The State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) was administered this spring. The STAAR measures the statewide curriculum in Reading at Grades 3-8, Writing at Grades 4 and 7, Mathematics at Grades 3-8, Science at Grades 5 and 8, and Social Studies at grade 8.

Electronic results for STAAR grades 3-8 assessments are available through the North East Independent School District Parent Portal at <https://portal.neisd.net/neisdportal> and through the Texas Assessment Management System (TAMS) at <http://www.TexasAssessment.com>. On June 30, electronic results for grades 3-8 STAAR Report Cards, previously called the Confidential Student Reports will be available through the TAMS at <http://www.TexasAssessment.com>.

To access student results on TAMS, you will need your student's birthdate and a secure access code, which can be found on your student's report card, any previous STAAR report, and on the North East Independent School District Parent Portal under the "STAAR" tab.
