As we embark on our 4th week, please remember to sign and return the following documents: Acknowledgement of Electronic Distribution of the Student/Parent Handbook and Parent Volunteer Permission Form.

We are also asking for your extreme caution during the morning and afternoon dismissal for the safety of our students. This is the time of the day when we have all students on the move to enter or dismiss from the building as well as a multitude of vehicles. Please drive careful, be patient, no cell phones, and remember our dismissal areas are designated spots depending on how your child goes home.

BUS RIDERS: All students will have bus tags to identify their bus #.

CAR RIDERS: All students will have a car rider colored/numbered tag attached to their backpack that will match the colored/numbered car tag in their parent/guardian/car pool vehicle.

AFTERNOON PARENT PARK and PICK-UP: All students will be matched with their parent/guardian using the car rider colored/numbered car tag presented by the parents at pick-up time.

WALKERS/BIKERS: All students will be dismissed to their designated areas for dismissal.

DAYCARE: All students will be dismissed to the gym and seated according to their Daycare tag.

We have one VISITOR Parking LOT in the front (far front parking lot). If walking your child into the building, please park in the appropriate lot and use the crosswalk. In the afternoon, if you wish to come into the school to pick-up your child (ren), please use the designated back parking lot. All PARENT AFTERNOON PARK and PICK-UPs will park in the back and meet staff at the Rotunda doors. Parents will show their CAR RIDER TAG and your child (ren) will be sent to meet you. All students leaving in a car must have a CAR RIDER TAG that matches their parent/guardian tag. Otherwise, staff will direct you to the front office to show appropriate ID. We encourage all parents to use the car rider line for the safety of all students.

*If you have a change of transportation and will be unable to provide your car tag, please be sure that an email, note, or fax has been sent to the school.

CAR RIDERS- All car riders need a car rider tag for their vehicle and a matching tag for student back-packs. Students should be dropped off and picked up along the parent pick-up lane in front of the school. We provide between 12-15 safety patrol students and staff to open car doors and greet each student at the start of each day as well as to say good-bye to them in the afternoon. We encourage all parents and students to use our car rider line as it allows for a safe practice as well as one where we can build relationships with students and families while greeting. CAR RIDER Tags will be available for pick-up at Meet the Teacher/Orientation and throughout the year in the front office. You can get extra tags in case you have multiple ca and/or car pool.

Buses will drop off and pick up in the back parking lot.

*Safety Patrol - Unfortunately, we do not have enough staff to cover childcare for Safety Patrol Siblings. If your oldest child will be involved in Safety Patrol, please understand that younger siblings will go home at our regular dismissal time, 2:40. Thank you for your understanding with this matter.


