- 6. If you are on a transfer to University School this year, it is MCCSC policy that you submit a new transfer request for the 2022-2023 school year. Please note that your child must meet all the criteria outlined in the transfer request to remain a student at University School. <u>Inner School Transfer Request Out of District Transfer Request</u> Inner School Transfer Requests must start at your child's home school. Transfer requests are dependent on enrollment.
- The end of the school year for students is May 20th (last day). Keep up to date
  with everything that is going on by staying in touch with your child's classroom
  communication.
