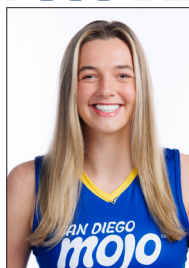

MATCHUP STORYLINES

• San Diego travels to Van Andel Arena looking to extend its two-game winning streak, though the Mojo are still searching for their first road victory of the season at 0–4. Grand Rapids has dropped its last four matches since a 3–1 win in San Diego on Jan. 23, when the Rise opened with a 31–29 first-set win.

• The Mojo continue to grow under first-year head coach Alisha Childress, with standout performances from Marlie Monserez, Grace Loberg, Shara Venegas, and Marin Grote. San Diego's balanced offense, anchored by Monserez, Loberg, Jovana Brakočević, Maya Tabron, and rookie Hayden Kubik, is complemented by league-leading backcourt defense led by Venegas.

• The Rise return home with an experienced lineup, featuring Alexis Shelton, Paige Briggs-Romine, and Rhamat Alhassan, who provide scoring and front-row presence. Grand Rapids has played two five-set matches this season and continues to rely on balanced contributions across its roster, including libero Elena Oglivie and setter Saige Ka'aha'aina-Torres.

SAN DIEGO MOJO OUTLOOK

• Statement Win at Home: The San Diego Mojo earned their second straight victory with a four-set win over league-leading Indy Ignite, 23-25, 25-23, 25-22, 25-15, improving to 3-2 at Viejas Arena and climbing into sixth place in the standings. After dropping a tight opening set, San Diego responded by winning three straight, closing the match with a dominant fourth-set performance.

• Monserez Driving the Offense: Setter Marlie Monserez extended her franchise-record double-double streak to eight straight in the win over Indy and continues to rank among the league's elite. She is second in total assists (375) and fifth in assists per set (10.14), while also ranking eighth in total digs (113) and 10th in digs per set (3.05). Offensively, Monserez leads the league in hitting efficiency (45.0%) and ranks fourth in kill percentage (46.7%), underscoring her efficiency as both a facilitator and scorer.

• Loberg Filling the Stat Sheet: Grace Loberg remains one of the league's most versatile players, ranking fifth in total points (131) and

eighth in points per set (3.74). She is seventh in total kills (110) and 10th in kills per set (3.14), tied for fourth in total service aces (10), tied for eighth in aces per set (0.23), and ninth in both total digs (108) and digs per set (3.09).

- **Grote's Presence at the Net and Service Line:** Middle blocker Marin Grote is tied for ninth in total blocks (15) and ranks 10th in blocks per set (0.44). From the service line, she has been one of the league's most dangerous players, tied for second in total aces (10) and tied for third in aces per set (0.29).

- **Venegas Anchors the Back Row:** Libero Shara Venegas ranks third in both total digs (133) and digs per set (3.69), providing steady serve receive and defensive consistency that extends rallies and stabilizes the floor defense.

- **Brakočević's All-Around Impact:** Opposite hitter Jovana Brakočević continues to provide offensive production and serving pressure, tied for eighth in total service aces (7) and tied for eighth in aces per set (0.23), delivering in key stretches.

- **Efficiency in the Middle:** McKenna Vicini ranks fourth in hitting efficiency (36.8%) and seventh in kill percentage (42.6%).

GRAND RAPIDS OUTLOOK

- **Seeking a Spark Against San Diego:** Grand Rapids enters the matchup aiming to stop a four-match losing streak, with their last win occurring against San Diego on January 23. In that 3-1 victory, the Rise hit .277 and captured a 31-29 opening set before taking control of the match.

- **League Leaders Driving Production:**

- Setter Saige Ka'aha'aina-Torres ranks fourth in the league in assists per set at 10.52 and sixth in total assists with 326, anchoring the Rise offense.

- Carli Snyder ranks ninth in the league with 89 kills and 10th in kills per set at 3.18 despite missing the last three contests. She recently moved into second place in franchise history with 404 career kills, trailing only Claire Chaussee at 429. Snyder also holds team records for points with 487, aces with 37 and attack attempts with 1,330.

