Cardboard paper towel rolls

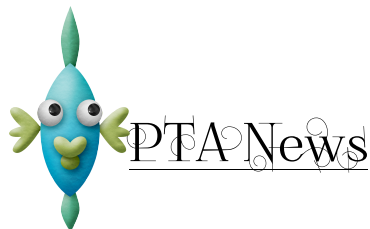
Cardboard toilet paper rolls

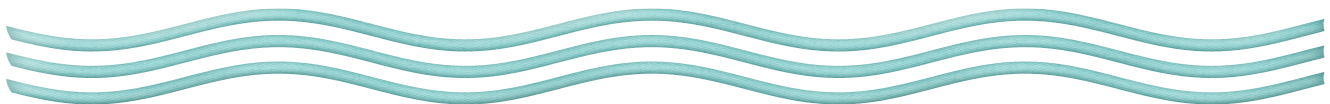
PTA News
