start with the Mojo, Bedart-Ghani dominated the action against Omaha, scoring a match-high 20 points with 13 kills, four blocks and a franchise-record-tying three service aces. She also added 11 digs for her first double-double with San Diego and helped the squad hold one of the top-hitting teams in the PVF to a season-low .119 hitting percentage.
- Against Atlanta, Bedart-Ghani made her home debut for the Mojo, coming off the bench to score 16 points with a team-high of 14 on .270 swinging while adding a pair of aces and six digs in a five-set heartbreaker against the red-hot Vibe.

LEE COMMANDS THE FLOOR

- Veteran setter DaYeong Lee has made an immediate impact in her first year in the league, currently ranking in the top five in total assists (674/6th) and assists per set (9.77/4th).
- The native of South Korea has tallied 11 double-doubles on the year, the third-most in a season and a career in Mojo history.
- She has nine games of at least 40 assists, including a 54-assist outing at Atlanta on March 15 and a 49-assist performance in the Mojo's March 1 victory over Columbus.
- Lee has also collected 22 blocks this season, the eighth-most in a season in team history.
- She had at least two blocks in five-straight games from January 19-30 and has eight overall, including a pair of three-block performances.
- In the Mojo's home win over Indy, Lee collected her fourth double-double of the season, tallying 45 assists and 12 digs, while also posting a pair of blocks and two kills in the Mojo's thrilling victory over first-place Indy.
- She averaged 11.25 assists and three digs per set in the match, while leading

an offense that had almost all of the Mojo hitters have their highest-rated efficiency performances.

PITTMAN COMING UP ACES

- Middle blocker Regan Pittman has been an impact player for the Mojo during her first season in America's Finest City. In 15 games and 51 sets played she has posted 49 blocks, averaging an impressive 0.96 blocks per set to lead the league.
- Her 49 blocks are the third-most for a career in Mojo history.
- Pittman has two seven-block performances in 2025 (March 1 vs. Columbus; March 30 at Vegas), tied for the second-most in a match in franchise history.
- She has tallied at least three blocks in seven of her last nine matches played.
- Pittman had at least five blocks in each game during a three-game stretch from February 27 to March 5, the second player in Mojo history to accomplish the feat.
- She had six against Grand Rapids on February 27, seven versus Columbus on March 1, and five at Grand Rapids on March 5.
- She was dominant during week 10 of the season, leading the Mojo to back-to-back home victories against Grand Rapids and Columbus in her return to the court following a six-game absence.
- On February 27 against the Grand Rapids Rise, Pittman had match highs of 20 points and six blocks and added 12 kills and two service aces to top the Rise and end the visitors' three-match winning streak. She had a .417 hitting percentage and a 50% kill percentage in the win while adding six digs and one assist.
- Two days later against the Columbus Fury, Pittman registered a co-match-leading 18 points courtesy of 11 kills on 23 swings for a .435 hitting percentage, while also recording seven blocks, tied for the second-most blocks in a match in team history. Her seven blocks are tied for the third-most in a game this season in the PVF and are the most by a player since February 2. She also contributed six digs and one assist.
- Across the two matches, Pittman scored 38 points with 23 kills, 13 blocks and two service aces while adding 12 digs and two assists. Her 13 blocks over a two-game stretch are the third-most in Mojo history, one shy of the 14 accomplished twice by Ali Bastianelli during the 2024 season.
- She has also been a force at the service line, collecting six aces in 38 sets played, averaging 0.16 aces per set.
- Pittman has three two-ace matches this season, at Columbus on January 11, against Grand Rapids on February 27 and versus Atlanta on April 8.

TABRON TAKES CHARGE

- Rookie outside hitter Maya Tabron is off to a hot start in her professional career, notching double-digits in kills in each of her first three games and 10 times overall, while leading the Mojo in scoring seven times.
- She has paced the Mojo offense over the last seven games, totaling 121 points courtesy of 94 kills, 19 blocks and eight service aces, while also contributing 92 digs, collecting four double-doubles during the stretch.
- In San Diego's four-set win over Omaha on April 12 she collecting a career-best 20 digs, tied for the seventh-most in Mojo history.
- Tabron had a career night for the Mojo against Atlanta on March 15, establishing career highs of 25 points, 20 kills and two aces, while also adding three blocks and completing her third double-double of the season with 12 digs. Her 25 points are tied for the sixth-most in San Diego history and are a season-high for the Mojo.
- She equaled her then-career-high with 15 kills in the Mojo's win at Orlando on March 13, scoring 18 points overall with two blocks and a service ace.
- Against Grand Rapids on March 5, she led the Mojo with 10 points and nine kills while hitting .318.
- The Gilroy, Calif. native tallied 10 kills in her debut against Orlando on January 9 and collected 14 in a road win at Columbus before posting a career-best 15 kills and 19 points in her home debut against the Valkyries.

GIMMIE MOORE

- Outside hitter Jenaisya Moore had a career day for the Mojo in San Diego's four-set victory over Indy on Jan. 24.
- Moore had a Mojo season-high 24 points, collecting her first double-double of the season with 20 kills and 12 digs.
- The 24 points and 20 kills established career highs, while also posting a career best with three blocks and adding a service ace -- which equaled a personal best.
- Moore's 24 points in the match are the seventh-most in Mojo history and the 20 kills are tied for 10th.
- Her 12 digs marked her first outing with double digits this season and the fourth of her PVF career.
- She added a second double-double against the Omaha Supernovas on February 20 with 12 kills and 11 digs, scoring 14 points in the effort.

