#### **VIBE VS SUPERNOVAS RECAP ON 5/4**

The Atlanta Vibe (19-9) saw their historic 13-game win streak end with a four-set loss to the Omaha Supernovas (21-7) at Gas South Arena. Outside hitter Leah Edmond led the team with 17 kills, followed by opposite hitter Aiko Jones (13), middle blocker Khori Louis and outside hitter Micaya White (11 each). Middle blocker McKenna Vicini posted a match-high .412 hitting efficiency, while the Vibe narrowly outhit Omaha overall, .322 to .319. Defensively, libero Morgan Hentz tallied 23 digs, with setter Marlie Monserez and Edmond adding 12 each, and Louis recorded a match-best five blocks. Despite the loss, Atlanta led in total points (77), digs (66), and assists (62).

#### **VALKYRIES VS VIBE STAT COMPARISON**

Offensively, the Vibe are tied for first in the league for kill percentage, averaging .367, while the Valkyries are ranked third, averaging .366. Defensively, the Valkyries are third in the league for digs per set, averaging 16.70, while the Vibe's digs per set average on the season is 17.27, holding the highest amount in the league. In aces on the season, the Vibe total 129 aces, ranked first in the league for aces per set, while the Valkyries total 124, ranked second in the league. As for assists, Atlanta holds the third highest assists per set with 12.97 and the Valkyries are first averaging 13.25 assists per set.

#### ATLANTA LANDS TWO PVF AWARDS

The Pro Volleyball Federation announced its 2025 season awards, with the Atlanta Vibe earning two major honors. Morgan Hentz was named Libero of the Year for the second consecutive season after averaging a PVF-record 4.50 digs per set and playing every set for the second year in a row. Rookie Khori Louis earned the Rising Star Award, leading the league with a record 35.9 hitting efficiency and a 44.9 kill percentage in her standout debut season.

#### **FOUR VIBE PLAYERS EARN LEAGUE AWARDS**

Four Atlanta Vibe players earned All-PVF honors ahead of the Championship Tournament in Las Vegas. Leah Edmond and Morgan Hentz were named to the first team, while Marlie Monserez and rookie Khori Louis earned second-team recognition. Edmond, a repeat first-teamer, ranked second in both kills (409) and aces (41), and made the top 10 in digs and blocks. Hentz led the league in digs with 508, continuing her dominance as a top libero. Monserez broke the league record for assists in a 3-set match and finished third in total assists (998). Louis impressed in her rookie season, leading the league in hitting efficiency and finishing second in kill percentage.

#### THIRTEEN WINS IN A ROW

The Vibe's 13-game win streak has come to an end, but it will go down as the longest in PVF history. They dominated the 2025 season with unmatched consistency, setting a record no other team reached. Despite the loss to Omaha in the final game, the Vibe's historic run stands as the league's top streak this year. With four teams left in the playoff, they will fight to compete against Orlando and the winner of Omaha vs. Indy. The Vibe have beaten every single team in the playoffs this season.

# **HEAD COACH KAYLA BANWARTH**

As a former Power Five head volleyball coach and a member of the 2016 USA Olympic Team, Banwarth has expansive knowledge of the game. Her impressive career with Team USA spanned six years of international competition, during which she collected eight medals. Notably, she earned a bronze medal at the 2016 Olympics, adding to her legacy in American volleyball history.

Banwarth previously served as head coach at Ole Miss and as an assistant for the powerhouse Nebraska program. After making a shift to coaching in 2017, Banwarth stepped into an assistant role at the University of Nebraska. In her debut season, she helped guide



the Huskers to a Big Ten Championship and a NCAA Championship title. In 2020, Banwarth became head coach at Ole Miss turning around the volleyball program from a 1-9 record in the 2020-2021 season to a staggering 21-9 record in 2022. Banwarth heads into her first season as the newly appointed Atlanta Vibe head coach.