- Middle blocker Rhamat Alhassan is tied for third in the league with 22 total blocks and ranks third in blocks per set at 0.73, giving Grand Rapids one of the top front row defensive presences in MLV.

- **Home Court Trends:** Grand Rapids is 1-2 at home this season and 14-15 all time at Van Andel Arena. The Rise are 5-2 in three set matches at home and 6-4 in five set matches but 3-9 in four set contests.

MOJO-RISE CONNECTIONS

- **Former Rise to Mojo Pipeline:** Three current Mojo players previously suited up for Grand Rapids. Middle blocker Marin Grote spent the 2024 and 2025 seasons with the Rise and still holds the franchise records for most sets played (154) and total blocks (95). Outside hitter Shannon Scully played for Grand Rapids in 2024, as did middle blocker Kayla Caffey.

- **Championship Ties at Texas:** Mojo middle blocker Kayla Caffey and Rise setter Saige Ka'aha'aina-Torres were teammates on the University of Texas team that captured the 2022 NCAA National Championship.

- **Wisconsin Roots and Pro Overlap:** Mojo outside hitter Grace Loberg and Rise opposite hitter Lauren Jardine-Clark won the 2021 NCAA National Championship at Wisconsin. They later reunited professionally with the Vegas Thrill alongside current Rise players Allison Mayfield and Berkeley Oblad, under first-year Mojo head coach Alisha Childress with

- **Florida Alumni Connection:** Mojo setter Marie Monserez, Rise middle blocker Rhamat Alhassan and Rise outside hitter Carli Snyder all played at the University of Florida. Monserez arrived in Gainesville one season after Alhassan and Snyder graduated, linking the programs across generations.

MOJO'S DEFENSIVE DYNAMO

- Shara Venegas ranks third in the league in total digs (119) and third in digs per set (3.72).

- Posted a match-high 20 digs vs. Columbus (Feb. 6), marking her third 20-dig performance of the season and ninth of her career.

- Has recorded double-digit digs in every match this season.

- 2025 Most Inspirational Player and All-Star.

- Holds the Mojo franchise single-season record with 413 digs and ranks second all-time in PVF single-season digs.

- One of the most accomplished liberos in international volleyball with 15+ years of pro and national team experience.

- Represented Puerto Rico at four FIVB World Championships (2014, 2018, 2022, 2025).

SETTING SAVANT

- Setter Marie Monserez continues to direct one of the league's most efficient offenses, ranking second in total assists (375) and fifth in assists per set (10.14).

- Leads Major League Volleyball in hitting efficiency (45.0%) and ranks fourth in kill percentage (46.7%), underscoring her offensive efficiency as a setter.

- Also ranks eighth in total digs (113) and 10th in digs per set (3.05), contributing consistently in the back row.

- Recorded her eighth consecutive double-double against Indy (44 assists, 10 digs), the longest streak in franchise history.

- Two-time PVF All-League selection (2024, 2025).

- Finished the 2025 season ranked third in the PVF with 998 assists, averaging 10.62 assists per set.

RELIABLE RALLY HITTER

- Outside hitter Grace Loberg ranks among the league leaders in total points (131, 5th), points per set (3.74, 8th), total kills (110, 7th), kills per set (3.14, 10th), service aces (t-4th, 10), aces per set (0.23, t-8th), total digs (108, 9th), and digs per set (3.09, 9th).
- Added 11 points, seven kills, four blocks, and 14 digs vs. Columbus, continuing her consistent two-way production.
- Set franchise single-match record with four service aces in Atlanta earlier this season.
- Appeared in 139 collegiate matches with more than 1,200 career kills; NCAA National Champion in 2021 at Wisconsin.
- Has set single-season career highs in kills, digs, attacks, aces, and blocks, surpassing what she recorded in her first two seasons combined.

