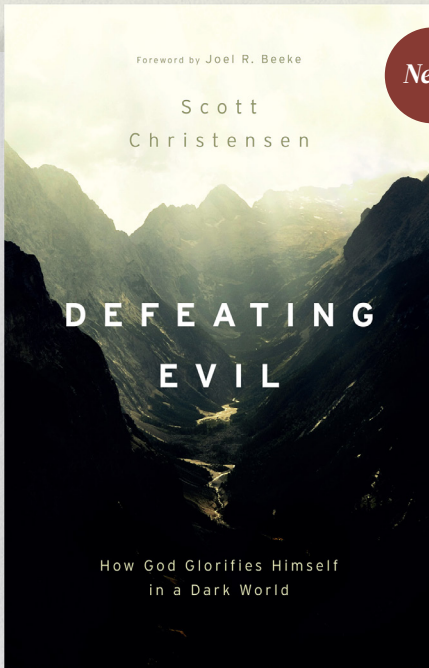


Etching of Adam Smith created by Cadell and Davies (1811), John Horsburgh (1828) or R. C. Bell (1872). Public domain.
