BOWERS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA RECEIVES \$20,000 LET'S PLAY GRANT FROM DR PEPPER SNAPPLE GROUP AND NATIONAL NON-PROFIT KABOOM! AFTER NATIONAL VOTING COMPETITION

MANCHESTER, CT, August, 17, 2017 – Dr Pepper Snapple Group and national non-profit KaBOOM! awarded five recipients, including Bowers Elementary School PTA, a \$20,000 Let's Play Video Contest Grant following a national voting competition where organizations submitted videos illustrating their need for an improved play space.

Let's Play fans voted for their favorite playground videos on www.LetsPlay.com to select the five grant recipients. By finishing in the top five, Dr Pepper Snapple and KaBOOM! awarded Bowers Elementary School PTA a \$20,000 Let's Play grant to build a new playground.

The video contest is part of Let's Play, an initiative by Dr Pepper Snapple to provide kids and families with the tools, places and inspiration to make active play a daily priority. Organizations nationwide were asked to submit videos illustrating their need for places to play for a chance to win one of five \$20,000 grants.

"Because of its small size, the current Bowers playscape is only used by kindergarten and first grade students. Play is such an important part of childhood, and our vision is to add enough equipment for all our kids to have an exciting place to play at recess." said Jessica Mendelsohn, Bowers PTA Playground Committee Chair. "Providing the gift of play to the children in our



community is the most important work we will ever do." said Amy Newman, Bowers PTA President.

Bowers Elementary School supports a student enrollment of 430 children in grades K-5. The school is also a location for before-school and after-school programs, little league games, and summer camps. The grant funds will be used to add additional playground equipment at Bowers. Neighborhood and area children will directly benefit from this grant and the additional playground equipment it will provide.

Dr Pepper Snapple has committed more than \$35.5 million to Let's Play through 2019, impacting youth-serving organizations across the U.S., as well as Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean. Through Let's Play, Dr Pepper Snapple partners with two non-profit organizations, KaBOOM! and Good Sports, to build and improve playgrounds in underserved communities and provide grants for sports equipment.
