Any requests to change a student's course selection(s) must be noted, signed by student and parent and returned to their counselor. ONLY THIS FORM MAY BE USED TO REQUEST A CHANGE.

Any changes will be due to your grade level counselor by Friday, May 19th.

Students who turned in their blue enrollment paperwork after the May 10th due date may be on a waiting list for dual credit classes for the fall semester and will need to periodically check their MyLoneStar account to see if they have been placed in the dual credit class and can make a payment.

Final Transcripts

Colleges require a final transcript to prove you graduated from high school. Final transcripts will be mailed to the college/university of your choice during the third week of June. A request to mail your final transcript must be made by completing a **FINAL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM** with the Registrar's Office. The cost of each transcript is \$2.00. Final Transcript Request Forms will be available May 10th. Requests received in the Registrars' Office after June 15th will not be processed until early August.

The Registrar's Office will be closed on June 19th through July 25th.

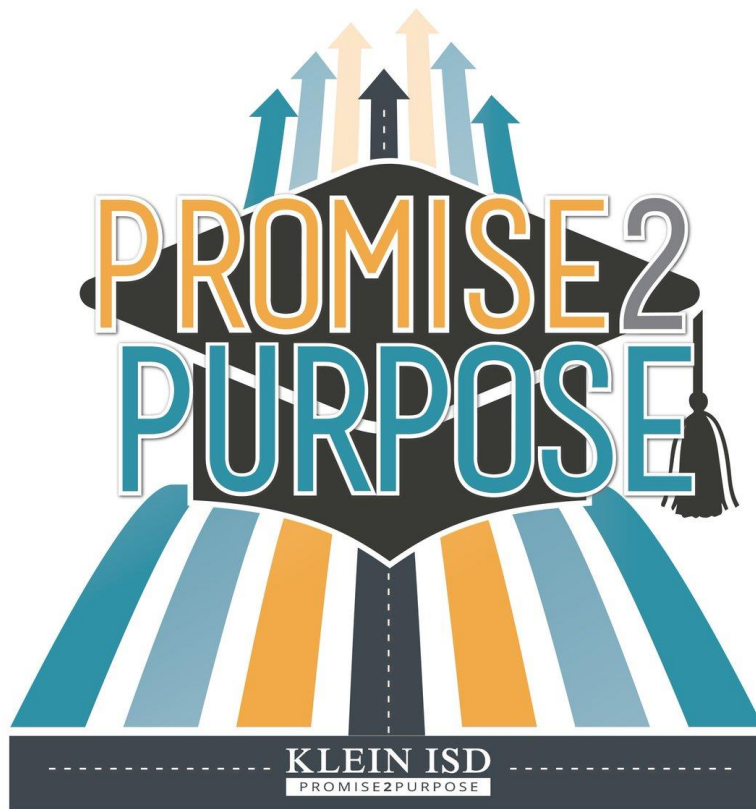

KISD Rules for Final Exam Exemptions

Note: Student textbook records must be clear in all subjects before any final exam exemptions are awarded.

Spring Final Exam Exemption Rules

Students will be eligible for exemptions if they meet all of the requirements below:

KORC

Students - This is just a reminder that you need to report any damage to your tablet within 5 days. After filling out a Work Order Request online, take your tablet to the KORC for repair. The KORC will not call you down.

Students, this is just a friendly reminder that you must have your tablet in a case at all times. Failure to do so can result in a referral, and should your tablet be damaged while it is not in a case, you will be responsible for the cost of repair.

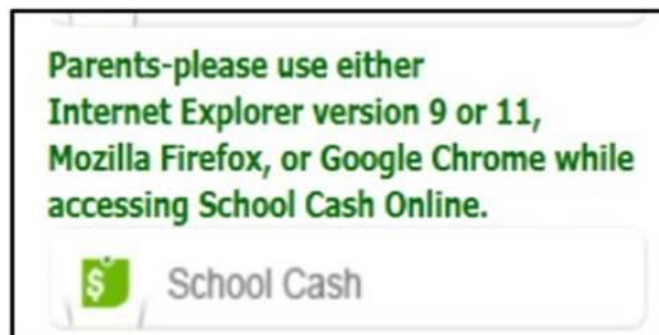
