KISD students participate in the *Texas SUCCESS* program, which provides statefunded access to an on-line interactive reading program for Texas public school students in grades 3-8. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has selected *I station Reading* as the *Texas SUCCESS* reading provider. Additionally, Katy ISD has purchased I station home access for students in prekindergarten-grade 2.

Parents who set up an account last year for home use, will still be able to use the same account and student logins. For new students, parents will need to set up an account.
