## Manage Your Future

Manage Your Future (MYF) is a career exploration and planning program for youth ages 14—18. The program is designed to provide participants with the means to explore an extensive variety of career opportunities that can lead to career planning, goal-setting, and a pathway to prosperity. The program provides participants with an understanding of expectations in the workplace related to behavior, attitudes, attire, accountability, and responsibility. Incorporated into the program are lessons to enhance financial literacy, soft skills, job interviewing techniques and performance. Educational and cultural trips are provided. The program strives to produce responsible, well-adjusted, and connected young adults

## Training Workshops

Manage Your Future provides multiple training workshops for youths including...

- Job Interviewing
- Job Readiness
- Social Competencies Skills
- Financial Literacy
- Virtual Job Shadowing

Enrolled participants are paid for attending training workshops at minimum wage.

## Internship Sites

Enrolled participants are placed in internships at local businesses and organizations after school for up to 10 hours per week or during the summer for up to 25 hours per week, and are paid at minimum wage.

## Bus Passes

Bus passes are available during enrollment.

## Eligibility

- Between the ages of 14-18.
- Citizen of the United States.
- Residing in households eligible for or receiving Temporary Family Assistance (TFA).
- Residing in households eligible for or receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).
