WELCOME TO INDY IGNITE PROFESSIONAL VOLLEYBALL

The Indy Ignite are one of eight teams taking the court in the second season of Pro Volleyball Federation (PVF) competition. The mission of the Indy Ignite is to pursue victory, empower women and serve our community through the competitive world of pro volleyball. Indy is the only new PVF team in 2025. The other seven teams are the Atlanta Vibe, Columbus Fury, Grand Rapids Rise, Omaha Supernovas, Orlando Valkyries, San Diego Mojo and Vegas Thrill.

IGNITE CAN CLINCH PLAYOFF BERTH WITH VICTORY OVER SAN DIEGO

The path is simple: Win Sunday's match over visiting San Diego and Indy clinches the fourth and final Pro Volleyball Federation playoff position in the first season for the expansion franchise. It's not the only way the Ignite can clinch, but it's the fastest and most direct.

It would also end a five-match losing streak, Indy's longest of the season. Each of those defeats has been narrow - two came in five-setters and Friday's loss to Orlando saw Indy battle into extra points in the final two sets before dropping both. Ignite head coach George Padjen is reminding his team to focus solely on beating the Mojo and to tune out the noise about the postseason.

"I hear people chattering about it - it's the playoffs, it's the playoffs," Padjen said. "But to me, it's just we're playing Sunday. You can't look ahead one day, you can't look ahead one point."

PRO VOLLEYBALL FEDERATION PRIMER/PLAYOFFS INFORMATION

- Each PVF match is a best-of-five sets. In the first four sets, the winner is the first team to 25 points (with at least a two-point advantage); the winner of the fifth set is the first team to 15 points (again with a lead of two or more points)
- There are no line judges; line scoring is done with the use of 22 high-definition cameras placed around the court. Coaches are permitted two call challenges per set, with the challenge referee off site relaying the decision to referees on site.
- Each team plays 28 matches in the regular season, with four matches (two home, two away) against every other team in the league. The four teams with the best records advance to the playoffs to be held May 9-11 at Lee's Family Forum, home of the Vegas Thrill. Tickets to attend the matches are available at axs.com. Both the May 9 semifinals and the May 11 championship match will be telecast by the CBS Sports Network. The championship-winning team earns a \$1 million prize.

PLOTTING IGNITE'S PATHS TO PVF PLAYOFFS

The Ignite are on the verge of clinching a PVF postseason berth in their inaugural season. Indy is currently fourth in the standings, with the top four teams at season's end advancing to the playoffs. Omaha, Atlanta and Orlando have already qualified for the postseason. For Indy to join them, one of the following needs to happen:

- The Ignite win one of their three remaining matches, or
- Grand Rapids and Vegas both lose one more match.

If either of those happen and Indy winds up with an identical record as Grand Rapids, San Diego and/or Vegas at the conclusion of the regular season, the Ignite win the first playoff tiebreaker (match result totals) over all three teams.



CAJIC NAMED TO SERBIAN WOMEN'S NATIONAL TEAM

Ignite outside hitter **Nina Cajic** (shown above) has been named to the Serbian national women's team that will compete in the 2025 Volleyball Nations League tournament beginning in June. The native of Subotica, Serbia, ranks second on the Ignite with 187 kills this season and appreciates the national team honor.

"Ever since I started playing volleyball, that's been the dream of mine, just to get a chance," Cajic said. "Not even to make the team or to play in the Olympics, just to get a chance to prove myself because in Serbia everyone is so good and so tall. When you grow up and people are telling you you're too short and you're not going to play at a high level, you get kind of mad. I just wanted to prove to myself that I can do it, so I'm just very excited for the chance."

KEEP BLASTING! IGNITE PACKING A PUNCH

The Ignite boast a potent attack, with the team at the top of PVF in multiple offensive categories. Indy leads the league in kills per set and assists per set, is first in kill percentage and second in points per set.

It's been a total team effort. Middle blocker **Lydia Martyn** (shown above) leads the league in kill percentage (48.9%) and is second in kill efficiency (35.7%). Opposite hitter **Azhani Tealer** (shown above) is third in points scored (431) and kills (365) and tied for fourth in kill percentage (43.3%). Middle blocker **Caroline** "**CC" Crawford** is tied for seventh in kill efficiency (30.0%) and eighth in kill percentage (40.7%).

Setter **Sydney Hilley** has already set the PVF season record for assists (1,180 and counting), and her average of 11.46 assists per set is on pace to become another league standard. Hilley also is tied for ninth in service aces (15) and 10th in digs (275). Libero **Elena Murr** is fifth in digs (320).


