

imee Byrd started Why Can't We Be Friends? with a bold goal in mind: "I wrote this book because I want us to be biblically faithful in a very important area: our relationships." Our relationships—with our fellow believers, our friends, our spouses, our children, and our Godare critical to the shape of our lives. It's no wonder so many of our recent releases make relationships the focus of their wise insight and practical advice.

Why Can't We Be Friends? (Aimee Byrd p. 7)

Can men and women be friends? If you're alive and reading this, you probably have an opinion shaped by many factors, including your own experiences. When Aimee Byrd comes at this question, she upends it. Why ask if we can be friends when Christian men and women are already brothers and sisters in Christ? Instead, we need to ask what biblical brotherhood and sisterhood looks like and how we can model it in our own lives. Byrd challenges thinking on all sides as she holds this critical issue to the light of Scripture.

For the Love of Discipline (Sara Wallace p. 4)

For parents who want to have a good relationship with their children, discipline can feel like painful intrusion. But in Sara Wallace's positive view, parents can use moments of obedience or disobedience as wonderful opportunities to train and teach their children—even when their children are very small. Saturated with scriptural wisdom, Wallace's practical suggestions are empowering and easy to implement right away. I've been telling people about "word bundles" for months!

Loving Your Friend through Cancer (Marissa Henley p. 5)

We all wish no one had to read this book, but Marissa Henley was the perfect person to write it. During her battle with a rare form of cancer, Henley was blessed by the love and care of her friends. She's put that to practical use by writing a book to help you to help others, whether they're close friends or distant acquaintances. She'll answer questions that you may hesitate to ask, and she'll guide you in not only avoiding common mistakes but making a real difference. I was pleased to find that her insights transfer well to other situations, such as helping a friend with a chronic illness.

Domestic Abuse: How to Help and Domestic Abuse: Recognize, Respond, Rescue (Darby A. Strickland p. 8)

What do we do when our closest relationships become a source of oppression and pain? It's been encouraging to see a renewed concern for women and men—who experience abuse, but even so, wise and godly intervention is fraught with difficulty. Moreover, if you're wondering if you're experiencing some kind of abuse, how can you be certain?

Darby Strickland is an experienced biblical counselor who has worked with the abused, and their abusers, for years. She doesn't blame the oppressed for their oppression, nor does she want us to be misled by the manipulation of abusive individuals. Her two booklets are packed with a wealth of information to bring clarity and guidance to suffering people and those who want to help them. Don't overlook these excellent resources.


The Life of Moses (James Montgomery Boice p. 16)





This can be difficult, because in order to seek God's mercy we must admit that we *need* it—and we don't like to admit that we need anything, much less forgiveness! But exposing the specifics of our struggles with sin regularly points us back to the good news of the gospel and our forgiveness through God's grace. It leads to celebration!

Knowing and the Trinity

How Perspectives in Human Knowledge Imitate the Trinity

Every human being has a distinct perspective and experiences truth from this viewpoint. If God exists in three persons, as the Bible teaches, is it possible to discern epistemological perspectives that originate from this mystery? Once we understand that God is Trinitarian, we can see numerous reflections of his Trinitarian character in general and in special revelation.

A Daughter's Devotion to Her Father Part 2

Is Sunday School Enough? by Melissa Urban Craig

y father was a gifted Bible teacher. But that was not always the case during his student years at Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia. Dad used to recount, with a selfdeprecating chuckle and a twinkle in his eye, what his preaching professor Dr. Edmund Clowney once told him: "Mr. Urban, of all my students, you have shown the least amount of progress!" Dad studied under the legendary old guard of WTS: Van Til, Murray, Clowney, Woolley, Young, and Stonehouse. After graduating, God led my dad into many adventures, including Wycliffe language school, foreign missions, and living with aboriginal headhunters in the remote mountains of Taiwan (his only guide being a tiny, tribal woman with tattoos etched across her face!). God used these experiences to bring life and vibrancy to Dad's storytelling and Bible teaching. He could hold a classroom of rowdy boys spellbound as they learned the whole counsel of God. I was blessed to be one of his students in a Bible class, every day in a Christian school!

The blessing of a daily Bible class is not found in secular schools, but I discovered that my fellow homeschoolers were also missing a huge opportunity. I woke up to this fact while speaking to parents at a homeschool conference. My topic was P&R's Classics for Young Readers series and the importance of Christian classic literature in a child's education. When my presentation ended I polled the group, asking how many of these families had a daily Bible class as part of their homeschool curriculum. Not one person raised their hand, and I saw many puzzled faces. "Isn't that what Sunday school is for?" someone asked.

Our Children Need Bible Literacu

Sunday school provides an opportunity for Christian nurture within covenant community. However, it is the brevity of Sunday school that limits its effectiveness in a major way. Less than one hour each week is spent on a Bible lesson. If you are counting on Sunday school programs alone to impart Bible literacy to your child, you are in for a rude awakening. We can easily see that a child is ill served when assigned only one math problem a week in order to gain math proficiency. That would be malpractice! But neither will one Bible story per week give your child biblical literacy. When we as Christians have Bible literacy, our knowledge of the whole Bible allows God to speak into our lives with authority. God's Word makes our

conscience alive to the Holy Spirit in the choices we make. Equipping your child with spiritual wisdom and discernment is the goal.

