# Neden Sorular Konuşuyor?

**KİTABIMIZI, BİR BÜTÜN OLARAK** ya da TEST TEST Kolay, Orta, Zor şeklinde **GRUPLANDIRARAK** değil, her bir soruyu tek tek ele alıp **SORU TEMELLİ BİR SINIFLANDIRMA** yaparak oluşturduk.

Yaptığımız detaylı araştırmalarda öğrencilerimizin temel probleminin Yeni Nesil Soruları çözemediği noktasında değil, onlarla barışamadığı noktasında olduğunu tespit ettik. Klasik soru kalıplarında en zor soruları çözebilen öğrencilerimizin, aslında çok basit diyebileceğimiz **KURGUSAL SORULARDA** ciddi problemler yaşadığını gördük.

Öncelikle yukarıda belirttiğimiz gibi soruların derecelendirme sisteminde kullandığımız metodu, **KİTABI BİR BÜTÜN OLARAK** ya da TEST TEST **GRUPLANDIRARAK** değil, her bir soruyu tek tek ele alarak **SORU TEMELLİ BİR SINIFLANDIRMA** ile oluşturduk.

Araştırma sonuçlarımıza göre öğrenim sürecinde **YENİ NESİL SORULARLA** ilk olarak 8. sınıfta karşılaşan öğrencilerimizin; 5, 6 ve 7. sınıflarda bu konuda tecrübe yaşamadıkları için ciddi **ADAPTASYON** sorunları yaşadıklarını tespit ettik.

Bu sebeple uyguladığımız sistemi 5. sınıftan itibaren aynı formatta planlayarak **SADECE 8. SINIFLARDA DEĞİL; 5, 6 ve 7. SINIFLARDA DA %100 KURGUYA DAYALI BİR METOT** ile öğrencilerimizin kademe kademe **YENİ SİSTEMİ** özümsemesini sağlamaya çalıştık. Bunu yaparken de bu sınıf gruplarının seviyelerini en önemli kriter olarak belirledik.

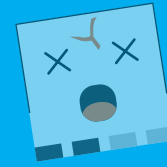

## nasıl bir sistem sunuyor?

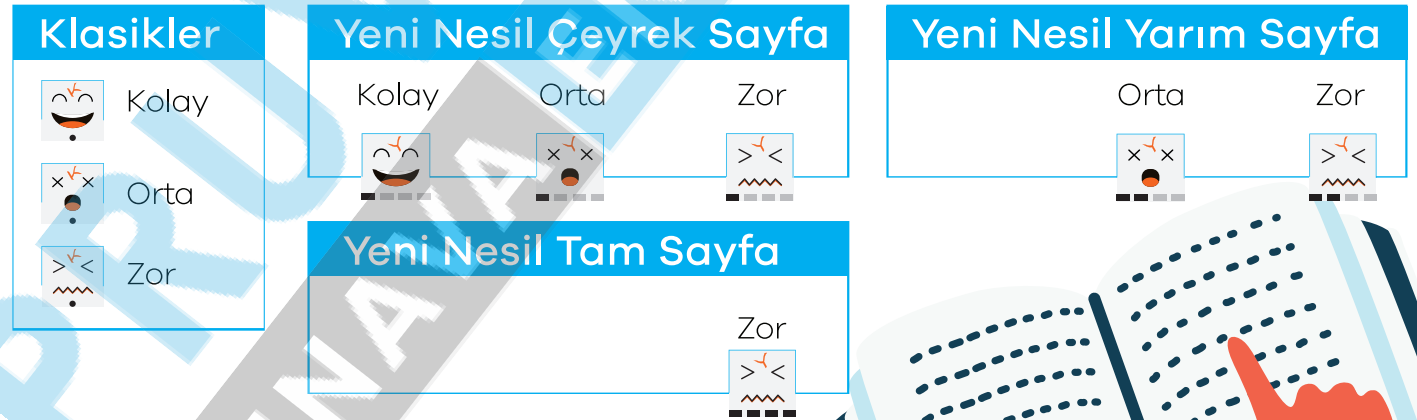
Yeni sınav sisteminde öğrencilerimiz %20 oranında **Klasik**, %80 oranında **Yeni Nesil Sorularla** karşılaşılıyor. Daha önceden olduğu gibi yine her iki soru tipinde de **Kolay / Orta / Zor** kombinasyonları kullanılıyor. Fakat bunların kullanım tarzları soru içeriklerine göre farklılık gösteriyor.

Sadece Yeni Nesil Sorular özelinde ebat olarak bir sayfayı ölçülendirmek suretiyle 3 farklı soru modeli karşımıza çıkıyor.

- Sayfanın  $\frac{1}{4}$  ü oranındaki sorular (Çeyrek Sayfa Sorular)
- Sayfanın  $\frac{1}{2}$  si oranındaki sorular (Yarım Sayfa Sorular)
- Sayfanın tamamını kaplayan sorular (Tam Sayfa Sorular)

**Klasik** ve **Yeni Nesil Soruların Kolay / Orta / Zor** kombinasyonlarını da içine alarak değerlendirdiğimizde;

# Neden

## YARIM ve TAM Sayfa Sorular diğerk sorulara benzemiyor?

**Yarım Sayfa** ve **Tam Sayfa** sorular yoğunluk, kurgu, ölçtüğü beceri alanı ve bilgi boyutu bakımından **Çeyrek Sayfa** sorulara göre daha kapsamlıdır.

Kurgusal yoğunluğu Çeyrek Sayfa Sorulara göre biraz daha fazla olduğu için Yarım Sayfa Soruların KOLAY kombinasyonuyla çoğunlukla karşılaşmıyor.

