We are excited to begin sharing our High School program with our future CB East students and parents. Unfortunately, because of the current capacity limitations on indoor events we will be unable to welcome all of you to CB East for our annual Curriculum Fair on Thursday, January 7, 2020. However, we are excited to offer an alternative with the hope that we can come together as a CB East Community later in the school year.



Dissemination of our curriculum information will take place as follows:

- 1) On Tuesday, January 5th, the Program Planning process begins when students receive information from the Middle School during the school day.
- 2) On Thursday, January 7th, you will be able to review pre-recorded presentations by our school counselors and by teachers within our various departments.
 - Counselors will review graduation requirements, block scheduling, and course planning options among other topics.
 - Teachers will share course options, sequences, level differences, and address frequently asked questions for our rising sophomore families.

All of the presentations will be available on our Curriculum Information website (Parent/Student Tab). The presentations will be separated by department so that you can visit the departments that you are interested in learning more about, mirroring an in-person curriculum fair. A direct link to the website will be sent to all families during the first week of January.

- 3) On Friday, January 8th, all families will receive an optional survey to complete. The purpose of the survey is to gather questions that have resulted after viewing the pre-recorded presentations. We will use these questions to guide us in preparing for the final segment of our informational series.
- 4) On Wednesday, January 13th, Mr. Moustakas and Mrs. Flanagan Kelly will host live on-line sessions for interested parents. Ahead of these sessions we will also send out a FAQ document including the themes from the survey and what will be discussed during the live sessions. The sessions will be offered via Microsoft Teams at the follow times:

 - 1:30 PM 2:30 PM

Links to each of these sessions will also be sent to all families during the first week of January. The purpose of these sessions is to address the most frequently asked questions that we received from the survey sent to all families on January 8th and to provide further clarification for families about the course selection process. These sessions are not mandatory and are not intended to address individual questions about your child's high school plan. Questions as such should be directed to your child's middle school counselor and/or middle school teachers at this time. We kindly ask you to attend only one session to ensure that all families have the opportunity to join the event.
