




OKE Math Tournament





<u>PRESIDENTIAL AWARD</u> <u>FOR</u> MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHING

The National Science Foundation is currently accepting nominations and applications for the *Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST)* program. PAEMST is the highest recognition that a kindergarten through 12th grade mathematics or science teacher may receive for outstanding teaching in the United States. Awards may be given to mathematics and science teachers in each state and U.S. jurisdiction and up to 108 awardees may be recognized each year.

This year the teachers in grades K-6 are eligible for this award. Presidential awardees will receive a certificate signed by the President of the United States, a trip for two to Washington DC to attend a series of recognition events and professional development opportunities, and a **\$10,000** award from the National Science Foundation. Awardees also join an active network of outstanding educators from throughout the Nation.

Anyone, including the general public, may nominate one or more teachers by completing the nomination form available at https://www.paemst.org/. You will need the teacher's name, email address, and school contact information for submission. Teachers may also initiate the application process themselves at https://www.paemst.org/.

The Nomination Deadline for teachers (Grades K-6) is April 1, 2016. The Application Deadline is May 1, 2016.