God's command to pass down biblical literacy to our covenant children involves the sacrifice of our time and the exercise of spiritual wisdom through interpersonal dialogue. Deuteronomy 6:4-9 says, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates."

Our Children Need Reformed Teaching

David and Sally Michael woke up to the blessing of Reformed teaching when they heard Rev. John Piper preach at Bethlehem Baptist Church (a Reformed congregation in MN). Instead of moralism, a new, powerful, Christ-centered view of the Bible took hold of them—and they desired to impart that teaching to their children. The

cost? God asked them to sacrifice their time, talent, and treasure for a new children's ministry. Dave declared to his wife, "I will teach nothing before we will continue teaching what we've been teaching our kids! Can you write something?" The spiritual fruit of their sacrifice turned into a ministry for children known as Truth: 78, based on Psalm 78:1-9.

P&R publishes Sally Michael's Making Him Known series, an 8-volume Bible study for children ages 3-9. According to Sally and Dave, "The teaching is Christ centered, not man centered. It inspires worship of the triune God, not moralism that depends on man's fallen, sinful will." This is the core of Reformed theology that awakens us to a proper view of God, fallen man, and God's redemption. These volumes are designed for homeschool Bible teaching and for non-homeschooling parents who desire greater Bible literacy for their children. Each colorfully illustrated book contains twenty-six lessons with study questions. One volume per semester will cover 1st – 4th grade.

Our Children Need Our Time

I pray that the Holy Spirit is nudging you awake! Read Psalm 78:1-9 and consider this: You will never get a do-over as a parent. Never. Each precious year of your child's life marks milestones that will not return. You cannot go back and hold them on your lap, tuck them into bed, or teach them a Bible memory verse or children's catechism lesson. Their high school and college graduations will arrive in the blink of an eye! You will not audibly hear a booming voice shout, "Time's up!" but the reverberation will echo in your mind, heart, and soul forever in that persistent question, "Where did the time go?"

God has given us precious promises that are "for you, and for your children" (Acts 2:39). How will you take responsibility for the spiritual formation of your children? Start by prioritizing Christcentered and Reformed Bible literacy each day.


even slept in his arms.



SKIP THE RELIGIOUS PLATITUDES

Edited excerpt from Loving Your Friend through Cancer by Marissa Henley.

he most common response heard by suffering people is something along the lines of "All things work out for good in the end." This is true. It is straight out of the Bible—in fact, it is one of my favorite verses. Romans 8:28 says, "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called

according to his purpose." Romans 8:28 is true. Romans 8:28 is good. But, when your friend is suffering, it is not the time for Romans 8:28. At that moment, Romans 8:28 will feel like a fake "happy Jesus stamp" placed on something that feels difficult, sad, and scary for your friend. As I've talked about this with believers who have suffered and heard these words. I've noticed three reasons why Romans 8:28 and other religions platitudes aren't just unhelpful but can actually damage our relationship with the hurting friend and our attempts to comfort her.

1. Your friend will think you think that she doesn't know this.

Many of my friends who have walked this road told me that when people said these things, it hurt because it implied that the suffering person didn't already know it. What they heard was, "Clearly you've forgotten that God is in charge. Your tears and grief tell me that you aren't trusting the good Lord's good plans for you."


We need to be open to the Lord's guidance and speak truth when he calls us to. But when he calls us to comfort, we can do just that. We can leave the correction to him and his timing. We can trust him to use all things for our friend's good even her struggles to believe.

2. It will feel like you're dismissing her pain or wanting her to hurry up her grief.

We desperately want to fix our friend's sadness, fear, or anger. This drive to fix is so deeply ingrained that we often don't realize how powerful a motivator it is. We think that if we can correct her thinking, we can take away some of her pain. But we're wrong. Cancer is painful no matter how convinced you are of God's sovereignty.

The truth of God's character keeps us from being crushed by our circumstances, but it doesn't take away our pain and sadness. When we understand this truth about suffering, we give our friend the freedom to take the time she needs with


> her emotions. We won't rush her. We won't try to correct her doctrine in an attempt to move her from sadness to joy in the midst of heartbreaking circumstances.



of communicating compassionate support to your friend.

If our purpose is to show empathy and support, then we should use words and Scripture that fit with our purpose. Every single cancerfighter and caregiver I've talked with has told me that platitudes such as "God has a plan," "God is sovereign," and "God will use this for good" don't make them feel understood or loved. They don't bring comfort to their hurting souls.

In my experience, verses reminding us of God's presence with us are comforting and reassuring. Look for psalms that speak of God as our refuge and strength, such as Psalm 46. Encourage your friend with Scriptures that convey God's peace, comfort, help, and faithfulness.



Let's use words and Scripture that are a balm to our friends' souls. Let's use our words to show that we understand their heartbreak and pain, not to diminish it. Let's tell our friends with cancer that we're sorry for their suffering, we love them, and we support them.




