Olweus Bullying Prevention Program

Our school cares about the safety and well-being of our students. We want to make sure our school is a good place for students to learn. To do this we use a program called the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program. The Olweus Bullying Prevention Program (OBPP) is one of the best-known bullying prevention programs. OBPP has been proven to prevent or reduce bullying.

The goals of OBPP are to reduce bullying problems and prevent new bullying problems from happening. The program also works to make relationship better among students. The program is for all students, not just those who are being bullied or who are bullying others.

Parents and guardians play a key role in this program. Your child will be asked to tell an adult at school and at home if he or she is being bullied or sees bullying happening at school. It will be very important that you take any bullying seriously and tell our school staff. Our school staff members have been trained to deal with bullying situations when we are told about them. Bullying should not be seen as "kids being kids" or something that students just need to deal with. Having a safe school experience is something that all student should be able to enjoy.

These are the anti-bullying rules at George McGovern. Please review them with your child......

We will not bully others. We will try to help student who are bullied. We will try to include students who are left out. If we know that somebody is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home.
