

MATCHUP STORYLINES

- **Mojo Seeking Fourth Straight:** San Diego (4-6) enters the rematch on a three-match winning streak, tied for the longest in franchise history. The run includes a four-set win over the Indy Ignite on Monday and a historic reverse sweep at Grand Rapids. A victory in Indianapolis would mark the first four-match winning streak in franchise history.
- **Road Challenge in the Series:** The Mojo lead the all-time series 3-2 but are 0-2 in Indianapolis.
- **Monserez Driving the Surge:** Setter Marlie Monserez has recorded double-doubles in eight of the last nine matches and ranks among the league leaders in both assists and digs. She is second in total assists (430) and fifth in assists per set (10.24), while also sitting fifth in total digs (121). Her ability to contribute defensively while directing the offense has been central to San Diego's recent stretch.
- **Middle Matchup at the Net:** San Diego's starting middles, McKenna Vicini and Marin Grote, face an Indy front row anchored by Lydia Martin and Blake Mohler, who rank among the league leaders in blocks per set. Efficiency in the middle third of the net could shape long rallies and late-set outcomes.
- **Opposite Production:** Jovana Brakočević is coming off a 22-point, 18-kill performance in the five-set win at Grand Rapids, including a block and kill in the closing stretch of the fifth set. She squares off against Indy's Azhani Tealer, who ranks among the league leaders in points and kills as the Ignite remain in first place at 7-2.

SAN DIEGO MOJO OUTLOOK

- **Historic Reverse Sweep:** The San Diego Mojo enter the weekend on a three-match winning streak after defeating the Grand Rapids Rise in five sets at Van Andel Arena. San Diego erased a 2-0 deficit for the first time in franchise history after entering the match 0-19 when trailing two sets to none. The win marked the Mojo's first road victory of the season and tied the franchise record for consecutive wins with three.
- **Brakočević's Dynamic Performance:** Opposite Jovana Brakočević led all players with 22 points and 18 kills on 36 swings against Grand Rapids, hitting .500 with a .438 efficiency. She added 15 digs for her first double-double of the season and

delivered a block and a kill late in the fifth set to help seal the match.

- **Monserez Among League Leaders:** Setter Marlie Monserez ranks second in total assists (430) and fifth in assists per set (10.24). She also ranks fifth in total digs (121) and 10th in digs per set (2.88). Offensively, Monserez leads the league in hitting efficiency (43.9%) and ranks fifth in kill percentage (45.5%).

- **Caffey's Efficiency in the Middle:** Middle blocker Kayla Caffey ranks second in hitting efficiency (41.3%) and second in kill percentage (50.7%).

- **Loberg Across the Leaderboard:** Grace Loberg ranks sixth in total points (150) and total kills (124), 10th in points per set (3.75) and kills per set (3.10), seventh in total digs (117), eighth in digs per set (2.92), seventh in total service aces (9), ninth in aces per set (0.23), and 10th in both total blocks (17) and blocks per set (0.42).

- **Grote from the Service Line:** Marin Grote is tied for fifth in total service aces (10) and ranks seventh in aces per set (0.28).

- **Venegas on the Back Row:** Libero Shara Venegas is tied for first in total digs (151) and ranks first in digs per set (3.68).

- **Vicini at the Net:** McKenna Vicini ranks fourth in hitting efficiency (35.2%).

INDY IGNITE OUTLOOK

- **First-Place Form:** The Indy Ignite remain in first place in Major League Volleyball, entering Sunday at 7-2 overall. After a four-set loss in San Diego on Monday, Indy responded with a four-set home win over Orlando on Friday to maintain its position atop the standings.

- **Tealer Leading the Offense:** Opposite Azhani Tealer ranks tied for fifth in total points (150) and sixth in points per set (4.29). She is fifth in total kills (133), seventh in kills per set (3.80) and ninth in kill percentage (.435). In the win over Orlando, Tealer matched a franchise record with 27 points in a four-set match, including 23 kills at a 51.1 percent clip.

- **Tuaniga Setting the Pace:** Setter Mia Tuaniga ranks fourth in total assists (388) and first in assists per set (11.41). She also provides scoring pressure from the service line, tied for fourth in total aces (10) and sixth in aces per set (0.29).

- **Martin at the Net:** Middle blocker Lydia Martin ranks fourth in kill percentage (46.7%) and is tied for fifth in total blocks (22). Her 0.92 blocks per set lead the league.

- **Mohler's Blocking Presence:** Blake Mohler is tied for ninth in total blocks (18) and ranks third in blocks per set (0.78), giving Indy two middles among the league leaders in blocking production.