PAGING PAGE

- Middle blocker Lauren Page has been a beast on defense while also contributing as an opposite.
- The Chino, Calif. native has posted 20 blocks on the year, the 11th-best single-season mark in Mojo history, while averaging 0.39 blocks per set.
- Page has had a pair of four-block performances this year with the Indy Ignite the opponent in both instances and added a three-block effort at Atlanta on March 15.
- She tallied her first double-double of the year on February 20 against Omaha, collecting 11 kills and 12 digs in the match at Viejas Arena.

BLACKWELL BACK HOME

- Rookie middle blocker Leyla Blackwell has been a consistent presence in the middle for the Mojo, starting eight games this season and posting 10 blocks in 26 sets.
- Prior to playing at Nebraska, Blackwell helped guide the San Diego Toreros to the 2022 NCAA Semifinals.
- Blackwell was a three-time first-team All-WCC selection for the Toreros.

MCGHEE SHINES BRIGHT

- Rookie outside hitter Elise McGhee impressed in her first career start against Vegas on February 7 at Viejas Arena, leading the Mojo with 17 points on .324 hitting with 16 kills and one block.
- The 16 kills against Vegas equaled a Mojo record for kills in a three-set match.
- She once again led the Mojo in scoring in a start against Grand Rapids on March 9, collecting 15 points on 15 kills while also collecting five digs.

LUND MAKES AN IMPACT

- Outside hitter Kayla Lund made her presence felt immediately for the Mojo, scoring the first point of the PVF season in the opener against Orlando.
- Lund went on to tie for a team-leading 10 kills, while also posting the most swings with 31. She tallied her first double-double of the season by adding 10 digs.
- She led the way for the Mojo once again in a road matchup at Omaha on Feb. 16, leading the team with 11 points and 10 kills.

CALIFORNIA LOVE

- Seven Mojo players are native Californians, the most players to hail from a single state on any roster in the Pro Volleyball Federation and the most to play in their home state.
- The Mojo roster includes San Diego locals Kendra Dahlke (Bonsall, Calif./Fallbrook HS) and Leyla Blackwell (San Diego, Calif./La Jolla HS/USD).
- Yaasmeen Bedart-Ghani (Los Angeles, Calif.), Kayla Lund (Pasadena, Calif.), and Lauren Page (Chino, Calif.) are SoCal natives, while Ronika Stone (San Jose, Calif.) and Maya Tabron (Gilroy, Calif.) are NorCal natives.
- Sarah Sponcil also has Golden State ties, having played as a graduate student at UCLA.

TEAMMATES ONCE AGAIN

- Outside hitter Kendra Dahlke and middle blocker Lauren Page were previously teammates during their club days, competing with Coast Volleyball Club prior to their collegiate careers.
- During their senior year of club in 2015, the duo helped Coast Volleyball Club win bronze at the Junior Olympics in New Orleans.
- Page was also a college teammate of middle blocker Ronika Stone for three seasons at Oregon from 2016-18.
- While at Oregon, Page and Stone helped the Ducks go a combined 62-33 (.653) with three appearances in the NCAA Tournament, including an Elite Eight run in 2018.
- Rainelle Jones and Jenaisya Moore were teammates at Metro Volleyball Club in Washington, D.C., helping lead the team to two nationals appearances.
- Maya Tabron and recent signee Celia Cullen played together at SMU, helping the squad to a 25-8 record in the program's first season in the ACC.

ROOKIES MAKING THEIR MARK

- Three Mojo rookies made their professional debuts in the season opener against Orlando.
- Outside hitter Maya Tabron started tied for the team lead with 10 kills while also adding eight digs.
- Middle blocker Leyla Blackwell also started, collecting seven kills and hitting a team-high .417.
- Elise McGhee entered in the second set and played two frames in her first professional appearance.

OLYMPIC REPRESENTATION

- A pair of Mojo players have represented their nation in the Olympic Games.

TAYYIBA HANEEF-PARK

HEAD COACH

The 2024 Pro Volleyball Federation Coach of the Year, Tayyiba Haneef-Park is a three-time Olympian with the United States. Haneef-Park won silver with Team USA at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. She serves as an assistant coach for the U.S. Women's National Team and has been selected for induction into the USA Volleyball Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2025.

Last season, Haneef-Park led the Mojo to a 13-11 regular-season record and No. 3 seed in the PVF playoffs in their first season. The club started 2-6 before winning 11 of its next 16 games to qualify for the postseason, falling one set short of reaching the championship match.

Prior to joining the Mojo, she spent 2022 as an assistant coach with Oregon Volleyball, during which the Ducks sported a 26-6 record, including a 17-3 mark in Pac-12 play. The 17 conference wins were a program record. Haneef-Park also spent two seasons (2015-16) as an assistant coach with Arizona Beach Volleyball, helping the Wildcats to a 38-10 record.

In addition to her Olympic performances, Haneef-Park contributed to notable achievements such as a gold medal at the 2012 FIVB World Grand Prix and bronze finishes at the 2003 and 2004 Grand Prix.

Haneef-Park played professionally for 11 years from 2001-12 with stops in Italy, Japan, Russia, Turkey and Azerbaijan. She began coaching in 2014, serving as an assistant on collegiate staffs with Arizona from 2014-16 and Oregon from 2022-23. She has also served as an assistant with various USA Volleyball teams during that time, but recently helping the United States win silver at the Pan American Cup in August and NORCECA Final Six in June.

Collegiately, Haneef-Park was a 2001 All-American at Long Beach State and helped The Beach to a national championship in 1998 and a runner-up finish in 2001. She also competed in track & field for Long Beach State and was a three-time All-American in the high jump.
