1. Report Cards will come home with your children on Friday, January 13th.
2. There will be no school on Monday, January 16th in observance of MLK Jr. Day. School will resume on Tuesday, January 17th.
3. MCCSC will hold their annual Winter Strings Concert on Tuesday, January 10th beginning at 7:00 PM in the Bloomington High School North gymnasium.
4. MCCSC will conduct their annual Kindergarten Open Houses on Thursday, February 9th. University School invites prospective kindergarteners for the 2023-2024 school year to join us beginning at 6:00 PM to learn about the life of a kindergartener at University School. Families need to attend their HOMESCHOOL Open House on February 9th.

When we have an e-learning day, students will be provided with 3 hours of live instruction in ELA, Math, Specials, and Intervention (ex. Speech, Special Education, ENL, Homeroom).