- **Service Pressure on the Outside:** Anna DeBeer is tied for eighth in total aces (8) and ranks third in aces per set (0.33), adding another serving threat to Indy's lineup.

MOJO'S LEAGUE-LEADING LIBERO

- Shara Venegas is tied for first in Major League Volleyball in total digs (151) and ranks first in digs per set (3.68).

- Posted a team-high 18 digs in the five-set win at Grand Rapids on Feb. 12.

- Has recorded double-digit digs in eight of 10 matches this season and had three matches of 20 or more digs.

- 2025 Most Inspirational Player and All-Star.

- Holds the Mojo franchise single-season record with 413 digs and ranks second all-time in MLV single-season digs.

- Setter Marlie Monserez ranks second in total assists (430) and fifth in assists per set (10.24).

- Also ranks fifth in total digs (121).

- Leads the league in hitting efficiency (43.9%) and ranks fifth in kill percentage (45.5%).

- Has three matches of 55+ assists and six of 40 or more assists.

- Recorded double-doubles in eight of the last nine matches.

- Had 56 assists and eight digs in the reverse sweep at Grand Rapids (Feb. 12).

- Established a team record with eight consecutive double-doubles (Jan. 15-Feb. 9).

RELIABLE RALLY HITTER

- Grace Loberg continues to shine as one of the league's most versatile two-way players. She ranks sixth in total points (150) and total kills (124), while also sitting 10th in points per set (3.75) and kills per set (3.10).

- Her all-around contributions extend to defense and serving, ranking seventh in total digs (117) and eighth in digs per set (2.92), seventh in total service aces (9) and ninth in aces per set (0.23).

- Loberg also provides a consistent front-row presence, ranking 10th in total blocks (17) and blocks per set (0.42), giving the Mojo production in every phase of the game.

- Set franchise single-match record with four service aces in Atlanta (Feb. 1).

- Appeared in 139 collegiate matches with more than 1,200 career kills; NCAA National Champion in 2021 at Wisconsin.
- Has set single-season career highs in kills, digs, attacks, aces, and blocks, surpassing what she recorded in her first two seasons combined.

OPPOSITE POWERHOUSE

- Jovana Brakočević is a three-time Olympian and 2016 Olympic silver medalist for Serbia.
- Had five double-digit kill performances this season.
- Jovana Brakočević posted 22 points and 18 kills on .500 hitting in the five-set win at Grand Rapids on Feb. 12, adding 15 digs for her first double-double of the season.
- Delivered match highs of 20 points and 17 kills vs. Columbus on Feb. 6, hitting .440 on 39 swings, with two blocks and an ace.
- Six-time professional MVP with championships in over 10 countries; MVP of Champions League and FIVB Club World Championship with VakıfBank.
- Led Serbia to its first European Championship gold in 2011, earning MVP and Best Spiker honors.

TABRON TAKES CHARGE

- Maya Tabron, a dual U.S. and Swedish citizen, represents Sweden internationally.
- Recorded nine kills and 12 digs against Omaha on Jan. 30, adding consistent serve-receive and floor coverage.
- Had her second consecutive double-double in the home match against Grand Rapids on Jan. 23, finishing with 16 kills on .391 hitting and 17 digs, along with an ace and two assists.
- Recorded her first double-double of the season vs. Atlanta on Jan. 18 with 10 kills and 15 digs.
- Set multiple Mojo rookie records in 2025, including blocks (38), blocks per set (0.47), and aces per set (0.15), while tying the franchise rookie record with 12 service aces.
- Posted seven double-doubles during her 2025 rookie campaign.

BLOCKING BOSS

- Middle blocker Marin Grote is tied for fifth in total aces (10) and ranks seventh in aces per set (0.28).
- Posted 15 points vs. Columbus (Feb. 6), including 12 kills, two service aces, and one block.
- Had 17 points at Omaha on Jan. 30 with season highs of 12 kills and five blocks
- Two-time All-Pac-12 selection and AVCA All-American at Washington.
- 2025 All-Star with Grand Rapids.

EFFICIENCY IN THE MIDDLE

- Kayla Caffey ranks second in hitting efficiency (41.3%) and second in kill percentage (50.7%).
- Recorded 10 points on nine kills and one block in the five-set win at Grand Rapids.
- Helped Omaha secure the league's top regular-season record in 2025, appearing in 25 matches.
- In 2025, ranked sixth in MLV in service aces (18), eighth in kill percentage (40.8%), and 10th in hitting percentage (.294).

- Two-time NCAA Championship finalist and 2022 national champion at Texas.


