Dear Academies of Loudoun students and parents,

As you all are considering your options for fall instruction, I have put together some clarifications that may be of assistance to you in making your decision.

## Here are a few basics:

- MATA classes are only available in the Hybrid Option.
- AET and AOS classes are available in both options, however we do recommend the
  hybrid option because it allows us to incorporate the hands-on, inquiry-based
  instruction that is a foundation to the teaching and learning of our programs, and also
  better supports our research classes.
- All Academies students have the option of choosing the same model for the Academies and their home high school, OR different models. There is currently an error in ParentVue that is being corrected to allow the two choices for each Academies family. Additional information will be sent out once this has been corrected.

## Hybrid Model at the Academies and the home high school

The table below summarizes what an Academies student schedule might look like if they select the Hybrid option for both ACL and their home high school. If a student is set to attend ACL on A days, they will be assigned to either A1 or A2. If a student is set to attend ACL on B days, they will be assigned to either B1 or B2.

The table below illustrates a student in Group A1 who has in-person learning at ACL on Tuesdays and would be in-person at their home high school on Thursdays.

- Group A2 students would have in-person learning at ACL on Wednesdays and would be in-person at their home high school Fridays.
- Group B1 students would be at their home high school on Tuesdays (in-person) and Wednesdays (asynchronous) and would have in person learning at ACL on Thursdays.
- Group B2 students would be at their home high school on Tuesdays (asynchronous) and Wednesdays (in-person) have in-person learning at ACL on Fridays.

Start and stop times for the hybrid model will be close to the Distance Learning model and will be based upon transportation. These times will be finalized in the coming weeks.

## Hybrid Model at the Academies with *Distance Learning (DL)* at the home high school

The table below summarizes what an Academies student schedule might look like if they select the Hybrid option for ACL and distance learning at their home high school. If a student is set to attend ACL on A days, they will be assigned to either A1 or A2. If a student is set to attend ACL on B days, they will be assigned to either B1 or B2.

The table below illustrates a student in Group A1 who has in-person learning at ACL on Tuesdays and would be in DL at their home high school.

- Group A2 students would have in-person learning at ACL on Wednesdays and would be in DL at their home high school Fridays.
- Group B1 students would be in DL at their home high school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays and would have in-person learning at ACL on Thursdays.
- Group B2 students would be in DL at their home high school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays have in-person learning at ACL on Fridays.

Start and stop times for the hybrid model will be close to the Distance Learning model and will be based upon transportation. These times will be finalized in the coming weeks.
