

KISD Rules for Final Exam Exemptions

Note: Student textbook records must be clear in all subjects before any final exam exemptions are awarded.

Spring Final Exam Exemption Rules

Students will be eligible for exemptions if they meet all of the requirements below:



Due to recent changes in payment card industry standards, School Cash Online will no longer work in Internet Explorer 10.