- Major League Volleyball is the premier professional women’s indoor volleyball league in North America, featuring elite American players, Olympians and top international talent.
- Entering its third season, MLV continues to elevate the sport through high-level competition, innovation and nationwide visibility.
- The league is aligned with USA Volleyball and committed to Olympic development, serving as a premier pathway from professional play to the international stage.

EXPANSION AND GROWTH IN MAJOR LEAGUE VOLLEYBALL

- Major League Volleyball’s footprint continues to expand, highlighted by Dallas taking the court for the first time this season and the addition of teams in Minnesota, Northern California and Washington, D.C., confirmed for the 2027 campaign.
- With continued strategic growth, the league is slated to feature 11 teams during the 2027 season, further strengthening its national presence.
- MLV already competes in some of the nation’s largest media markets, with all eight teams in 2026 located within the top 45 designated market areas (DMAs).
- Four current teams are based in top-25 DMAs, and the addition of three new franchises in 2027 will bring Major League Volleyball into three more top-20 markets.

- Major League Volleyball announced a landmark 50-match national broadcast schedule, the most expansive media rollout in league history, highlighted by the MLV Championship airing on ION and the All-Star Match on CBS and Paramount+.
- The season will feature coverage across CBS Sports, Roku Sports Channel, ION, VICE and MLV digital platforms, with opening weekend, weekly marquee matchups, and postseason action showcased on national television.
- For the third consecutive season, every remaining match will also be available on the MLV YouTube Channel and through local broadcast agreements, providing nationwide access and continued growth for professional volleyball in the U.S.

ALISHA CHILDRESS

HEAD COACH

The San Diego Mojo tabbed U.S. Olympic bronze medalist and four-time NCAA champion Alisha Glass Childress as the second head coach in franchise history on August 10, 2025. Childress previously served as an assistant coach at Stanford University and with the U.S. Women's National Team. She also served as a coach during the 2025 season with Athletes Unlimited.

Childress joined the Stanford coaching staff in 2019, spending two seasons on the Cardinal sideline and playing a pivotal role in helping guide the program to victory in the 2019 NCAA National Championship.

Before her time on The Farm, Childress served as an assistant coach with the U.S. National Team during the 2018 Pan American Cup, where the U.S. rallied to win gold over host Dominican Republic.

As a player, Childress is regarded as one of the top setters in the world. During her nine-year professional career, she played in the United States, Italy, Turkey, Poland, Puerto Rico and Brazil. Childress spent the 2024 and 2025 seasons with the Vegas Thrill, collecting All-League accolades in 2024 while also earning Most Inspirational Player honors from the league's coaches, and playing in the league's inaugural All-Star Match in 2025.

Childress directed U.S. National Team offensive attacks for six years, helping lead Team USA to a bronze medal at the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio, where she earned Best Setter honors. She was also selected Best Setter of the 2016 NORCECA Olympic Qualification Tournament, guiding the U.S. to gold and an automatic spot in the Rio Games.

A two-time USA Volleyball Indoor Athlete of the Year (2013, 2014), Childress earned gold medals in three consecutive FIVB World Grand Prix Finals (2010, 2011, 2012).

Childress played collegiately at Penn State from 2006–09 for legendary head coach Russ Rose, leading the Nittany Lions to three straight national titles from 2007–09 and posting a 110–2 record during the three-year run. She was a three-time AVCA All-American, three-time All-Big Ten Conference and three-time NCAA Championship All-Tournament selection, and a nominee for the 2009 Honda Volleyball Award.

A four-year starter for the Nittany Lions, she concluded her Penn State career ranked fourth in program history with 5,800 assists and 12.47 assists per set, 13th in hitting percentage at .336 and blocks with 448 and 15th with 465 sets played.

As a prep player, the Leland, Michigan native was a four-year letterwinner at Leland High, earning Michigan Gatorade Player of the Year and Miss Volleyball for the state of Michigan in 2006 after leading the Comets to the 2006 Class D state championship, producing a single-match record of 48 kills in the title match. She was a four-time first-team all-state, all-region and all-conference selection, concluding her high school career as the National and State High School record holder in season aces (296), career aces (937) and career kills (3,584).

A two-sport star, she earned first-team all-state accolades in basketball her junior and senior seasons. Raised in a coaching family, her mother, Laurie Glass, was her high school volleyball coach, and her grandfather, Larry Glass, was her high school basketball coach.

Childress is married to eight-year NBA basketball veteran and Stanford All-American Josh Childress. They have three daughters, Maya, Mina and Amara.


