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1. If you need to make any dismissal changes for your child, please contact the office by 12:00. We will be sure to notify your child's teacher of the changes. Teachers are not always able to check their email during the instruction day.
  2. Please make sure your contact information is up to date in Skyward so you can receive proper notification if/when Winter weather causes a delay/closing. Also, we go outside for recess as long as the windchill is above the 18-20 range, as outlined in the corporation handbook. Please make sure your children are dressed appropriately.
  3. The MCCSC Office of High Ability Education has begun the middle school high ability identification/application process for the 2019-2020 school year for incoming 7th grade students. Notification letters will be mailed on Friday, January 25, 2019 to current sixth grade students who automatically qualify for middle school high ability services (advanced ELA or ALPS) based on scores on the In View and NWEA assessments. Application materials for students who want to appeal for placement in middle school high ability programs are due to the Office of High Ability Education on or before Friday, February 8, 2019. Placement in advanced math classes is a separate process and will occur later in the semester.
  4. If you have questions about the high ability application/identification process, a parent information meeting will be held on Thursday, January 24 at 6:30 PM in the Tri-North Middle School auditorium. This meeting is open to any parent or
