- 1. Tuesday, May 3rd is Election Day. Since MCCSC Schools are used for polling sites, there will be NO SCHOOL on this date.
- May 2nd 6th is Teacher Appreciation Week. It is a great time to write your child's teacher a small thank you for all the work they have done this year. Our PTO should be sharing information about what they are organizing for the teachers as well.
- 3. We have about 15-20 "Thank You Teachers" yard signs left to sell to families from the past year. This is a great way to show your thanks for our University teachers by purchasing a sign for \$10 and placing it in your yard. If you already have a sign, now is the time to put it out in your yard! Signs may be purchased on the north side of the school during car/walker pick up/drop off each day or you can come into the office. Buy it, pick it up, place it in your yard! Funds support our PTO.
- 4. If you are moving out of district, town, state, or country, please email your child's teacher as well as Ms. Stilwell at astilwel@mccsc.edu to let us know. This helps as we plan for class assignments for the next school year.



- 5. If you are on a transfer to University School this year, it is MCCSC policy that you submit a new transfer request for the 2022-2023 school year. Please note that your child must meet all the criteria outlined in the transfer request to remain a student at University School. Inner School Transfer Request Out of District Transfer Request Please note that inner School Transfer Requests must start at your child's home school.
- 6. We are coming up on the end of the year. Your child's class is going to be VERY busy over the next few weeks. Please be sure to stay on top of all the communication your child's teacher will be sharing with you. Concerts, field trips, Field Day, graduation, promotion ceremony, play museum, Learning Festival, etc. It is going to be A LOT!
- 7. Our first week of ILEARN for students in grades 3-6 went great! Thank you for your help in getting your students to school for this assessment. We will continue this week with Math in grades 3-6, SS in 5th, and Science in 4th and 6th. Please see communication from your child's teacher for specific details of what is happening in their classroom.
- 8. All UES library books are due to Mrs. D'Eliso by May 6th. Please start making sure that your child's books are back at school. We easily have over 2,000 books in the hands of students right now, so getting them in early never hurts to allow for them to be reshelved in a progressive manner.
- 9. There will be NO Scholastic Book Fair during the Learning Festival this year. Instead, we are overjoyed to have Morgenstern Books offer to help support our UES Library by hosting a fundraiser May 1st 8th at their store. Purchase books, cafe items, or gift cards. Tell the cashier that you are supporting University School and 20% of the sale will go towards our library! You don't have to bring in a flyer word of mouth is enough!
