

August 2017 - Vassiliadis Cubs Drop-Off Zones

Hello Vassiliadis Families,

The Vassiliadis administration is proud to announce that there will be two different areas to utilize for dropping off students to school, a drop-off zone on Antelope Ridge and a playground drop-off at the rear of the school. Our goal is to help reduce parking challenges and to provide a safe way for students to arrive to school each morning. Please review the drop-off zone procedures below to ensure the safety of students.

- 1. The drop-off zone accepts students in grades 1-5 between 7:40 a.m. 7:55 a.m. Please wait until at least 7:40 a.m. before dropping off your children, as school supervision is not provided prior to this time. Parents with kindergarten students must drop off and pick up their kindergarten child on the kindergarten playground.
- 2. <u>PLEASE PULL YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE YELLOW DROP-OFF ZONE AREA (prior to allowing children to exit your automobile)</u>. This avoids having vehicles attempt to pass each other, which could ultimately create an unsafe situation for children.
- 3. For the safety of our students and the entire community, <u>PLEASE NEVER LET STUDENTS</u> <u>EXIT YOUR VEHICLES WHILE YOU ARE IN THE ACTUAL LANES ON THE STREET(S).</u>
- 4. Please abide by posted school zone speed limits and signage. When exiting the drop-off zone on Antelope Ridge, only left hand turns are permitted in the pass through lane and only right hand turns are permitted in the drop-off zone lane for the safety of students. Parking in the pass through lane or drop-off zone lane is prohibited.
- 5. As a courtesy to fellow drop-off zone users, please make sure that your children are ready to QUICKLY exit your cars. The drop-off zone was created to provide a fast, safe way for students to arrive to school, so be sure to have lunch boxes, backpacks, etc. ready to go.
- 6. The Vassiliadis campus (including the parking lots are <u>no ride zones</u>. All bicycles, scooters, and skateboards must be walked to avoid collisions with vehicles or pedestrians walking to school.