Tam Sayfa Sorularda ise derecelendirme sadece ZOR sınıfında yer alıyor. Yalnız bu zorluk sorunun kökünden değil yapısından kaynaklanıyor. Bu tarz sorular genellikle cevabı içinde saklı olan ve öğrencileri zamana karşı yarıştırmak için çözüme ulaşmalarını sağlamaya çalışıyor.

Geliştirdiğimiz yöntemle bahsettiğimiz 9 Farklı Soru Modelinin her birini **anlaşılabilir karakterlerle** soru soru sınıflandırdık. Ve **öğrencilerimizin eğlenerek anlayabileceği** ifadelerle tabloştandırdıktan sonra bu karakterleri her sorunun yanına yerleştirdik. Hiçbir testimiz TAMAMEN KOLAY veya TAMAMEN ZOR şeklinde tasnif edilmedi. Daha fazla soru çeşitliliğine ulaşmak için her test kendi içinde tüm soru tarzlarından beslenerek oluşturuldu.

Böylece ilgili konuda hangi tarz soruda sıkıntı yaşandıysa, o tarz sorulara odaklanarak gerekli tekrarların yapılması sağlandı. Bu yöntemle **öğrencilerimizin her üniteye tüm soru tarzlarıyla karşılaşmasına özen gösterdik** ve hangi tarz sorularda sıkıntı yaşadıklarını tespit etmelerine olanak sağladık.

## ÖĞRETEN SORULAR neden var?

**ÖĞRETEN SORULAR** ile klasik soru kalıplarının üstünden geçerek **Yeni Nesil Sorulara** hazırlık yapmayı amaçladık.



**Sorular Konuşuyor Serisi** kurguya dayalı bir sistem sunsa da belli oranda klasik soruların da olması gerekmektedir. Kurgusal soruların bilgiyi ölçen klasik sorular üzerine inşa edildiği artık bilinen bir gerçek. Bu sebeple tüm ünitelerin/konuların ilk testlerini (ÖĞRETEN SORULAR) klasik sorulara ayırdık. Bu testlerde klasik soruların öğrenim metodu olan kolaydan zora mantığı ile hareket ettik. ÖĞRETEN SORULARLA klasik soru kalıplarının üstünden geçerek Yeni Nesil Sorulara hazırlık yapmayı amaçladık.



# Harika bir psikolojik detay

## SINAV MODU!

2. üniteden itibaren her ünitenin sonuna sarmal formatta gerçek **SINAV KİTAPÇIĞI**'nın görsel altyapısından esinlenerek **Yeni Nesil Soru dağılımını** ve **gerçek sayfa yapısını** da dikkate alarak bir test hazırladık.

Üniversite sınavına hazırlanan bir öğrenci dilediği kadar sınava girebilir. Fakat ortaöğretim sınavına hazırlanan bir öğrenci sadece 1 defa sınava girebilmektedir. Bu açıdan baktığımızda ortaokul öğrencisi daha çok tedirgin olmakta, daha çok hata yapabilmektedir. Bir de söz konusu Yeni Nesil Sorular olunca sadece bilgi yönünden değil, **PSİKOLOJİK** yönden de bazı takviyeler yapılması gerekmektedir.

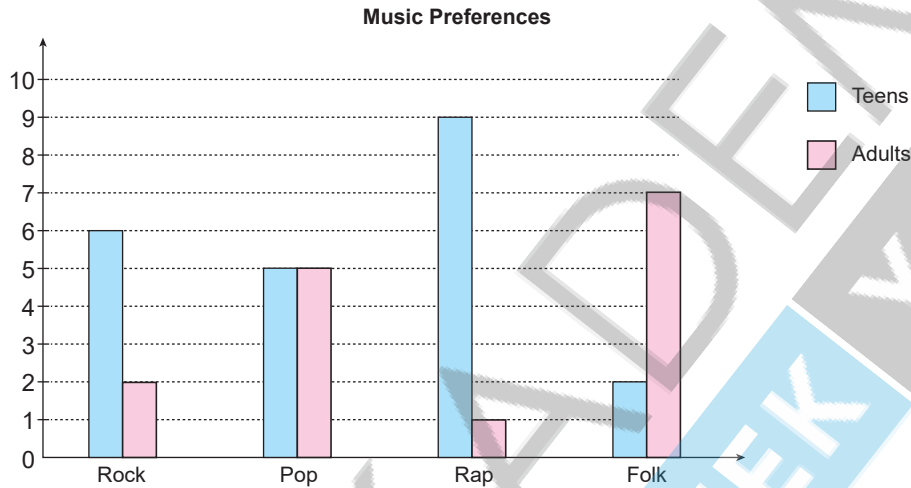

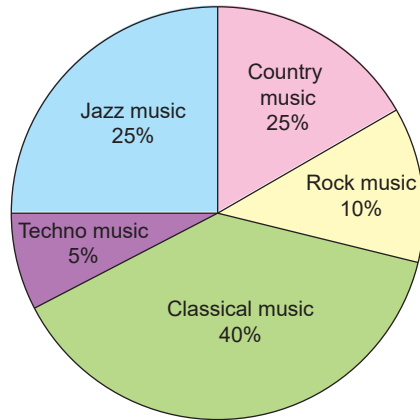

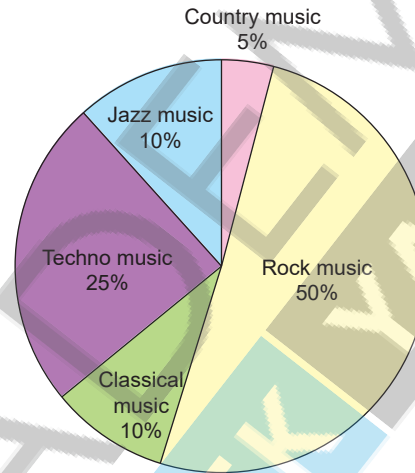
