WHAT TO EXPECT:

Part I - **CHOREOGRAPHY** – A short combination of Hip Hop/B-boy movement will be taught and then everyone will perform in groups of 4 or 5.

Part II – **CYPHER** - There will be an opportunity to "show what you've got" during the freestyle session.

OBK FACTS:

- Oak Break Krew was established in 2008. It is the Hip-Hop / bboy crew at Klein Oak High School.
- OBK performs throughout the year at school events (pep rallies, carnivals, dance shows) and competes at local jams.
- Additional dance attire will need to be purchased throughout the year.
- We are looking to add dancers with heart, talent (Hip Hop/BBoyin'/Poppin'/etc.) and the spirit to represent Klein Oak High School in a positive manner.
- OBK meets during 1st period daily (Hip Hop Crew 1,2,3,4) and one day a week after school until 4pm. OBK fulfills either PE or FINE ARTS requirements.
- After one full year of participation and earning 30 points, it is possible to earn a letter jacket in OBK.
