Ice Cream Sales

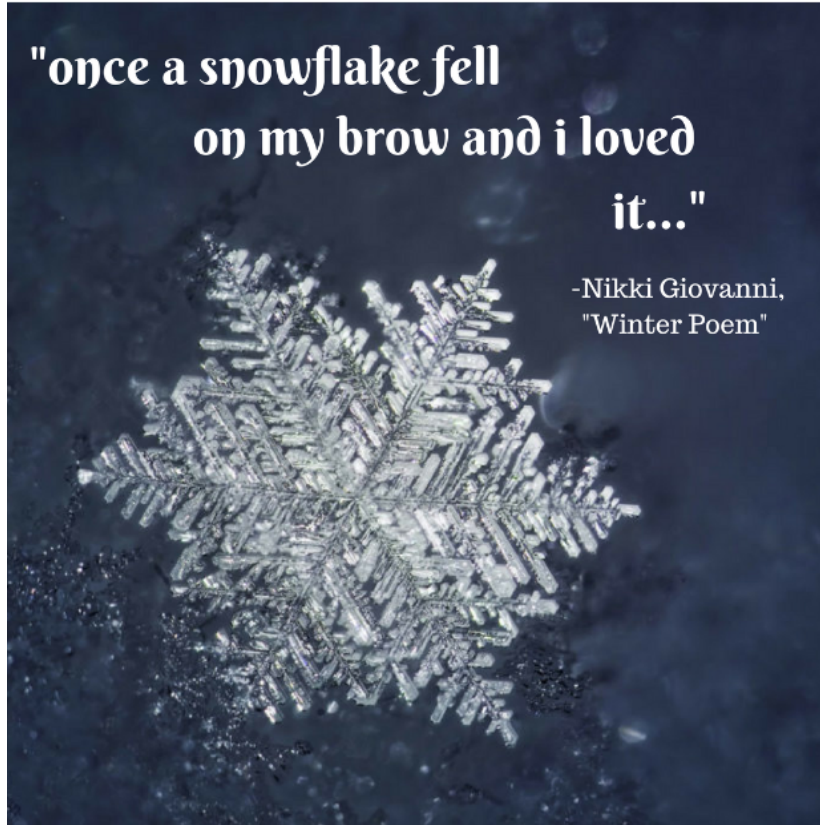
