Attendance Information - Everyday Matters

Chronic absenteeism was 36% in the Clark County School District (CCSD) and 21.6% at Del Webb last school year. That means that one out of every three CCSD students and one out of every five Del Webb students were absent 10 percent or more of enrolled days for any reason, whether excused or unexcused.

It's an issue we must address head-on and with urgency. When students miss classroom instruction, it negatively affects their success, including grades, test scores, graduation rates, and social development.

Chronic absenteeism also factors into school ratings on the Nevada School Performance Framework. The dramatic uptick in post-COVID absence rates have a large impact on our school's overall rating and led to a lowered star status as compared to prior years.

What can we do to address this?

- When possible, plan appointments and vacations around the school schedule.
- Unless ill, students should be encouraged to attend all classes daily.
- Provide absent notes (or medical excuse notes) for each absence. Parents can report and submit a reason for the absence by completing this form (available under the Parents tab on the school website).

Additionally, students who exceed ten (10) unapproved absences per semester in any course may receive a failing semester grade for that course.

If a student is absent from school, makeup work can be accessed on Canvas. If students have questions or need assistance from their teacher, they can email them directly.

How do I know what my child is doing at school?

Clark County Schools use two main programs for learning and grading/attendance. Parents are encouraged to monitor both to stay up-to-date with their child's progress at Del Webb:

- 1. Infinite Campus is where teachers enter grades/attendance and it is both a webpage and an app). To access the webpage, click <u>here</u>. If you do not know your password or login details, there are links to help under the login button. If that does not work, you would need to come into the school to show ID to then reset your password for you and give you the user name if needed. - 2. **Canvas** is where teachers keep their lessons and materials for each class. Students can also complete many of their assignments within Canvas. You can become a parent observer on Canvas and see everything your child sees by following these instructions.
