


Early Student Check Outs

Please take note that we will no longer check out students in the classrooms after parties. If you would like to check out your child after a party, you can do so in the front office. Please be aware that this will result in a partial day unexcused absence.

A Note From Nurse

24 HOUR RULE

Students who demonstrate signs and symptoms of an illness or a communicable disease should be referred to the school nurse for further assessment. An individual experiencing either vomiting and/or diarrhea or an elevated temperature of 100 degrees or above must be sent home. To give your child time to recuperate and to protect classmates and teachers, your child must be fever free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours before he/she can return to school. In addition, students experiencing vomiting and/or diarrhea must be free of symptoms without the use of preventative medications before returning to school.



MEDICINE

Children cannot carry medications on them at school, not even throat lozenges. If your child needs to take medicine at school, please send a note completed by a parent or a physician in addition to the medication. Please include the reason, the time it needs to be taken, and the amount (dose) to be given. Over the counter medicine must be in the original container and prescription medication must have the original pharmacy label attached with the child's name, name of



medication, and dosing instructions. Medications can be dropped off in the clinic by either the parent or the student with the exceptions of controlled substances and antibiotics which need to be brought into the clinic by the parent. Medications that are to remain in the clinic for the duration of the school year, must accompany a physician's note and a parent's signature. Medications prescribed for 3 times a day or less must be administered at home. CLOTHING

An accident can occur with any student, from all grade levels, for numerous reasons. Please remember to pack an extra change of clothes, including socks and underwear, for your child every day. Please be mindful with each season and as your child grows to update the clothes in the backpack.

PRESIDENTIAL AWARD FOR MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHING

The National Science Foundation is currently accepting nominations and applications for the *Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST)* program. PAEMST is the highest recognition that a kindergarten through 12th grade mathematics or science teacher may receive for outstanding teaching in the United States. Awards may be given to mathematics and science teachers in each state and U.S. jurisdiction and up to 108 awardees may be recognized each year.

This year the teachers in grades K-6 are eligible for this award. Presidential awardees will receive a certificate signed by the President of the United States, a trip for two to Washington DC to attend a series of recognition events and professional development opportunities, and a \$10,000 award from the National Science Foundation. Awardees also join an active network of outstanding educators from throughout the Nation.

Anyone, including the general public, may nominate one or more teachers by completing the nomination form available at https://www.paemst.org/. You will need the teacher's name, email address, and school contact information for submission. Teachers may also initiate the application process themselves at https://www.paemst.org/.

The **Nomination Deadline** for teachers (Grades K-6) is **April 1, 2016**. The Application Deadline is **May 1, 2016**. If your campus does nominate a teacher, please notify the curriculum coordinator as well.