OPPOSITE POWERHOUSE

- Jovana Brakočević is a three-time Olympian and 2016 Olympic silver medalist for Serbia.
- Delivered match highs of 20 points and 17 kills vs. Columbus, hitting .440 on 39 swings, with two blocks and an ace.
- Ranks tied for eighth in the league in service aces (7) and tied for eighth in aces per set (0.23).
- Six-time professional MVP with championships in over 10 countries; MVP of Champions League and FIVB Club World Championship with VakıfBank.
- Led Serbia to its first European Championship gold in 2011, earning MVP and Best Spiker honors.

TABRON TAKES CHARGE

- Maya Tabron, a dual U.S. and Swedish citizen, represents Sweden internationally.
- Recorded nine kills and 12 digs against Omaha on Jan. 30, adding consistent serve-receive and floor coverage.
- Had her second consecutive double-double in the home match against Grand Rapids on Jan. 23, finishing with 16 kills on .391 hitting and 17 digs, along with an ace and two assists.
- Recorded her first double-double of the season vs. Atlanta on Jan. 18 with 10 kills and 15 digs.
- Set multiple Mojo rookie records in 2025, including blocks (38), blocks per set (0.47), and aces per set (0.15), while tying the franchise rookie record with 12 service aces.
- Posted seven double-doubles during her 2025 rookie campaign.

BLOCKING BOSS

- Middle blocker Marin Grote is tied for second in total aces (10) and tied for third in aces per set (0.29).
- Ranks tied for ninth in total blocks (15) and 10th in blocks per set (0.44).
- Posted 15 points vs. Columbus, including 12 kills, two service aces, and one block.
- Two-time All-Pac-12 selection and AVCA All-American at Washington.
- 2025 All-Star with Grand Rapids.

MIDDLE BLOCKER MARVEL

- Kayla Caffey is one of MLV's most explosive and athletic middle blockers.
- Ranks fourth in the league in kill percentage (.490) and third in hitting efficiency (.412).

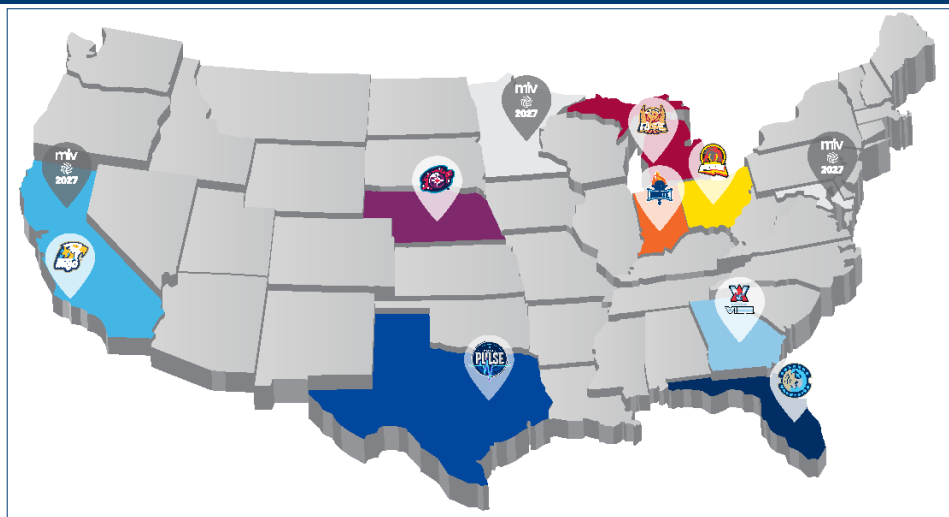
- Major League Volleyball is the premier professional women's indoor volleyball league in North America, featuring elite American players, Olympians and top international talent.
- Entering its third season, MLV continues to elevate the sport through high-level competition, innovation and nationwide visibility.
- The league is aligned with USA Volleyball and committed to Olympic development, serving as a premier pathway from professional play to the international stage.

