- Indiana law requires all schools to conduct universal screening of students in grades K – 2 for characteristics of dyslexia. Dyslexia is an unexpected difficulty learning to read despite intelligence, motivation and appropriate instruction. The universal screening consists of very brief assessments that are being administered at each school. The screeners do not diagnose dyslexia.


