



and Evaluation, and Independent Learning.




Math Acceleration

- Math Acceleration testing is for students entering 6th grade and wishing to enroll in 7th grade accelerated math
- Regardless of the testing date for a CBE for acceleration, placement in a new course will only take place at the beginning of a school year.
- Although there is no study guide, parents/learners may access the Texas Education Agency's <u>website</u> to view the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) covered in the exams.
- For 5th graders desiring to enroll in 7th grade accelerated math, the exam covers the 6th grade math TEKS.
- To register for the math acceleration test please talk with you elementary school counselor for the CBE application.
- Math Acceleration Testing Dates
 - May 17th or 31st
 - June 6th or 7th

- * must have teacher approval