EXPANSION AND GROWTH IN MAJOR LEAGUE VOLLEYBALL

- Major League Volleyball's footprint continues to expand, highlighted by Dallas taking the court for the first time this season and the addition of teams in Minnesota, Northern California and Washington, D.C., confirmed for the 2027 campaign.
- With continued strategic growth, the league is slated to feature 11 teams during the 2027 season, further strengthening its national presence.
- MLV already competes in some of the nation's largest media markets, with all eight teams in 2026 located within the top 45 designated market areas (DMAs).
- Four current teams are based in top-25 DMAs, and the addition of three new franchises in 2027 will bring Major League Volleyball into three more top-20 markets.

- The season will feature coverage across CBS Sports, Roku Sports Channel, ION, VICE and MLV digital platforms, with opening weekend, weekly marquee matchups, and postseason action showcased on national television.
- For the third consecutive season, every remaining match will also be available on the MLV YouTube Channel and through local broadcast agreements, providing nationwide access and continued growth for professional volleyball in the U.S.

ALISHA CHILDRESS

HEAD COACH

The San Diego Mojo tabbed U.S. Olympic bronze medalist and four-time NCAA champion Alisha Glass Childress as the second head coach in franchise history on August 10, 2025. Childress previously served as an assistant coach at Stanford University and with the U.S. Women's National Team. She also served as a coach during the 2025 season with Athletes Unlimited.

Childress joined the Stanford coaching staff in 2019, spending two seasons on the Cardinal sideline and playing a pivotal role in helping guide the program to victory in the 2019 NCAA National Championship.

Before her time on The Farm, Childress served as an assistant coach with the U.S. National Team during the 2018 Pan American Cup, where the U.S. rallied to win gold over host Dominican Republic.

As a player, Childress is regarded as one of the top setters in the world. During her nine-year professional career, she played in the United States, Italy, Turkey, Poland, Puerto Rico and Brazil. Childress spent the 2024 and 2025 seasons with the Vegas Thrill, collecting All-League accolades in 2024 while also earning Most Inspirational Player honors from the league's coaches, and playing in the league's inaugural All-Star Match in 2025.

Childress directed U.S. National Team offensive attacks for six years, helping lead Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio, where she earned Best Setter honors. She was also selected Best Setter of the 2016 NORCECA Olympic Qualification Tournament, guiding the U.S. to gold and an automatic spot in the Rio Games.

A two-time USA Volleyball Indoor Athlete of the Year (2013, 2014), Childress earned gold medals in three consecutive FIVB World Grand Prix Finals (2010, 2011, 2012).

Childress played collegiately at Penn State from 2006–09 for legendary head coach Russ Rose, leading the Nittany Lions to three straight national titles from 2007–09 and posting a 110–2 record during the three-year run. She was a three-time AVCA All-American, three-time All-Big Ten Conference and three-time NCAA Championship All-Tournament selection, and a nominee for the 2009 Honda Volleyball Award.

A four-year starter for the Nittany Lions, she concluded her Penn State career ranked fourth in program history with 5,800 assists and 12.47 assists per set, 13th in hitting percentage at .336 and blocks with 448 and 15th with 465 sets played.

As a prep player, the Leland, Michigan native was a four-year letterwinner at Leland High, earning Michigan Gatorade Player of the Year and Miss Volleyball for the state of Michigan in 2006 after leading the Comets to the 2006 Class D state championship, producing a single-match record of 48 kills in the title match. She was a four-time first-team all-state, all-region and all-conference selection, concluding her high school career as the National and State High School record holder in season aces (296), career aces (937) and career kills (3,584).

A two-sport star, she earned first-team all-state accolades in basketball her junior and senior seasons. Raised in a coaching family, her mother, Laurie Glass, was her high school volleyball coach, and her grandfather, Larry Glass, was her high school basketball coach.

Childress is married to eight-year NBA basketball veteran and Stanford All-American Josh Childress. They have three daughters, Maya, Mina and Amara.

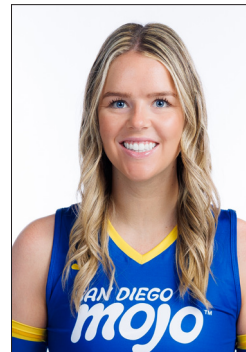
