We do want to make sure that you are all aware of campus hours as these are set for your child's safety. We always want to ensure that staff is on campus with your student and those times are from 7am to 3pm. We know many of you have other children at the elementary school, and would like to make sure you have a plan to ensure that our students are off campus by 3 pm. Our staff is on duty during those times and is dedicated to being available to students. Speaking of safety, we know many of you personally and still require all adults to show ID when they are picking up their student. This is for the safety of your student and others. We understand that many of you are just running in to quickly pick up your student and want you to be prepared with some form of picture ID. Thank you for supporting us with the safety of all of our students and we appreciate those who always show their ID at the door.

Our technology integration is changing this year and you will learn about these changes as you attend our Back to School Night on August 25, 2016, starting at 5pm. We have learned so much over the past five years and want to make sure that parents have the critical information to support the use of the iPad as an educational tool.

Welcome to CBMS. We are looking forward to growing our T-Bird family and want to give you a few informational items about Transition Day. Students will meet on the north blacktop area between 7 am and 725 am. Staff will be circulating and available for questions, as you drop off your student. Students will be greeted as they walk in the gym and will enjoy a day of activities. Our cafeteria will be available, or you can choose to send a lunch with your student. The money in your account will roll up from last year, but please make sure you have money in the account, if your student plans to eat school lunch. Students will not need their backpacks or any supplies the first few days of school. We want to focus on getting to know your student and will let them know when to bring all materials.

Please have a pick-up plan prior to the first day. We want to make sure your student knows how they are getting home and want them to enjoy the day and not stress about transportation. We encourage parents to use the north entrance drop-off area if the student is not walking or riding the bus.
