Student Drop-Off

Colder weather means more parents are dropping students off and picking them up at the end of the day, which can cause a longer car line. Please help students and staff move the car line quickly by noting these tips:

- School doors open at 8AM. Students cannot be dropped off before 8AM.
- Students <u>must enter/exit</u> the passengers side of the vehicle *only*. No exceptions. Adults should stay in the car.
- Students should be ready to exit the car quickly. Finish breakfast before pulling in, have the backpack and water bottles ready and coats on. Students should be able to unbuckle/buckle up on their own.
- If your child is having a rough day and having trouble getting in/out of the car, or has items they need to get out of the trunk, can't unbuckle/buckle up, etc. please pull around to the north parking lot. Do not hold up the line.
- If your child is typically a walker and the weather turns bad around dismissal time, go ahead and hop in the car and pull into the pick up line. Walkers will not be dismissed during heavy snow, rain or storms until the threat subsides.
