#### Hispanic Heritage Youth Awards Deadline: 11/03/24

The <u>Hispanic Heritage Youth Awards</u> honor Latinx high school seniors who excel in the classroom and community for their excellence in various categories including: Community Service, Education, Engineering, Entrepreneurship & Business, Green Sustainability, Healthcare & Science, Media & Entertainment, Public Service & Social Justice, and Technology.

This award is a one-time grant of up to \$4,000 to use for your college education or to fund a community service effort. You may apply for multiple categories and earn multiple awards. Click <u>here</u> for more scholarship opportunities.

#### Seal of Biliteracy

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given to graduating seniors who demonstrate proficiency in English & one other language. The application opens October 15th and the deadline to apply is December 6th. If you don't apply, you will not be allowed to test and earn the Seal. Visit <u>this website</u> for more information. To qualify, you must:

-Be on-track to graduate in May 2025, -Have a GPA of 2.0 or higher in your English classes -Demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English through a District approved exam(typically given in the Spring).

<u>Here</u> is a list of the languages for which you can test. Recipients earn a medallion to wear at graduation, a certificate, a seal for their diploma, and a notation in their transcript.
