- 1. We will conduct our Safe Harbor (Evacuation) Drill tomorrow morning. This is a PRACTICE in the event that we would have a reason to evacuate the building to a safe space. In our case, we have partnered with City Church, across the street, for this. If you have any religious beliefs that would prevent your child from entering their sanctuary, please call the main office at 812-330-7753 by 8:30 tomorrow morning so we can get your child's name recorded. Any students that are not able to enter into the sanctuary will wait in the lobby of the church.
- 2. We will be holding a Field Day on the last day of school, Friday, May 20th for students in grades 1-6. Kindergarten is doing their own Field Day separate from what is happening in the back of the school, so please look for information from your child's kindergarten teacher. For 1-6, we have created a SignUp Genius for parents/guardians to volunteer to help. - 3. You are invited to an MCCSC Referendum Community Meeting tonight beginning at 5:00 in the University School cafeteria. This will be an opportunity to hear from Mr. Hopkins and Dr. Hauswald about the state of the current referendum and the proposed referendum that will be on the ballot in November. - 6. If you are on a transfer to University School this year, it is MCCSC policy that you submit a new transfer request for the 2022-2023 school year. Please note that your child must meet all the criteria outlined in the transfer request to remain a student at University School. <u>Inner School Transfer Request Out of District Transfer Request</u> Inner School Transfer Requests must start at your child's home school. Transfer requests are dependent on enrollment.
- 7. Mark your calendars for Friday, May 13th from 5:30-8:00 for the Learning Festival. Various points of communication have gone out over the past couple weeks, including an extensive email this morning outlining the activities, food, tickets, auction, etc. We can't wait to see everyone on Friday evening!
- 8. Thursday, May 12th is the MCCSC Elementary Band Concert beginning at 7:00 PM. This concert will be held in the University School gym.
- 9. Virtual Summer Camp is an easy way for your child to stay sharp this summer from the comfort of your own home. This program is available to students currently in K through 8th grades. Your child can log on at any point throughout the week to complete these assignments or work on their personalized learning path in reading and/or math.
