### Winter Reminders

### MLK Week of Service

MCPS annually recognizes Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) with a week of service projects and acts of kindness in schools from Jan. 13-21, 2024. Some of our teachers will be utilizing resources from MCPS during this week to investigate mental health and well-being, support how to improve mental health and well-being, and have students develop an action plan to address well-being issues.



## NEW Bus Tracking App

MCPS will be launching a self-service bus app for families this semester. The tracking app will allow users to receive live updates on where their student's bus is, provide important two-way communication capability and enhance safety for students while they wait for and ride the bus.

The MCPS Department of Transportation is currently in a pilot phase with families and students at 10 schools. More information will be shared in the coming weeks as we prepare for the full launch across the district.

## Winter Testing

We are beginning MAP testing for the Winter. Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd graders will take the MAP-P test to assess their skills in math, while 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders will take the MAP-R (reading) test and MAP-M (math) test. The Winter MAP testing schedule is below, which includes specific dates for all grade levels.
