

Rebel Round-up 2016 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

Q: How do I get a FastPass?

A: Students who are RETURNING to the district can register online by going to the district website (www.hayscisd.net) and clicking on the FastPass icon. When they have completed the online registration process they will be able to print a FastPass to bring with them to the Rebel Round-up. BE SURE TO PRINT REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION.

Q: What is the benefit of the FastPass?

A: Students who have a FastPass can bypass the registration process which will significantly reduce their wait time.

Q: What are the times for Rebel Round-up?

A: August 11

Seniors: 11:30am – 3:00pm

CLOSED FOR LUNCH 3:00pm - 4:00pm

Freshman: 4:00pm - 7:30pm

August 12

Juniors: 8:30am – 12:00pm

CLOSED FOR LUNCH 12:00pm - 1:00pm

Sophomores: 1:00 pm − 4:30pm

Q: What if I have students in different grades levels (i.e. 9th grade and 11th grade)?

A: Parents may choose any of the Round-up sessions to attend. They can take care of all of their students at one time.

Q: Do parents have to attend?

A: Yes. In order for students to pick up their schedules, purchase parking permits, etc. parents/school guardian must accompany students..

Q: What do I need to bring to Rebel Round-up?

A: Students who are returning to our district from last year should complete the Online Registration process by clicking on the registration logo on the district website (<u>www.hayscisd.net</u>). After they complete all of the information they can simply print the email confirmation and bring that with them to the Round-up.

Q: What if I forget my "FastPass"?

A: You can print out a copy of your email confirmation in the library during the Round-up.

Q: Where do I park?

A: Students and parents should park in the lot near Joe Graham Gym, the Bales Gym Parking lot or in the parking lot at the rear of the complex behind the Hays HS Band Hall. Parents and students are asked not to park along FM 2770/Jack C. Hays Trail due to safety concerns.

Q: What entrance do I use for Rebel Round-up?

A: All students, parents and others will need to enter the building at the "B" wing entrance which is located on the north side of the building, in the parking lot between Joe Graham Gym and Shelton Stadium.

Q: Do you take checks for payment of outstanding debt?

A: Yes. Checks should made payable to Hays High School.

Q: What can I do at the Rebel Round-up?

A: Students will be able to:

- 1. Get a new ID (free for those who attend Round-up).
- 2. Pay outstanding obligations (fees, lost textbooks, etc.)
- 3. Purchase a parking permit.
- 4. Pick up course selection for Fall 2016.
- 5. Get more information about PTSA, Project Graduation, and Athletic Boosters.
- 6. Parents can attend Parent Information sessions where we will discuss Advanced Academics, College Readiness, and attendance matters.
- 7. Find out what clubs and student organizations are available to students

Q: What if I still have textbooks at home?

A: Textbooks can be returned during Rebel Round-up. Students who have outstanding textbooks will not be permitted to check out books for the next school year, purchase parking permits or receive their schedule at Rebel Round-up.

Q: Will the schedule I receive during the Round-up be my "real" schedule?

A: Yes. However, all students are required to pick up a new copy of your schedule on August 22^{nd} .

Q: What happens if I do not have all of my immunizations?

A: Students who are not up to date on their immunizations will not be given a schedule on the first day of school. Parents are encouraged to visit with a nurse during the Round-up to find out which immunizations are needed to bring their student in compliance with state law.

Q: My student was out of compliance due to hair color (face piercing, etc.) and could not take his/her photo ID. When is the next available time?

A: Students who were unable to get an ID during the Rebel Round-up will be able to purchase an ID for \$5.00 once school gets started. Students who are new to Hays High School will not have to pay for their first ID.

Q: Do I need a new student ID?

A. If your 2015-2016 Hays High School ID is in like-new condition you are not required to get a new ID at the Rebel Round-up. However, beginning on the first day of school, students who are not new to the campus will be required to pay to replace an ID. All IDs are FREE during the Rebel Round-up.

Q: Am I able to meet with my counselor?

A. Yes, counselors will be available on all days during Rebel Round Up.

Q: Can I change my schedule on August 11th or 12th?

A. Yes. Only if there is an error that would change the student's graduation plan. We will have staff on hand to answer any questions.
